Capital Quality supports continuous professional development for early childhood education professionals, informs subsidy rates and provides information for families.

Enrollment

- License issued
- Facilities that have a Provider Agreement for Subsidized Child Care Services with OSSE are automatically enrolled in Capital Quality, but all licensed child development facilities are encouraged to participate
- Quality facilitator is assigned



Quality Facilitation

- Receive technical assistance to help understand the observations, Infant/Toddler Environment Rating Scale-Revised (ITERS-R), Family Child Care Environment Rating Scale-Revised (FCCERS-R) and/or Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS)
- Participate in communities of practice (CoP)
- Develop continuous quality improvement plan



Observations

- Trained, independent contractors conduct the CLASS, ITERS-R and FCCERS-R observations in each facility
- Facilities receive program-level score reports
- Facility is assigned its Capital Quality designation based on the results of the CLASS, ITERS-R or FCCERS-R
- Capital Quality designation will be posted on mychildcaredc.org



Continuous Quality Improvement

- Monitor, track and measure your progress toward your goals
- Revise goals or set new goals as needed



Quality Facilitation

- Receive targeted coaching, professional development, trainings and resources to help your program achieve its quality improvement objectives
