- Required by the District of Columbia's Healthy Schools Act of 2010
- Annual assessment of health and physical education knowledge in fifth grade, eighth grade, and high school (during the year in which health class is provided)
- Data uses:
 - HSA reporting
 - Track progress on performance to health and physical education standards
 - Drive targeted investments through grants
 - Identify needs for TA supports and CBO partnerships

Assessment Blueprint

All items in the assessment are equally scored, and results are reported as percent correct.

Assessment Timeline, Important Dates, and Responsibilities

April 1

through

June 14, 2019

Preparation Deadlines

Due no later than COB Friday March 15:

What	How to Submit
High school health roster	If your LEA serves high school grades, upload completed roster of students enrolled in a health class during the 18-19 school year to Box . Use the roster template found on the OSSE website .
Planned assessment start and end dates	Email to OSSE.SchoolHealth@dc.gov. Include your LEA's name followed by the words "Health Assessment Timeline" in the subject line. The dates must fall within the April 1 – June 14 window.
Student accommodations	Upload completed spreadsheet of planned student accommodations to <u>Box</u> . The spreadsheet should follow the template found on the <u>OSSE website.</u>

- At least 10 days before your planned HPEA start date, test all computers and networks to ensure SurveyGizmo is not blocked on your schools' networks.
- March 27, 2019: download students' assessment IDs from Box and distribute test tickets to schools along with the Proctor Script and any other needed materials for the assessment administration.
 - Note: Grades 5 and 8 test IDs created with snapshot of elementary and middle school enrollment as displayed in SLED on March 15, 2019. High school IDs created with health class rosters submitted by LEA.
- At least 5 days before students take the assessment, make sure schools send home letters offering parents the option to exempt their children from completing questions about sexual health.
- From April 1 through June 14, 2019 track HPEA completion regularly using Qlik. Follow up with schools to ensure 100 percent completion rate before the assessment end date



School Proctor Responsibilities

The school-based Health Assessment Proctor(s) will

- Confirm that assessment URL is not blocked by the school's network: http://hpea.osse.dc.gov/s3/2019HPEA
- Distribute sexual health exemption letters and track receipt
- Ensure appropriate accommodations are available for students
- Confirm and communicate assessment dates, times, and locations with LEA Health Assessment Coordinator
- Obtain students' test ID tickets from LEA Assessment Coordinator
- Review and follow Health Assessment Proctor Script

Sexual Health Exemption

The 2019 Health and Physical Education Assessment will take place in schools between April 1, and June 14, 2019. If you do not wish for your student to participate in the sexual health portion of the assessment, please fill out the form below. 






Uploading Files to Box






Uploading Files to Box






Downloading Files from Box




For monitoring completion rates during the assessment window




For **reviewing results** (% correct)











Monitoring Assessment Completion Rates













