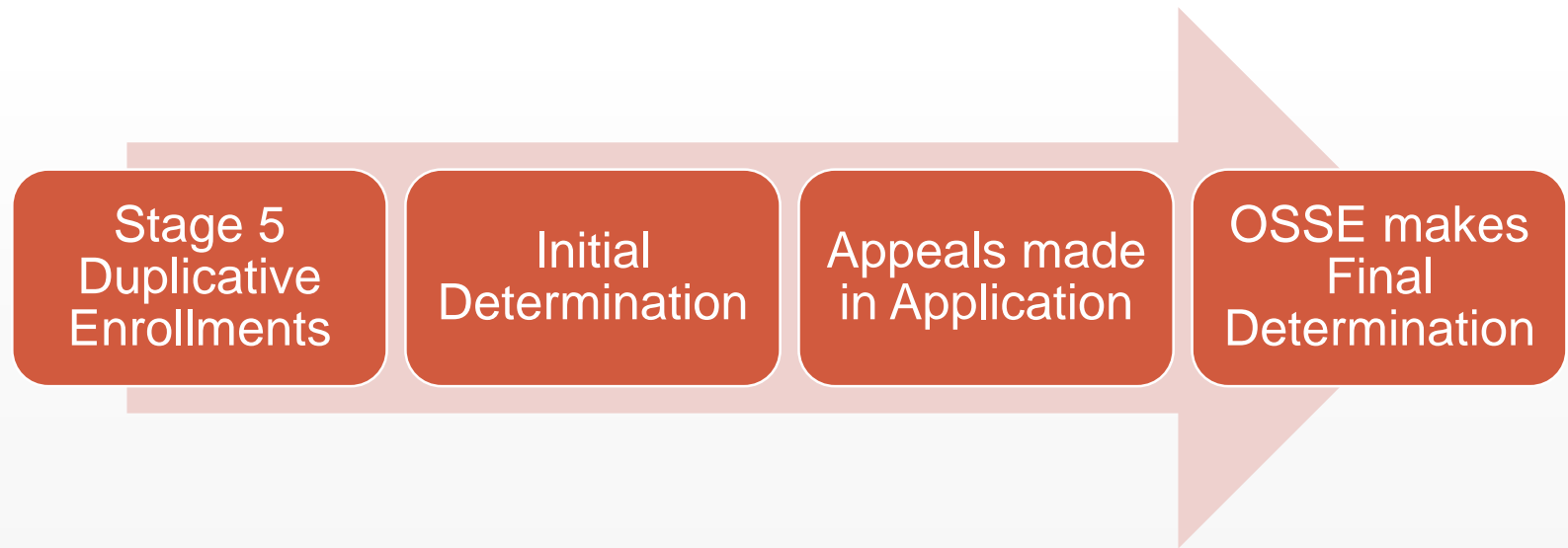


Duplicative Enrollment



Duplicative Enrollment Application

- The new duplicative enrollment resolution application supports the new duplicative enrollment policy.
- The application was released on Sept. 9th.
- The application receives stage 5 student duplicative enrollments from the SIS.



Frequently Asked Questions

Four duplicative enrollment application trainings were held. These are the most frequently asked questions (FAQs).

Q1: How will this impact my funding?

- The resolution of duplicative enrollments in the first period (which overlaps with the enrollment audit) will only have a positive impact on your funding by expediting the resolution process.
- Funding for Q2 will be based on unaudited numbers as it has been in the past; duplicative enrollments will continue to be excluded from the count entirely. However, if a duplicative enrollment is resolved through the de-duplication process prior to Oct 7, and neither LEA appeals the decision, then that student will be included in the count for the receiving school, whereas in the past they would have been excluded.

Q2: Do I still need to contact the other LEA to ask them to exit a student?

- This new process means that LEAs do not have to reach out to other LEAs to resolve duplicative enrollments. The application will also send email notifications throughout the process to remind LEAs to address the duplicative enrollments.

FAQs (cont.)

Q3: How does this impact Adult LEAs?

- The duplicative enrollment policy has not changed for adult LEAs.
- The only change to the process is that this year they will upload their documentation for appeals into the duplicative enrollment application instead of in the enrollment audit application.

Q4: Does this process resolve stage 4 and stage 5 enrollments?

- No. This process only addresses stage 4 versus stage 5 enrollments.

