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## **Essential Distance Education Webinar Series**

Webinar 1, "Ready, Set, Go" maps key steps in getting started with remote distance education. Wednesday, Sept. 9, 2020 2 – 3 pm ET

Webinar 2, "Recruitment, Screening, & Orientation" introduces the importance of developing strong recruitment, screening and orientation practices in distance programs; we offer guidance on how to do this completely at a distance. Wednesday, Sept. 16,, 2020 2 – 3 pm ET

Webinar 3, the final webinar, "Instruction and Assessment" shares strategies for providing instruction, support, and assessing learners in distance education. Wednesday, Sept. 23, 2020 2 – 3 pm ET





Self-paced, multimedia introductory courses; approximately three hours each to complete. Learners can self-enroll and are automatically awarded a certificate of completion.

#### Introduction to Open Educational Resources

This course introduces participants to essential information about Open Educational Resources (OERs), including key definitions, examples and reflective activities presented in multimedia format. The goal of the course is for teachers to understand the benefits of using OERs, know where to find them, and how to evaluate them.

#### Introduction to Mobile Learning

Participants in this course learn about integrating mobile devices into their classroom, distance, or blended instruction. It includes definitions, suggested strategies, examples, and reflective activities. The goal of the course is for teachers to have an understanding of the different ways adult learners and their teachers can use flip-phones, smartphones and tablets for learning both in and out of the classroom.

#### **Introduction to Blended Learning**

This course presents foundational information about blended learning, including definitions, strategies, examples, and reflective activities presented in multimedia format. The goal of the course is for participants to have a basic understanding of the different forms of blended learning and how they might integrate them into coursework.
