EARLY ACCESS TO IMMUNIZATION DATA

User Guide

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Overview

District law and regulations require all schools in the District of Columbia, including private, parochial, and independent schools, to verify student compliance with the immunization requirements as part of enrollment and attendance. If a student is not compliant, the school must immediately notify the parent, guardian, or adult student in writing of the missing immunization(s). If the student does not come into compliance within a 20-school day period, the school must remove the student from school and any school extracurricular activities until the immunization certification is secured by the school.

All public and public charter schools in the District are required to implement the <u>immunization</u> attendance policy.

Purpose

This document serves as the user guide for the Early Access to Immunization Data Qlik application. The Early Access to Immunization Data Qlik application provides a high-level analysis of student-level immunization compliance data. LEAs and schools can view whether a student is identified by DC Health as compliant, overdue, or due for immunizations. Detailed student-level immunization data, such as which immunizations are due or overdue, are available at https://dchealth.dc.gov/dociis.

The Early Access to Immunization Data Qlik application is released in the spring. At that time, the application displays enrolled students for the current school year and pre-enrolled students for the next school year. The application is then updated at the start of school to only show enrolled students for the current school year.


Access

Data Refresh Schedule

The Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) provides student enrollment data to DC Health weekly. DC Health's District of Columbia Immunization Information System (DOCIIS) attempts to match the students; if a match is found in DOCIIS, the student immunization data will be sent to OSSE. If DOCIIS is unable to complete a student match, the application will display 'Not Received.' The application is updated with the immunization data every Monday at 9 am.



Student Immunization Status Sheet

The **Student Immunization Status** sheet displays an overview of immunization compliance at the LEA, school, and student levels. See <u>Definitions</u> for descriptions of the data displayed in the application.

The sheet provides visualizations highlighting the below.

- Filter by USI
- Filter by Current School Name
- Filter by New to LEA
- Filter by Returning to LEA
- Number of Students in Compliance
- Number of Students Out of Compliance

Filters

The application displays the below four filters. Applying filters will update all visualizations and data displayed.

- USI
- Current School Name
- New to LEA
- Returning to LEA

KPIs

The application displays two Key Performance Indicators (KPIs):

- Students in Compliance; and
- Students Out of Compliance.

Note: The KPI *Percentage of Students in Compliance* will be released at the start of the next school year. The KPI will display the percentage of stage 5 enrolled students who are compliant.

Students in Compliance

The **Students in Compliance** KPI displays the total number of unique students that are compliant based on the data received from DC Health. This KPI includes all enrolled students for the current school year and pre-enrolled students for the next school year.

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Figure 3: KPI: Students in Compliance

Question: What does compliance mean?

Compliance means the student has met **all** required vaccines for their age. This KPI also includes students who have a current exemption (medial, religious, or HPV Opt-Out Certificate). To view students who are compliant, scroll to the <u>Student Information Table</u> and select **Yes** in the compliant column header filter.

Students Out of Compliance

The **Students Out of Compliance** KPI displays the total number of unique students **who** are out of compliance based on the data received from DC Health. This KPI includes all enrolled students for the current school year and pre-enrolled students for the next school year.


Question: What does out of compliance mean?

Out of compliance means the student has **not** met all required vaccines for their age and do not have a current exemption (medical, religious, or HPV Opt-Out Certificate). To view students who are not compliant, scroll to the <u>Student Information Table</u>, and select **No** in the compliant column header filter.

Stacked Bar Chart




The **Student Count by Grade** stacked bar chart displays all unique students who enrolled for the current school year and pre-enrolled for the next school year by grade and compliance status.