Q5: When can appeals be submitted?

- If an appeal was rejected or partially accepted, the appeal window will open on Oct 14. Until then, the dropdown menu will not be available in the application.

Q6: What documents can be used to appeal?

- The Duplicative Enrollment Resolution Policy lists the acceptable documents.

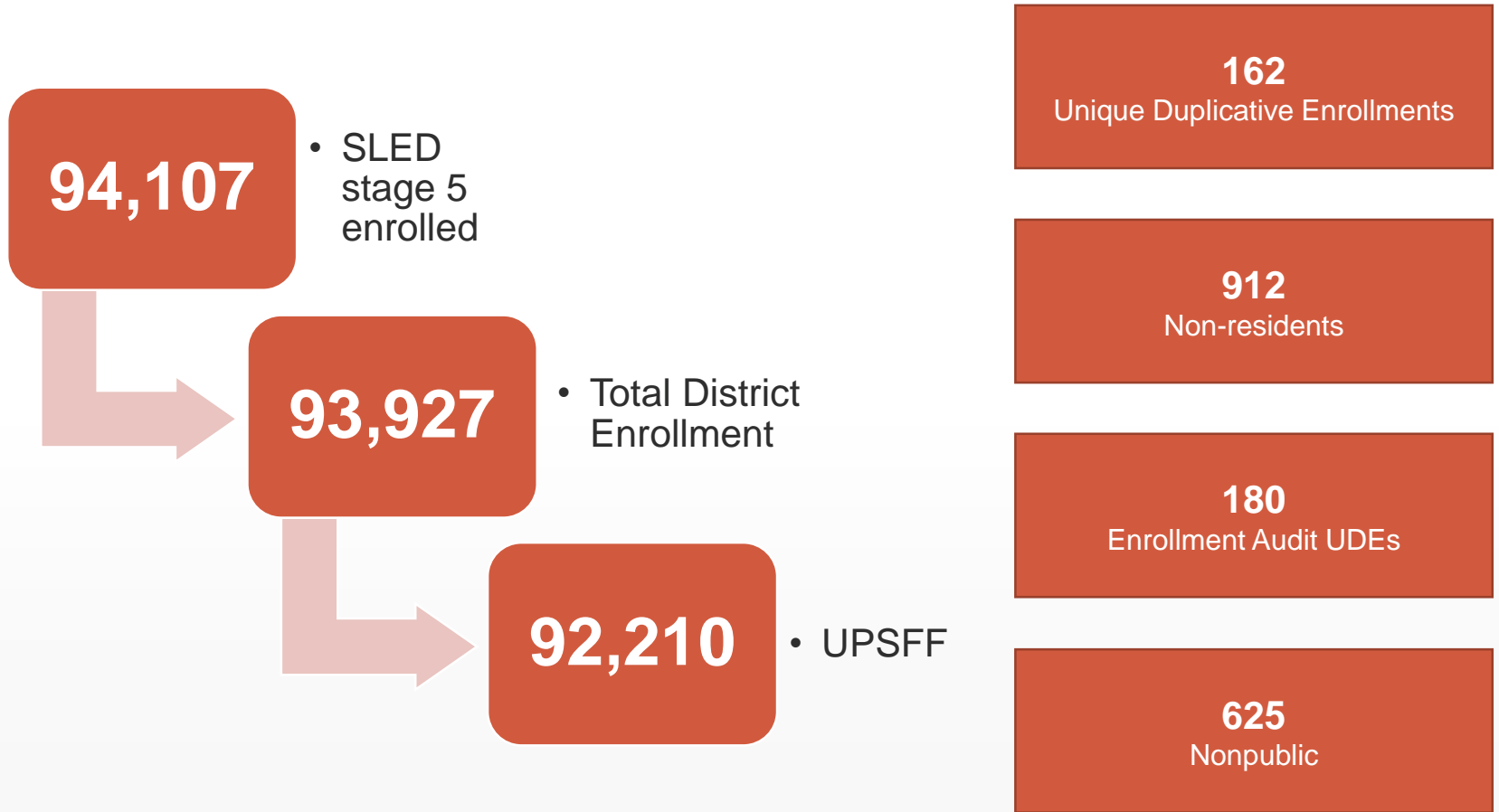

School-Level Access to Comprehensive Homeless Qlik Application

- This year, OSSE will provide **school-level access to the Comprehensive Homeless Qlik application**.
 - This application allows users to see homeless identifications from The Community Partnership to Prevent Homelessness (TCP) data.
- In order for school-level Homeless Liaisons to be have access to the application, LEA Data Managers must list them with **role “Homeless Liaison” in eSchoolPlus** and their SLED access must be current.
- The application will be released by **October 15, 2019**.

