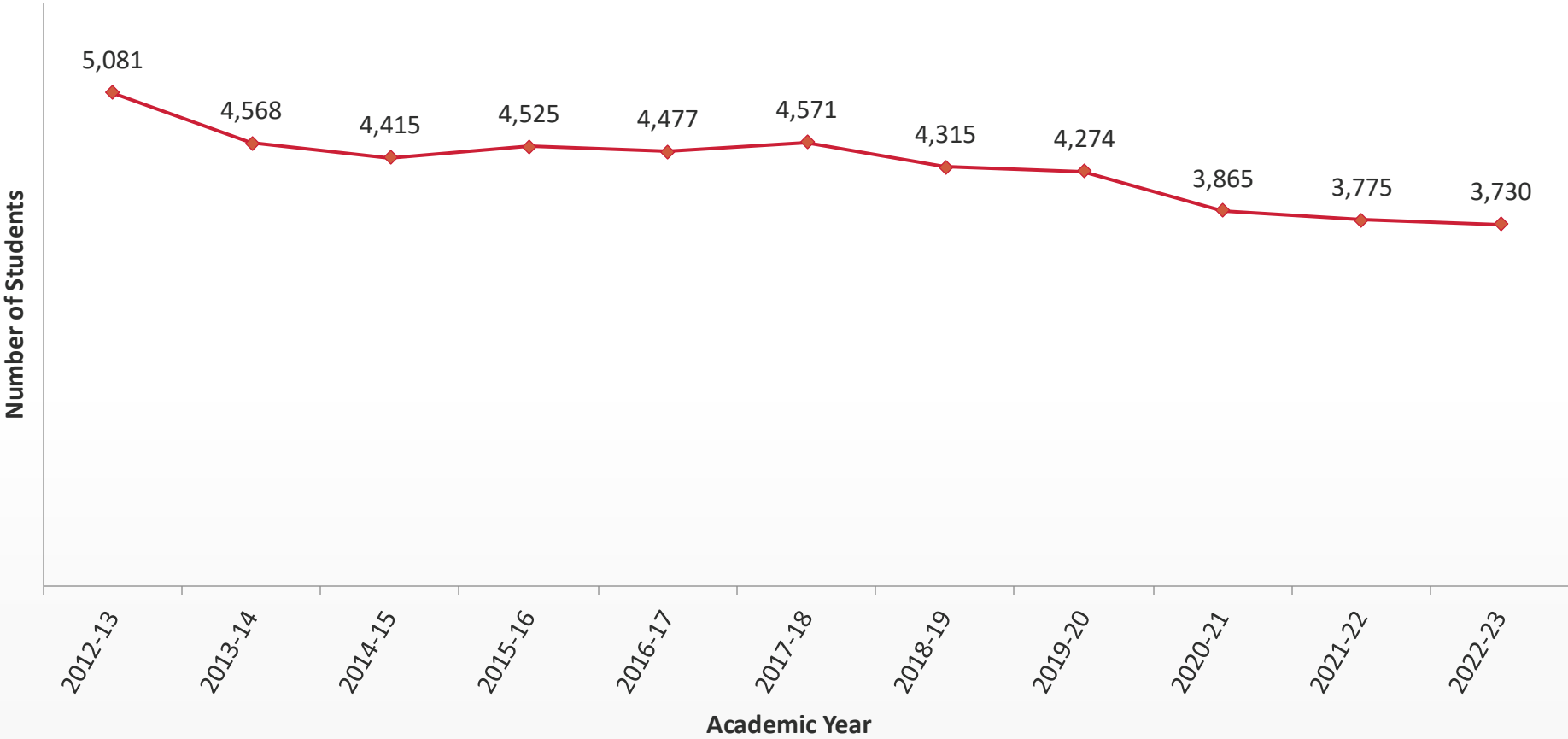

# DCTAG Accomplishments

Since the first DCTAG awards were made in 2000,\* the program has provided nearly 36,000 total awards for students to enroll at more than 700 institutions across 50 states, the District of Columbia and the US Virgin Islands.

