

FIRST AID SUPPLIES

29 DCMR 369.3-Each Facility shall provide the following items among its first-aid supplies:

One (1) roll of one-half (1/2") non-allergenic	One-third cup (1/3 c.) of powdered milk for

- First aid supplies must be stored in a location beyond the reach of children/infants but in an area ready accessible and known to all staff
- All first aid equipment and supplies must be maintained clean and in a sufficient quantity for the size of the child care program
- Staff is required to have First Aid and CPR Training
- First Aid and CPR Training must be renewed upon expiration
- When a child is injured, the parents/guardians must be notified immediately and the incident must be documented
- Hands must be washed thoroughly before administering first aid to the injured person
- Temperature of a child/infant may be taken when necessary with a digital thermometer or ear probe
- Children/Infants must be under adult supervision at all times
