The Office of the State Superintendent of Education, Adult and Family Education (OSSE AFE) funds providers in the District of Columbia to offer Adult Basic Education (ABE), Adult Secondary Education (ASE) including GED (General Education Development) and NEDP (National External Diploma Program), English as a Second Language (ESL), English Literacy/EL Civics and Family Literacy Services to DC residents. OSSE AFE providers integrate these services with ancillary, workforce and/or postsecondary education transition services to address the needs of District residents.

The Department of Employment Services (DOES) provides workforce development programs and services to DC residents. DOES services include job search assistance, self-directed job search, vocational training, apprenticeship, unemployment insurance, transitional employment, and referrals to supportive services and educational programs.

OSSE AFE and DOES have partnered to provide District residents with adult education, occupational literacy, digital literacy, Career Essential Boot Camps, postsecondary education and training services. Intake, assessment and instructional services are also available at American Job Centers.