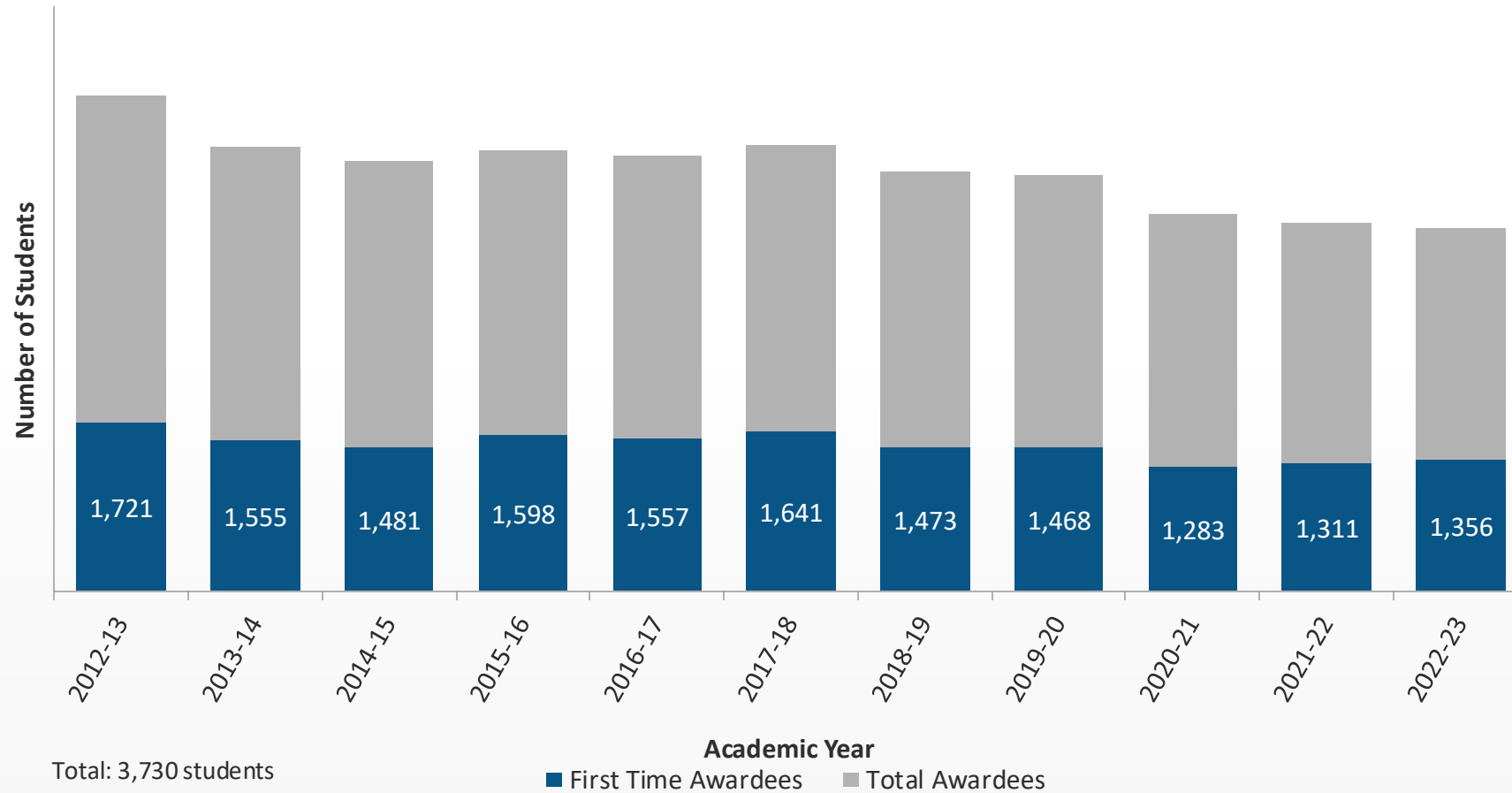


# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Award Year



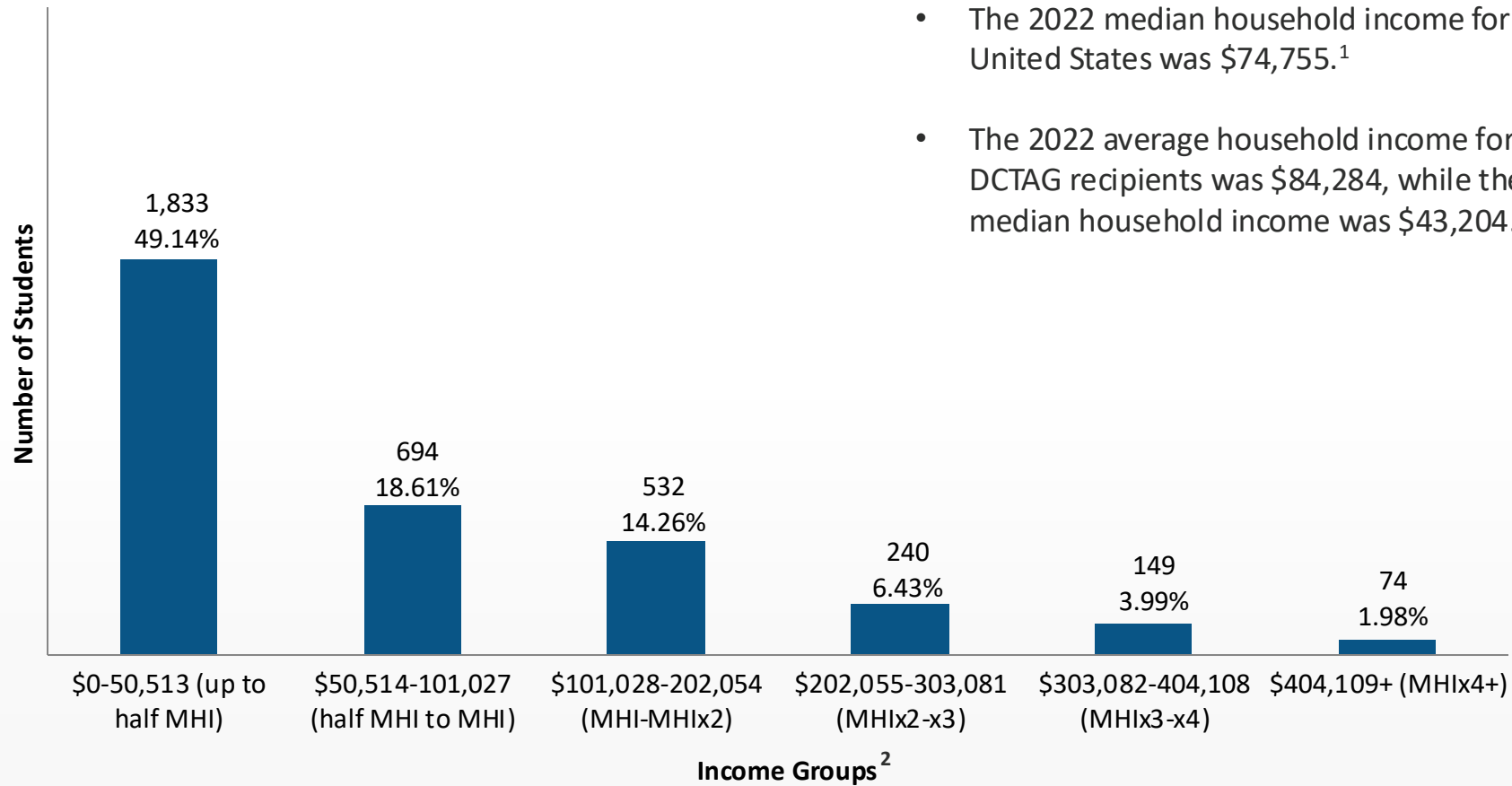
# Students Awarded DCTAG, by First Time Status

# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Household Income (AY 2022-23)

- The 2022 median household income (MHI) for the District of Columbia was \$101,027.<sup>1</sup>
- The 2022 median household income for the United States was \$74,755.<sup>1</sup>
- The 2022 average household income for DCTAG recipients was \$84,284, while the median household income was \$43,204.