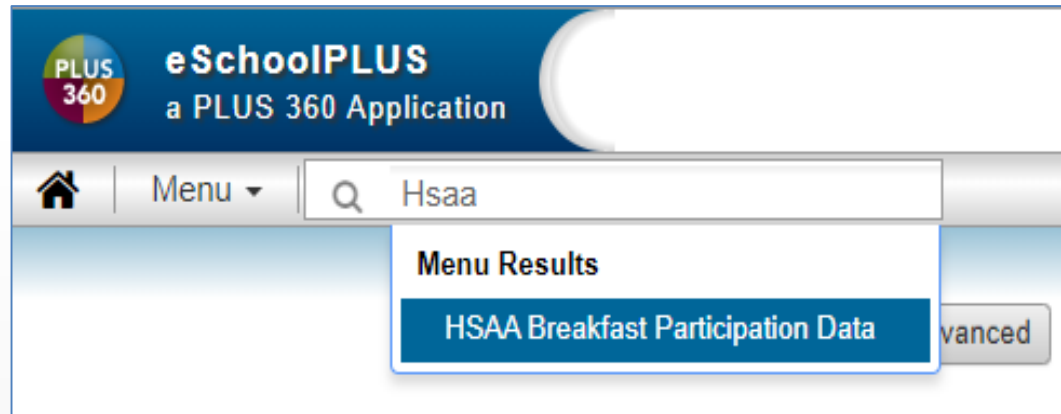


HSAA Breakfast Participation Data

- School Breakfast Program (SBP) is a federally funded meal program operating in public, public charter, and nonprofit private schools as well as residential child care institutions (RCCIs).
- OSSE will collect monthly breakfast counts at the school-level
 - **Months:** Sept. to May
 - **Collection:** In eSchoolPLUS
- **Business owner:** Division of Health and Wellness

