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Eagle Academy's Experience Implementing the Immunization Attendance Policy

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Background on Eagle Academy

- Eagle Academy PCS has been in operation for nearly 20 years
- Serve children 3 9 years of age; PK3 to 3rd grade
- Title I School

Process for Enforcement

- Reinforcing immunization requirements for more than 10 years
- Reminders of immunization requirements prior to start of school year
 - Enrollment Events
 - Parent Orientation
 - Parent Handbook
 - Back to School Night

• Weekly Compliance Reports

• Identifying students who are within 20 days of being out of compliance

Process for Enforcement

• Courtesy Phone calls for students at risk of non-compliance

- 1st call at 20 days prior to non-compliance
- 2nd call 2-3 days after 1st call
- 3rd call 7 days prior to non-compliance

• Immunization Compliance reminder letters

- 1st reminder letter sent via email or hardcopy 7 days after 2nd call
- 2nd reminder letter sent via email or hardcopy 10 12 days prior to noncompliance
- Exclusion letter (if necessary) 3 5 days prior to exclusion date

• Providing families with resources for access health care options

- Allow parents to show proof of a scheduled appointment
- Compile a bank of local community resources for families
- Partnering with local providers to provide in-school health services

Key Ingredients

- Efficient communication Over communicating
- Timely identification of students Early Identification of students at risk for non-compliance
- Parent Engagement Providing multiple opportunities for parents to receive information/interaction
- All hands-on deck approach (multiple departments)

Potential Future Changes

- Improved electronic notification system
- Providing more in-school resources to improve access to health services