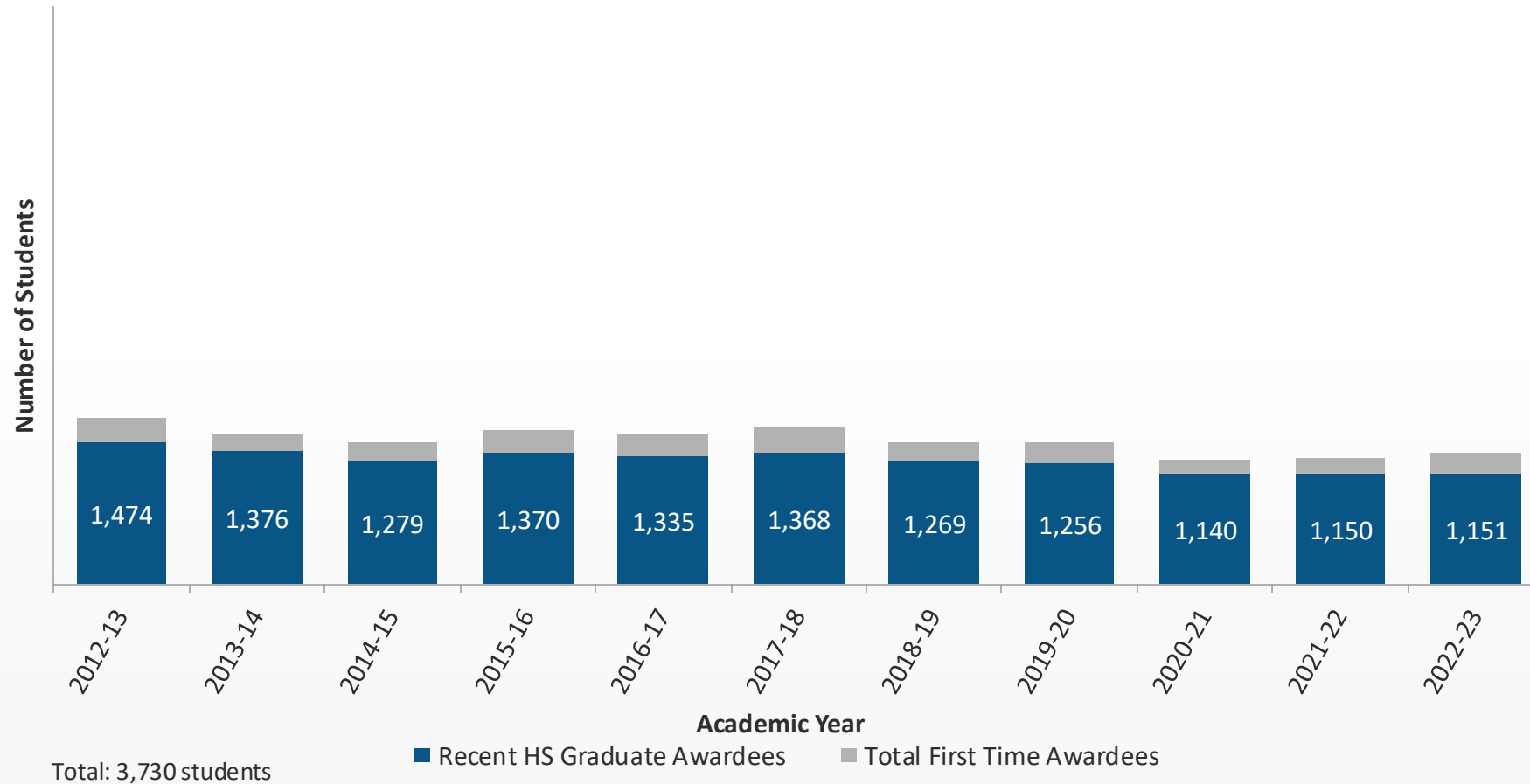

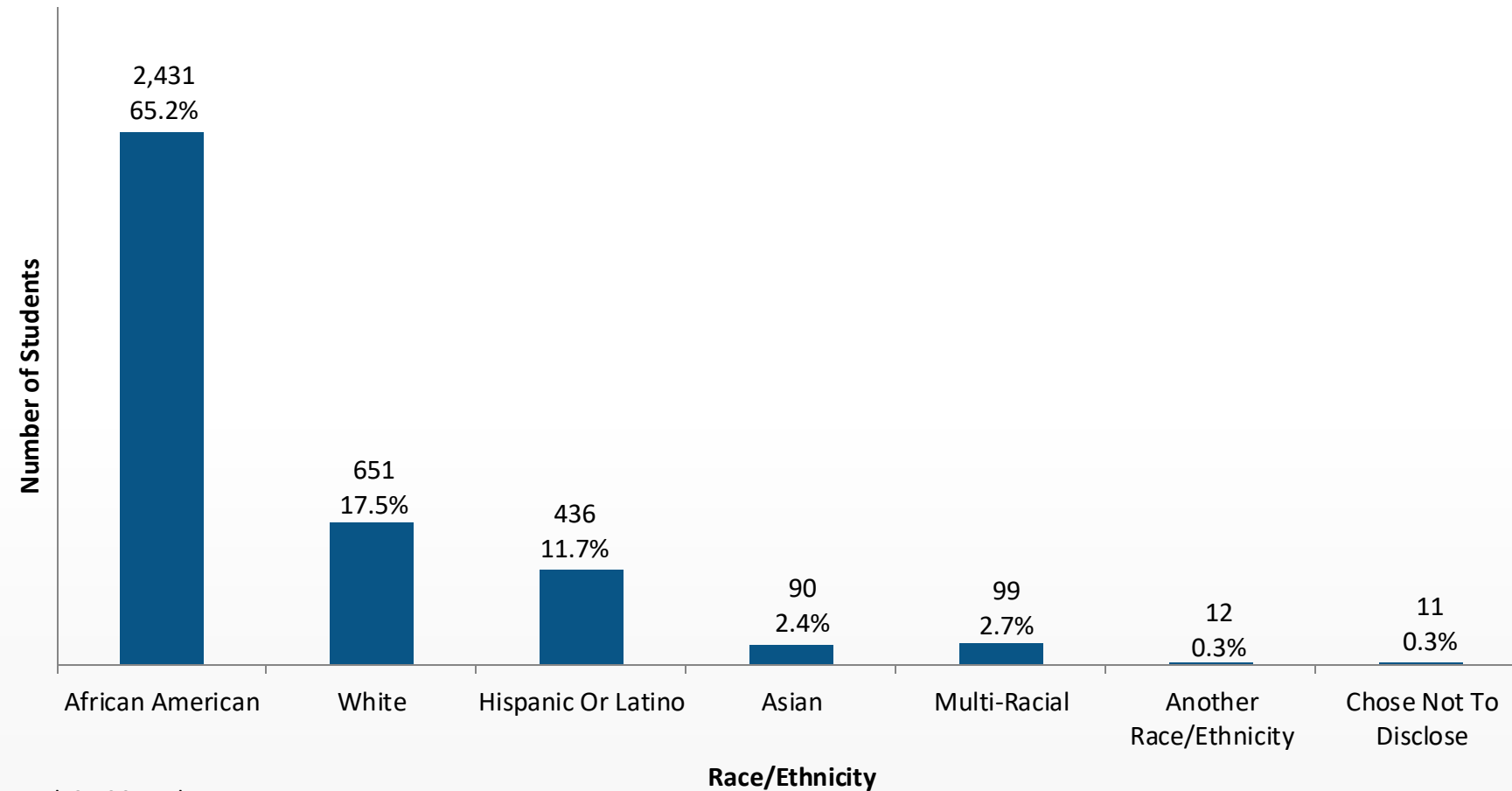

This graph shows the number of DCTAG first-time awardees in the given academic year who graduated from high school in the previous academic year.



