

Step One: Visit: http://ies.ed.gov/ncee/wwc/


Step Two: Select the hyperlink that reads, "Find What Works!"




Step Three: From the list of Topics/ Outcome Domains in the "Find What works for. . ." menu, choose an area of targeted interest. These interests include both behavior and academic supports.



Step Four: Depending on your chosen area of interest or concern, you may further filter your findings based upon Topic/ Outcome Domain, Grade, Effectiveness Rating, Extent of Evidence, Delivery Method, Program Type, Gender, Race, and Region



Step Five: After reviewing the improvement index, effectiveness rating, extent of evidence, etc., select an "Intervention" that embodies the components of an intervention you think, through professional judgment, strategic team/ group decision-making, and other methods of shared responsibility, that would be appropriate for your school community.



Step Six: After selecting the intervention you want to research more into, a full "Report Summary" appears that illustrates, in a synopsis the following areas: "Effectiveness, Program Description, and Research." If after the synopsis review you/ your team consider this an appropriate intervention, choose to download the full report and continue your investigation to implement the intervention.
