



EDUCATOR LICENSURE EXAMS

To obtain a license to teach in the District of Columbia, applicants must provide evidence of successful completion of required state licensure exams. For teaching and pupil services subjects the District of Columbia requires the completion of the Praxis series administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). For the area of school principal and assistant principal we require completion of the School Leadership Series exam administered by ETS. The required examinations for each licensing area are listed below. In some instances license holders from other states/jurisdictions may qualify for a test exemption or waiver; and those with valid DC licenses who are seeking an endorsement license may qualify for a Principles of Learning & Teaching (PLT) testing waiver. **SCORE RECOGNITION SCHEDULE FOR DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA TEACHER LICENSURE EXAMS
THAT HAVE BEEN DROPPED, DISCONTINUED OR REGENERATED**

The District of Columbia recognizes that there are applicants who have achieved passing scores on licensure exams that have since been dropped, discontinued, or regenerated (ETS test updating process). In these instances, passing licensure exam scores will be acceptable for a period not to exceed three (3) calendar years after the date an exam has been dropped, discontinued or regenerated.

Below is a chart of acceptable exams for subject areas that include a previously required exam(s), and the score recognition schedule. Applicants who possess test names/codes and scores that DO NOT match the exams listed on this chart, will be required to provide passing scores for currently required exams.