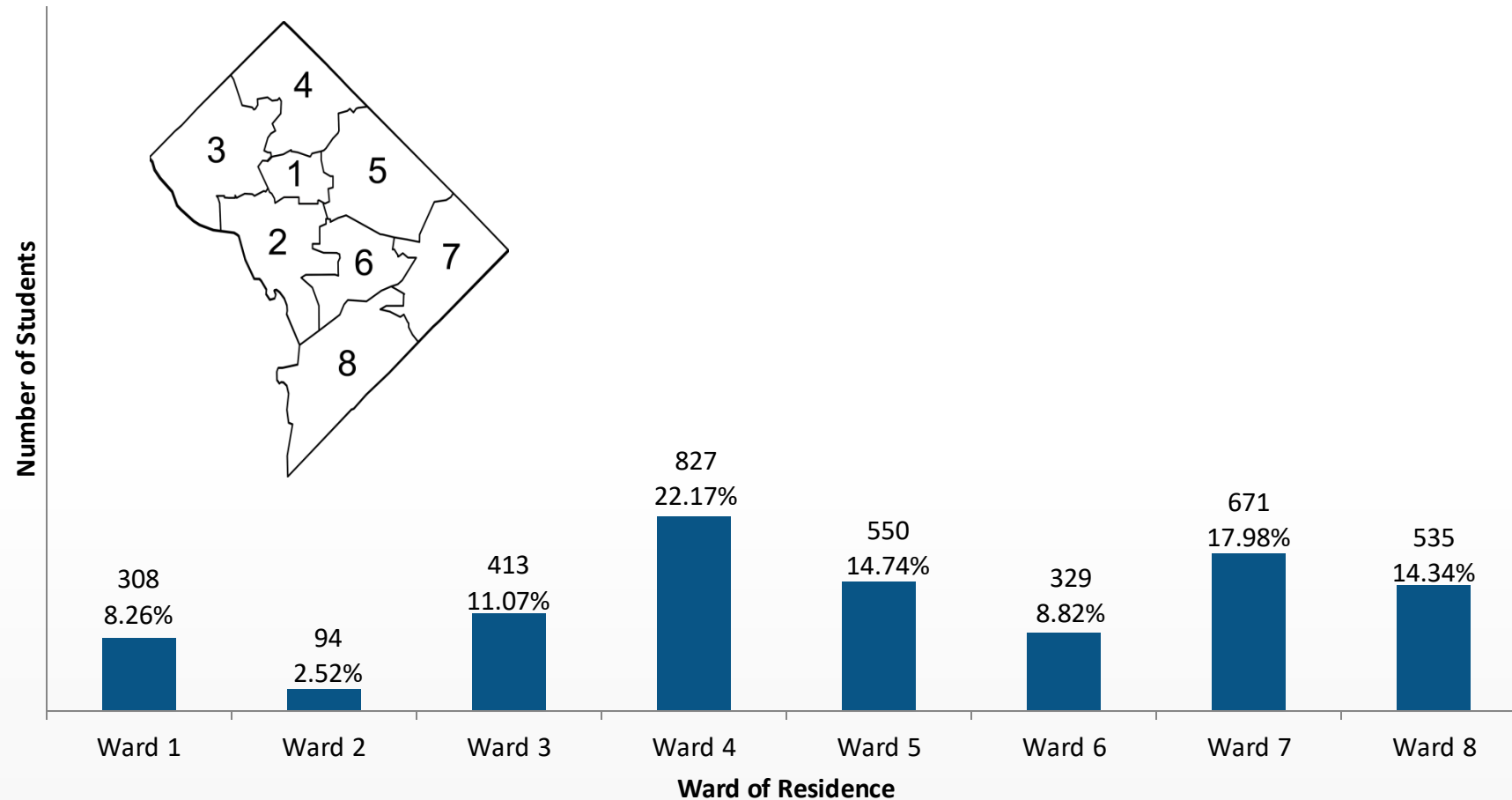
# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Race/Ethnicity (AY 2022-23)

# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Ward (AY 2022-23)



