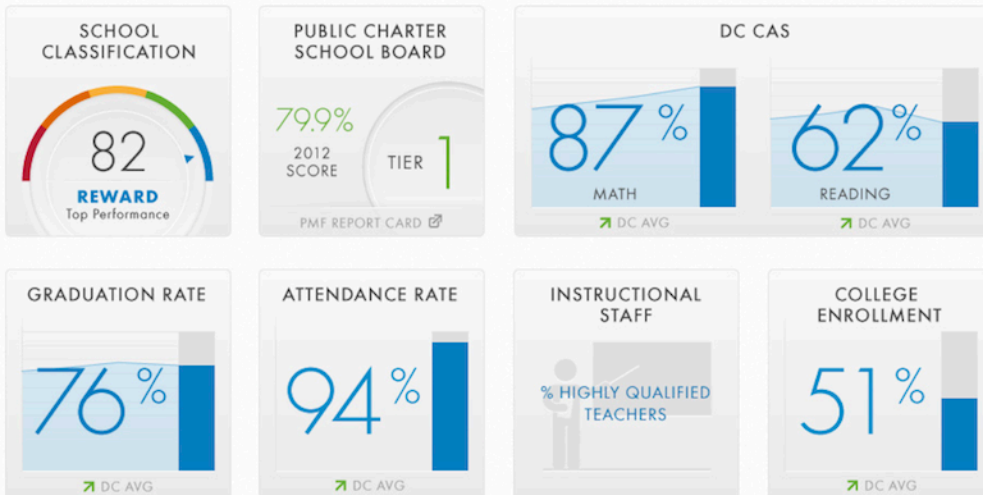

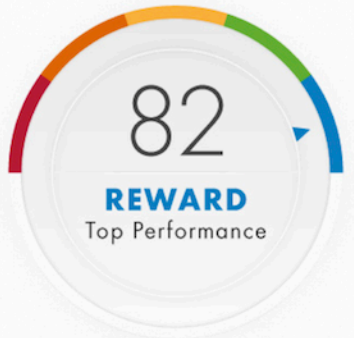

The DC school classification system includes multiple measures to evaluate performance and student growth. These measures include the DC CAS, annual growth, graduation rates, attendance rates and participation rates. Under the system, required under the [Elementary and Secondary Education Act \(ESEA\)](#), each school is given a [School Index Score](#) based on the performance of its students. Schools receive different levels of support, resources, flexibility and monitoring based on their [classification](#).



ABC High School is classified as a Reward school for top performance, which means:

- » The school demonstrates the highest levels of student performance, defined as a School Index Score of 80 and above.
- » The school receives public recognition, invitations to participate in special programs and is eligible for reward funding.

DC CAS

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The performance of DC students in grades 3–8 and 10 is measured using the [DC Comprehensive Assessment System \(DC CAS\)](#). This chart shows the percentage of students who were classified as [proficient](#) on the reading and mathematics tests. The most recent DC CAS results are on the right hand side of each chart. Previous years' results are included to show whether performance is increasing or decreasing. The orange line shows the average performance for all DC schools for comparison.