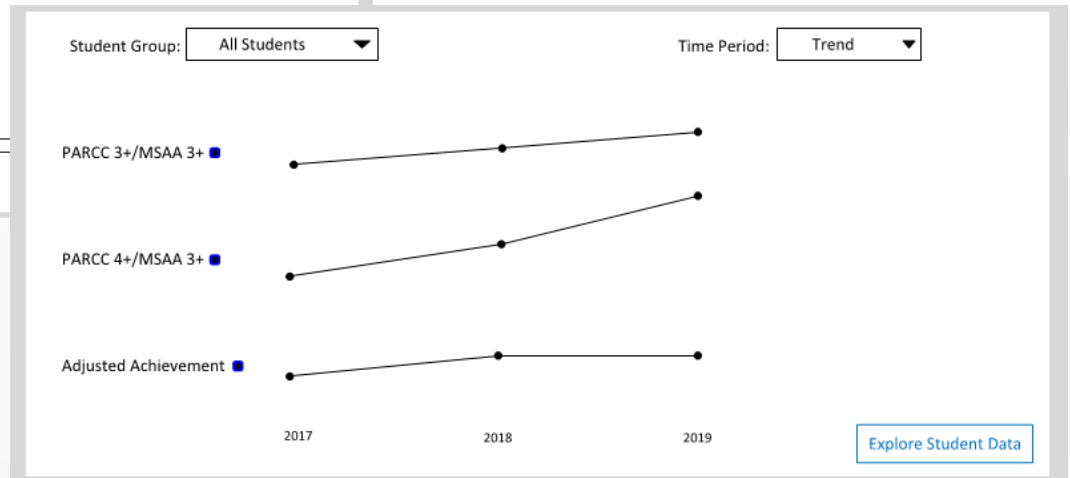

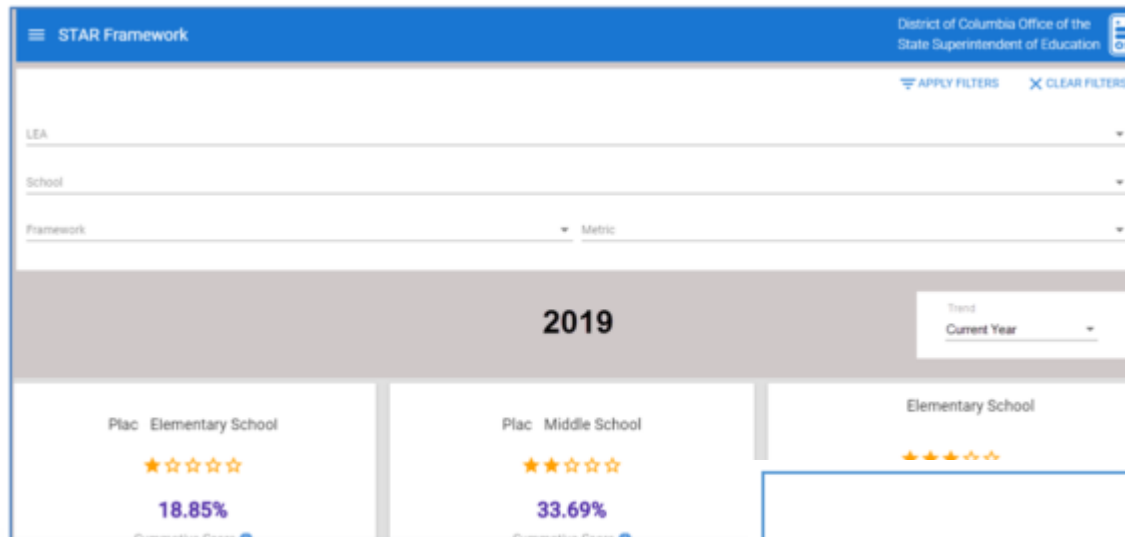


Figure 4: Mockup of School Year on Lane

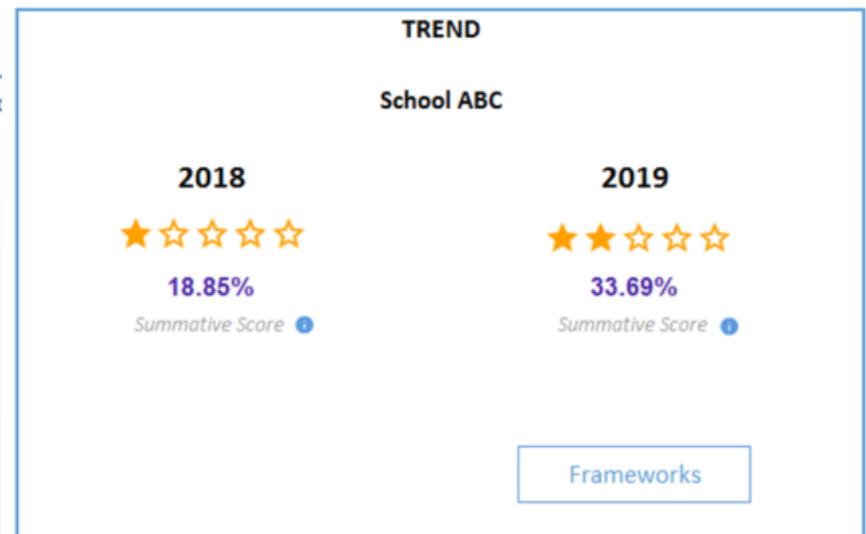


Figure 5: Mockup of a Trend School Card