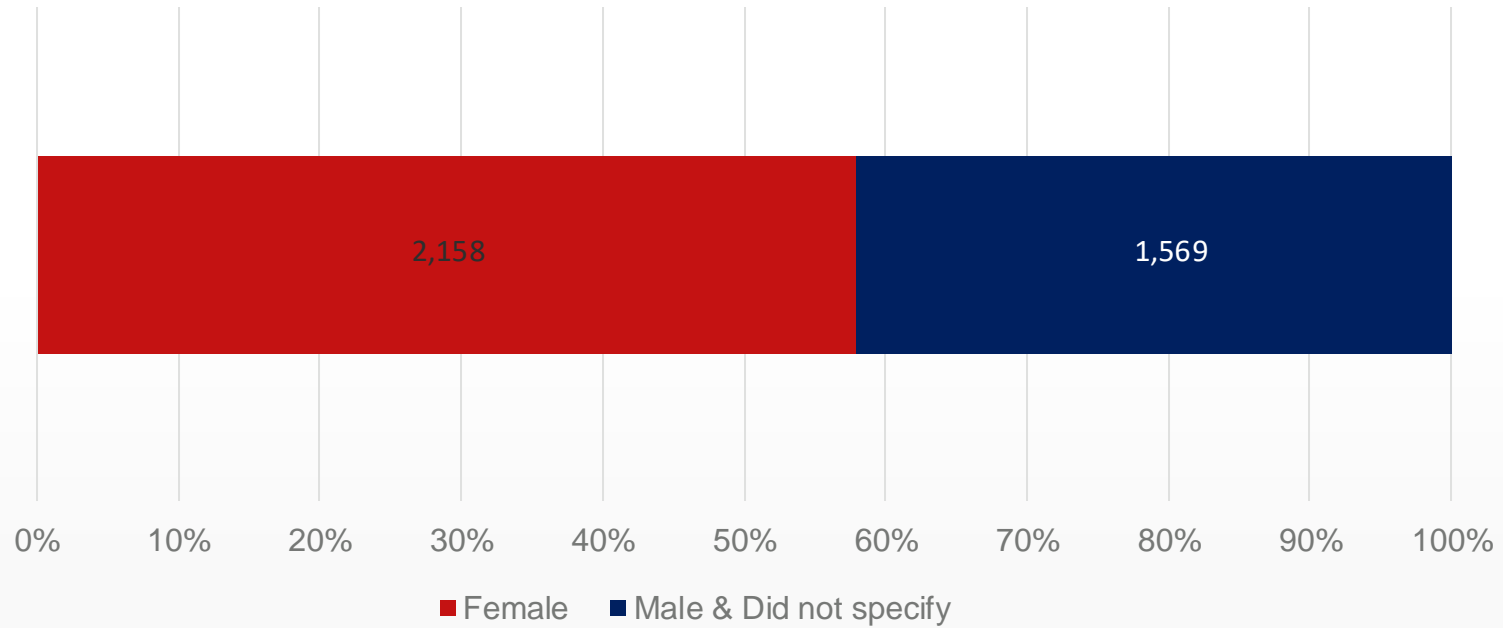

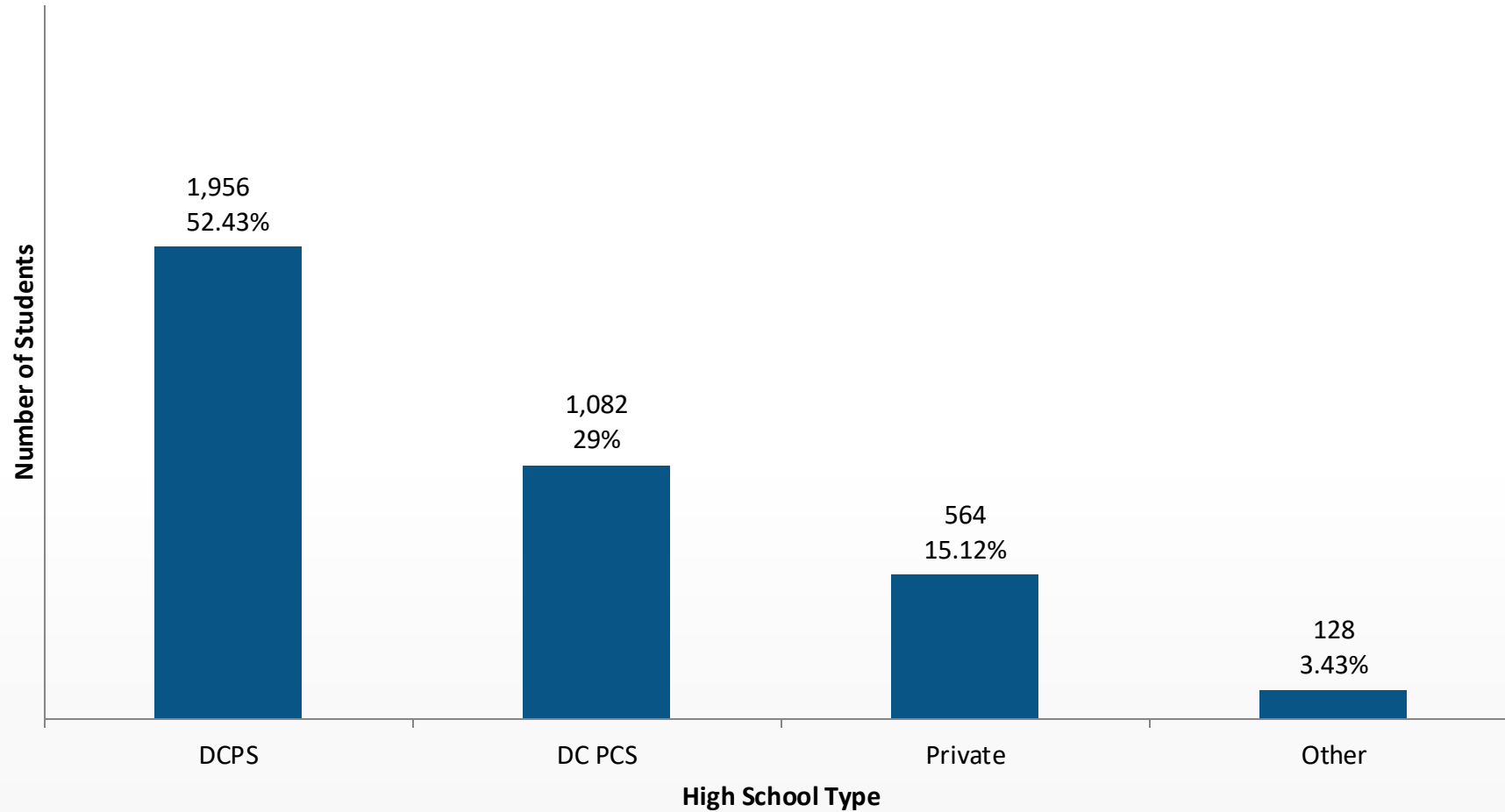


# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Gender (AY 2022-23)



