Featured Divisions

Specialized Education (DES):

The Division of Specialized Education is responsible for ensuring the delivery of timely, legally compliant, and high-quality services to children with disabilities from birth through age 21 who resides in the District of Columbia. The division ensures Local Education Agency (LEA) compliance with Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) and serves as the lead agency for implementation of Part C of the IDEA, provided through the Strong Start Early Intervention Program for infants and toddlers. As such, this division oversees the development and promulgation of state policy governing early intervention and special education, monitors LEAs, nonpublic, and early intervention providers to ensure their compliance with the law, monitors the allocation and administration of IDEA grant funds to LEAs; provides training and technical assistance to LEAs and providers; and investigates and helps resolve District complaints relating to special education.

Elementary and Secondary Education (ELSEC):

The Division of Elementary and Secondary Education is responsible for all aspects of the classroom instruction and curriculum, establishing teacher certification requirements for all eligible District schools; establishing statewide standards to be adopted by local agencies and monitoring assessments across all schools. ELSEC monitors and ensures compliance with respect to English Language Learner federal and state requirements. The Division also ensures that classrooms are taught by highly qualified teachers in compliance with the District State Education Plan.
