- EGMS was created during the 2013-2014 School Year in collaboration with online data systems developers
- EGMS replaces the old way of:
 - Applying for Grant Awards
 - Requesting Reimbursements
 - Reporting & Updating Data

Amending 21st CCLC Program Information

- Proposed changes to 21st CCLC program information including, but not limited to, Administration, Office and Site locations, curriculum, # of hours served, and # of grades or students served, **will require a formal letter to OSSE explaining why program changes are necessary.**
- Letters must be on an organization's letterhead, be signed by the administrator over the 21st CCLC program, and be submitted to 21stcclc.info@dc.gov. OSSE will conduct a review and provide feedback as needed.
- If changes are approved, OSSE staff will provide assistance as needed to update EGMS program information.