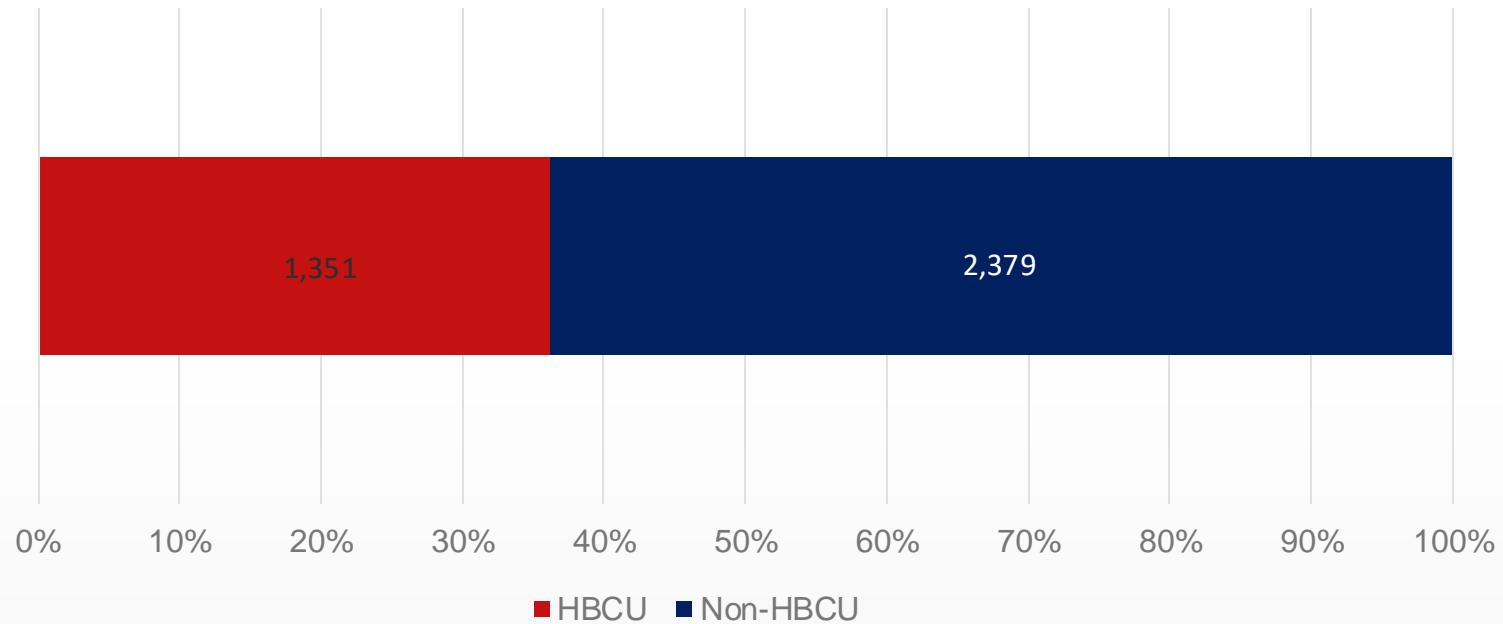

# Students Awarded DCTAG, by High School Type (AY 2022-23)



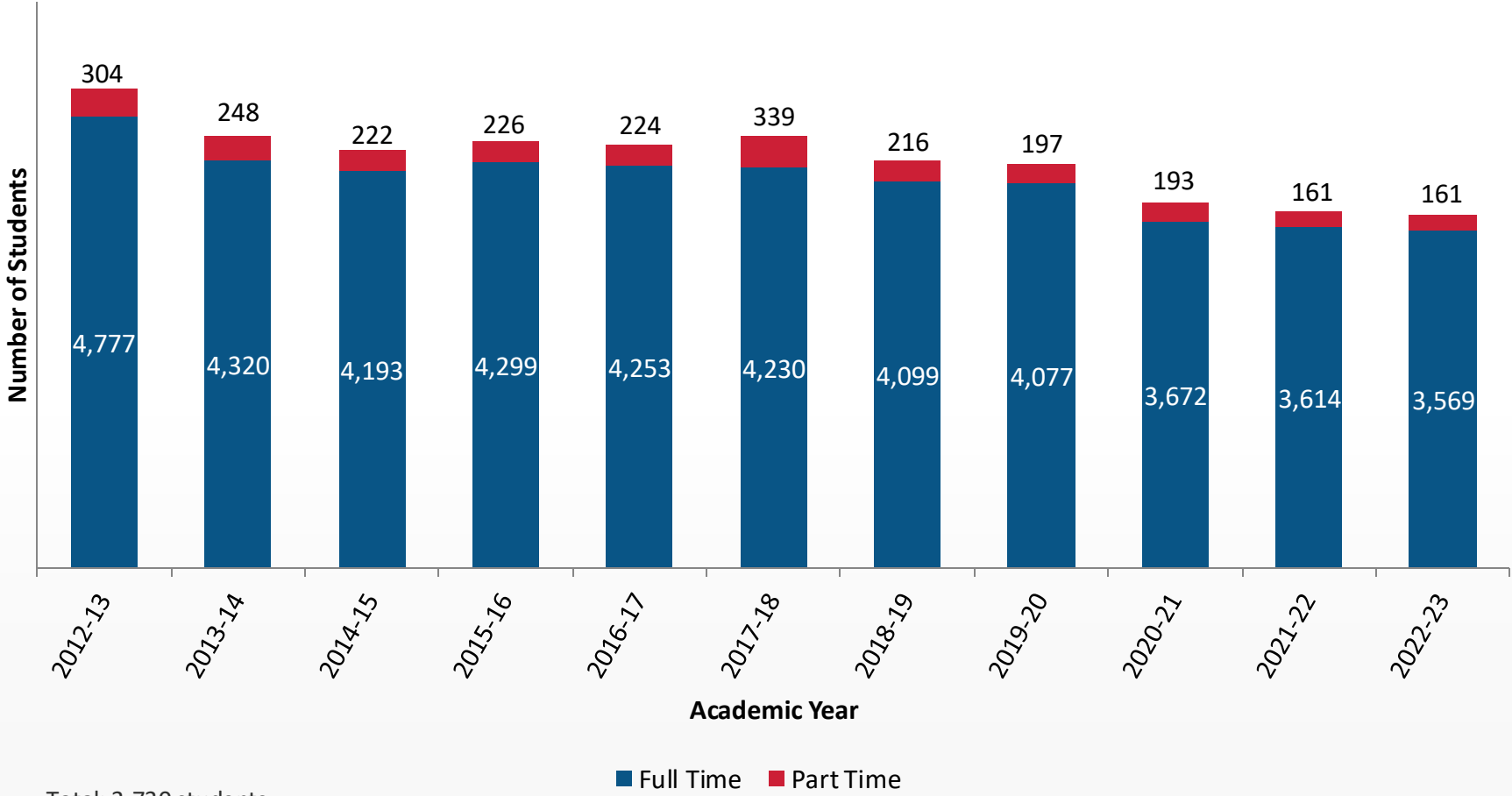

# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Institution's HBCU Status (AY 2022-23)

