Systems and Supports, K-12

- 1. Open and log into the Enterprise Grants Management System (EGMS).
- 2. Once logged in, click GMS Access/Select.
- 3. Confirm the filter year is set to the current application cycle (ex: "2024"). Search by name or scroll to locate 21st Century.



4. Confirm the grant and grant type are accurate, then click the year (ex: "2024") to open the application.
