## **2020 Cafeteria Staff Training Grant FAQs**

The questions below were submitted during the pre-application question period and are made available to assist all applicants in completing the 2020 Cafeteria Staff Training Grant. The pre-application question period ended on Nov. 1, 2019. Please reference the informational webinar and this document to assist with the application process. ### **1. How do I start an application?**

All OSSE grants are managed using the Enterprise Grants Management System (EGMS). Visit [grants.osse.dc.gov](http://grants.osse.dc.gov) and click on login to begin an application. New users will need to create an account with EGMS to complete an application.

### **2. When is the application due?**

Applications are due by 3 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on Friday, Dec. 6, 2019.

### **3. How do I complete Central Data in EGMS?**

Central Data must be completed for an application to be submitted. Instructions on completing Central Data can be found, [here](#).

### **4. What is the total funding amount for the grant?**

The total funding available for this grant is \$100,000.

### **5. Who is eligible for the grant?**

Eligible applicants: DCPS, DC public charter schools, and DC non-profit private schools who participate in the NSLP, other organizations that support the National School Lunch Program including: food service vendors, food service management companies, and training organizations with experience training schools.

Applications from other organizations and certified training organizations must encompass training a minimum of three school campuses who participate in the NSLP at the start of school year 2019-20. Applying organizations must have experience supporting school food programs. A letter of interest regarding the training is required from each school the organization plans to provide training for.

**6. I am a food service vendor, am I eligible to apply for this grant?**

Yes, food service vendors are eligible applicants.

**7. If we have vendor provided meal would we be able to utilize this grant and if so how?**

Yes, you are able to utilize the grant to train your foodservice/nutrition employees.

**8. Is there a list of recommended training organizations to partner with?**

No, there is not.

**9. Can our staff provide the training?**

Yes.