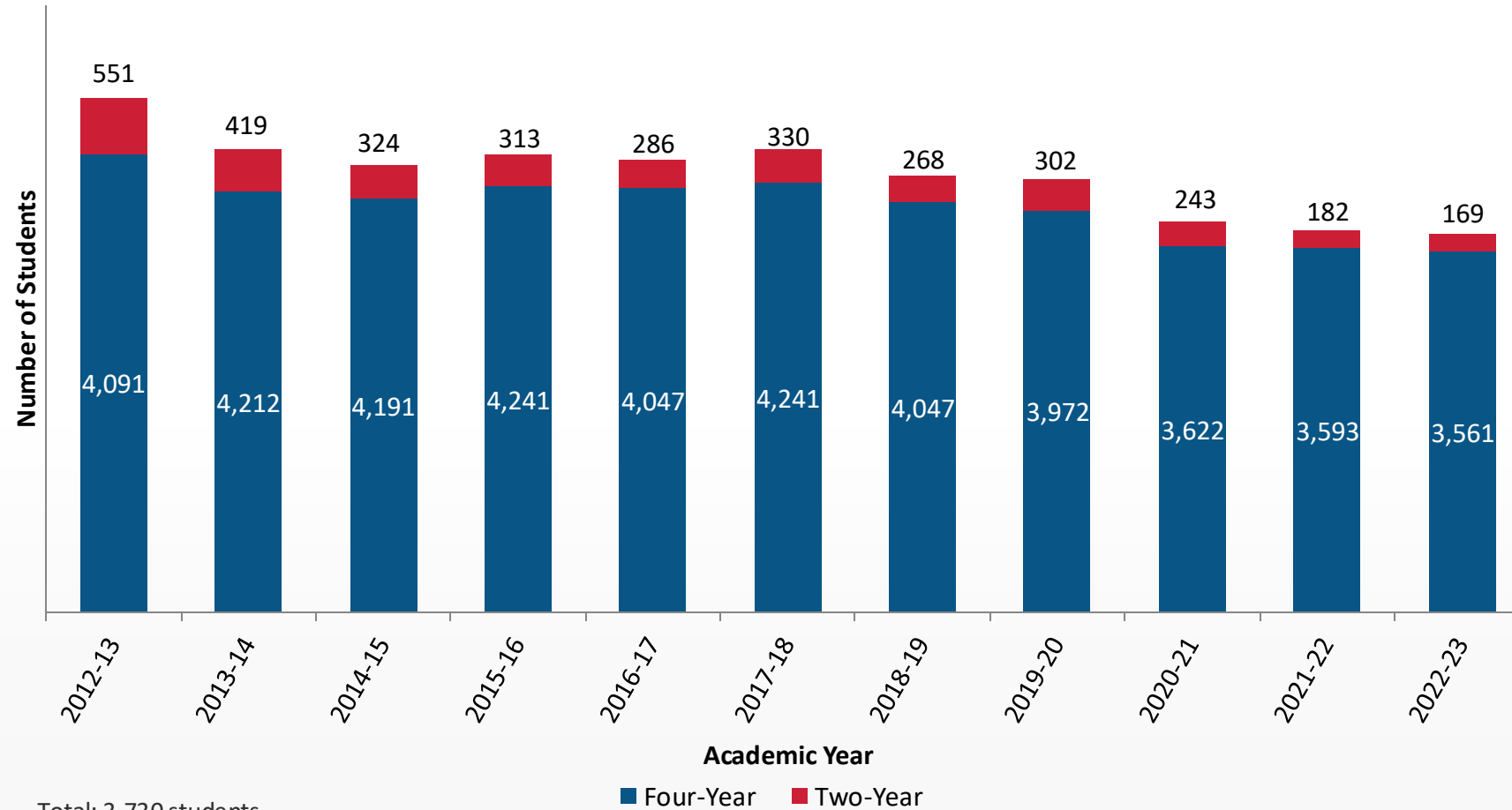

# Students Awarded DCTAG, by Level of Institution