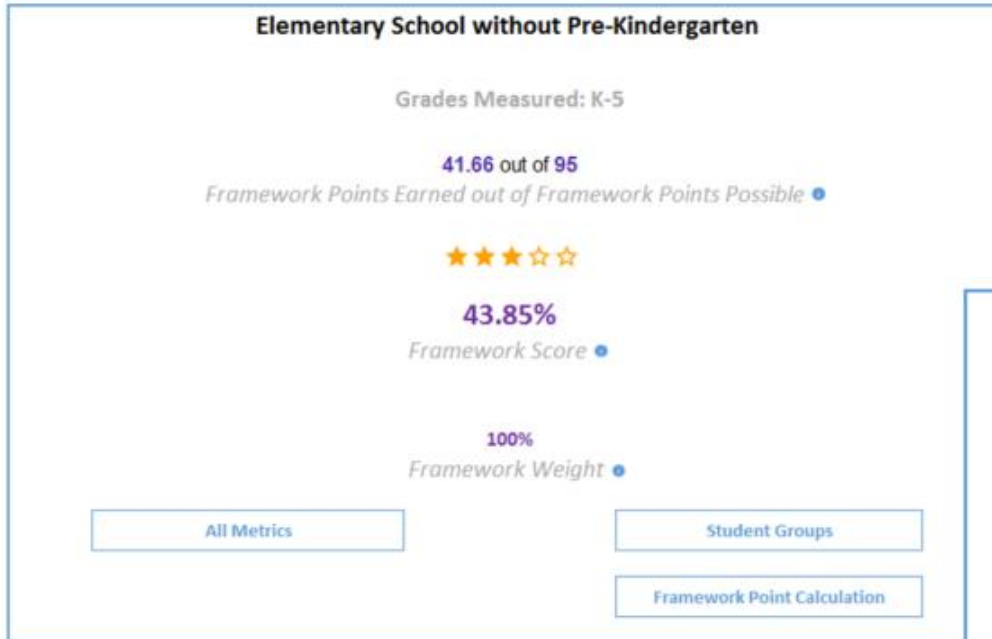


Figure 7: Mockup of Framework Card for a School

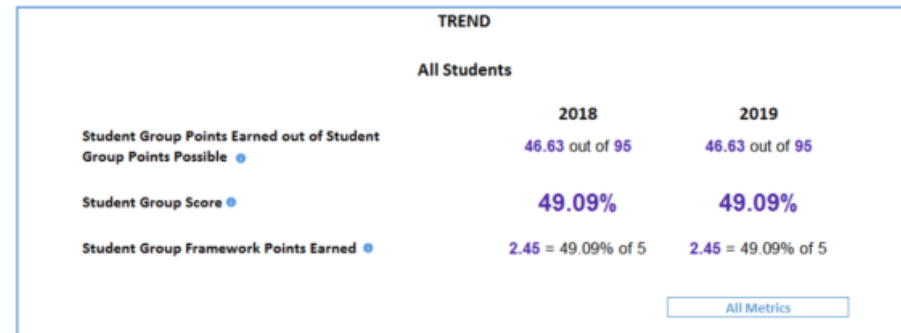
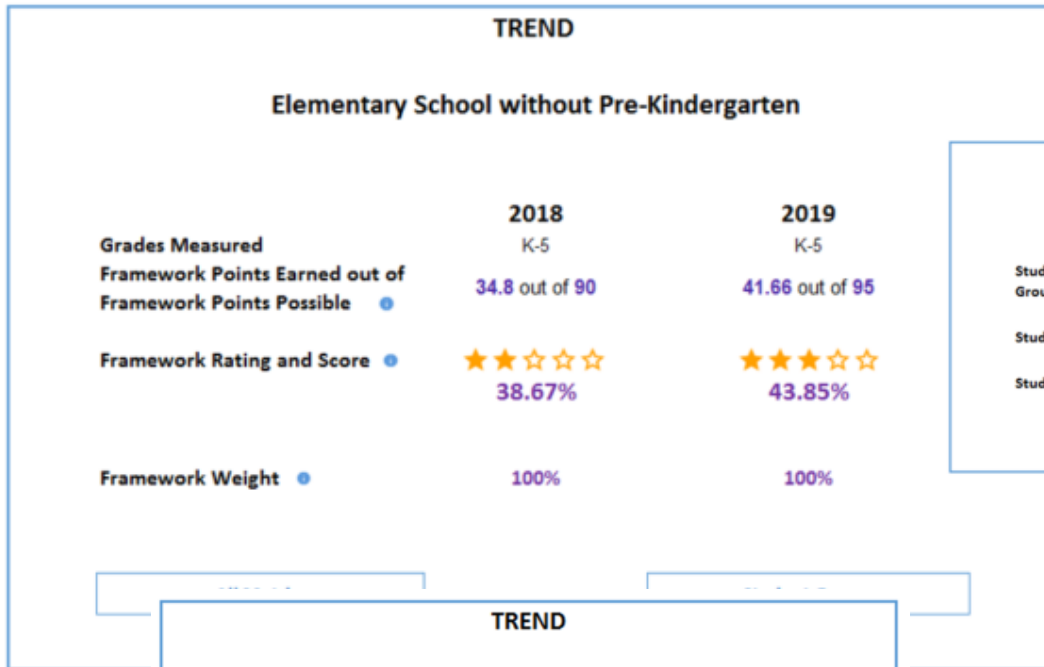


