- The Related Services Management (RSMR) report is a report that compares the amount of time a related service is **prescribed** on a student's IEP to the amount of time the service is actually **provided**.
- The report is based on data entered by the service provider via the Service Logging Wizard in SEDS.
- This report assists school leaders and managers in:
 - Determining if providers are delivering services as prescribed on the IEP (e.g., duration, frequency, setting, etc.),
 - Managing caseload assignments,
 - Managing service provider resources, and
 - Addressing any discrepancies in services to students.



The report pulls together data from SEDS, including:

- Student names and demographic info
- Amount and types of services prescribed on IEP
- Amount and types of services provided over a set time period
- The providers assigned on the IEP and/or who delivered the services (if different)
- Amount of missed services and reasons for missed services

The report also includes calculations generated from the raw data:

- Percent of services prescribed that were completed
- Productivity percentage for providers

- Moving forward, **LEAs will receive early access to information** on students with disabilities in a data visualization application, Qlik, using two sources:
 - MySchoolDC: Prior to the SIS cutover between school years, LEAs that participate in MySchoolDC will receive information for pre-enrolled students with disabilities as soon as MySchoolDC shares this information with OSSE for the new school year.
 - **Nightly SIS Feeds**: After the SIS cutover between school years, all LEAs will receive information for pre-enrolled students with disabilities once they initiate nightly feeds from their SIS to OSSE for the new school year.