Figure 12: Mockup of a Trend Student Group Card

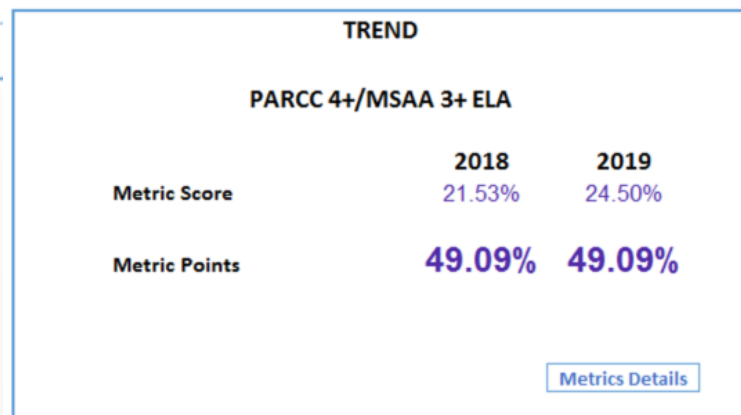


Figure 15: Mockup of a Trend Metric Card

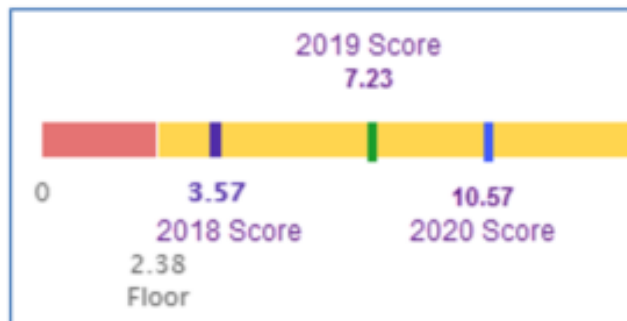
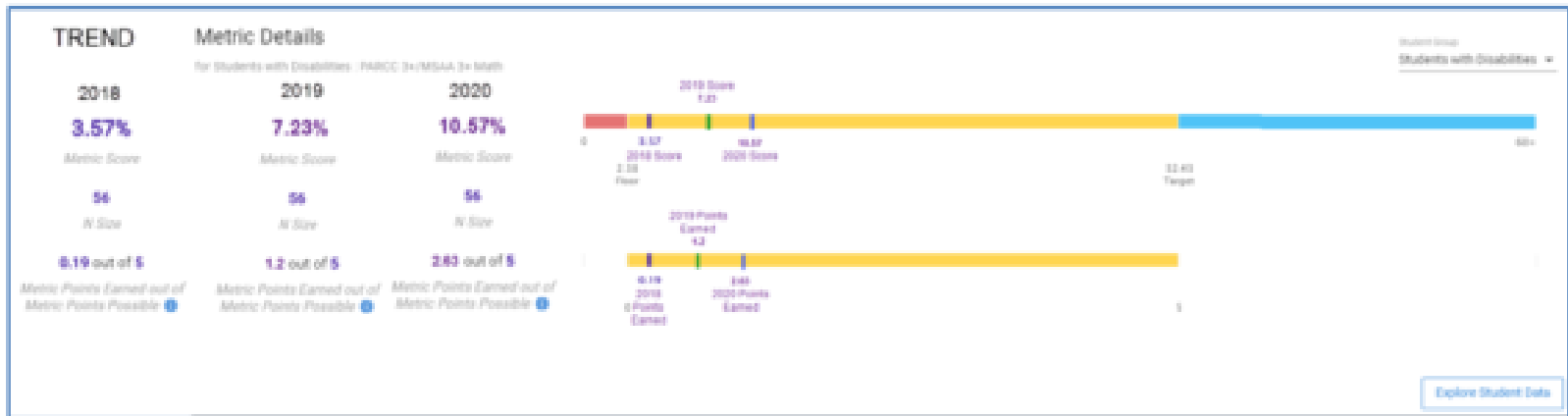


Figure 21: Mockup of Metric Score Bar