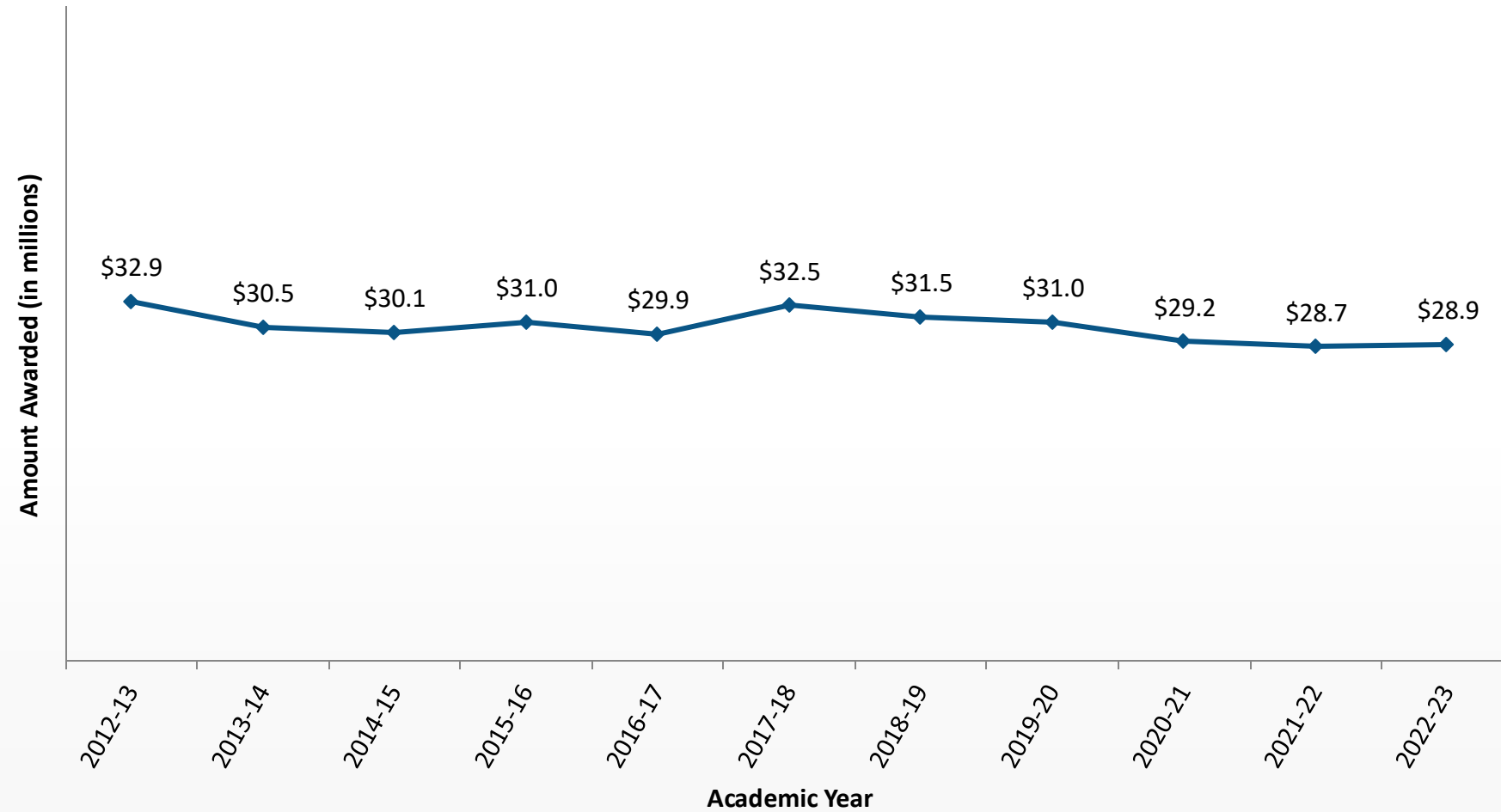

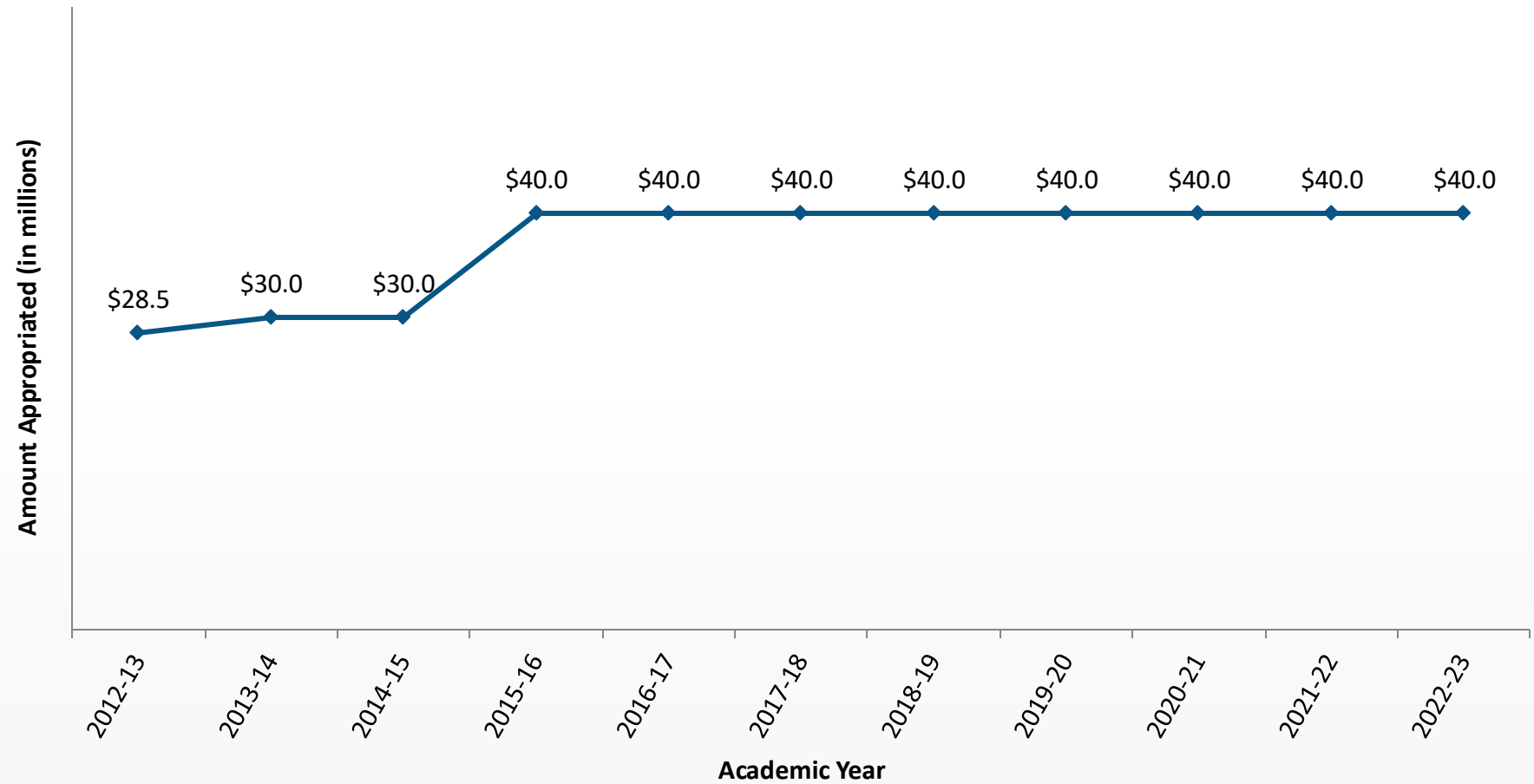

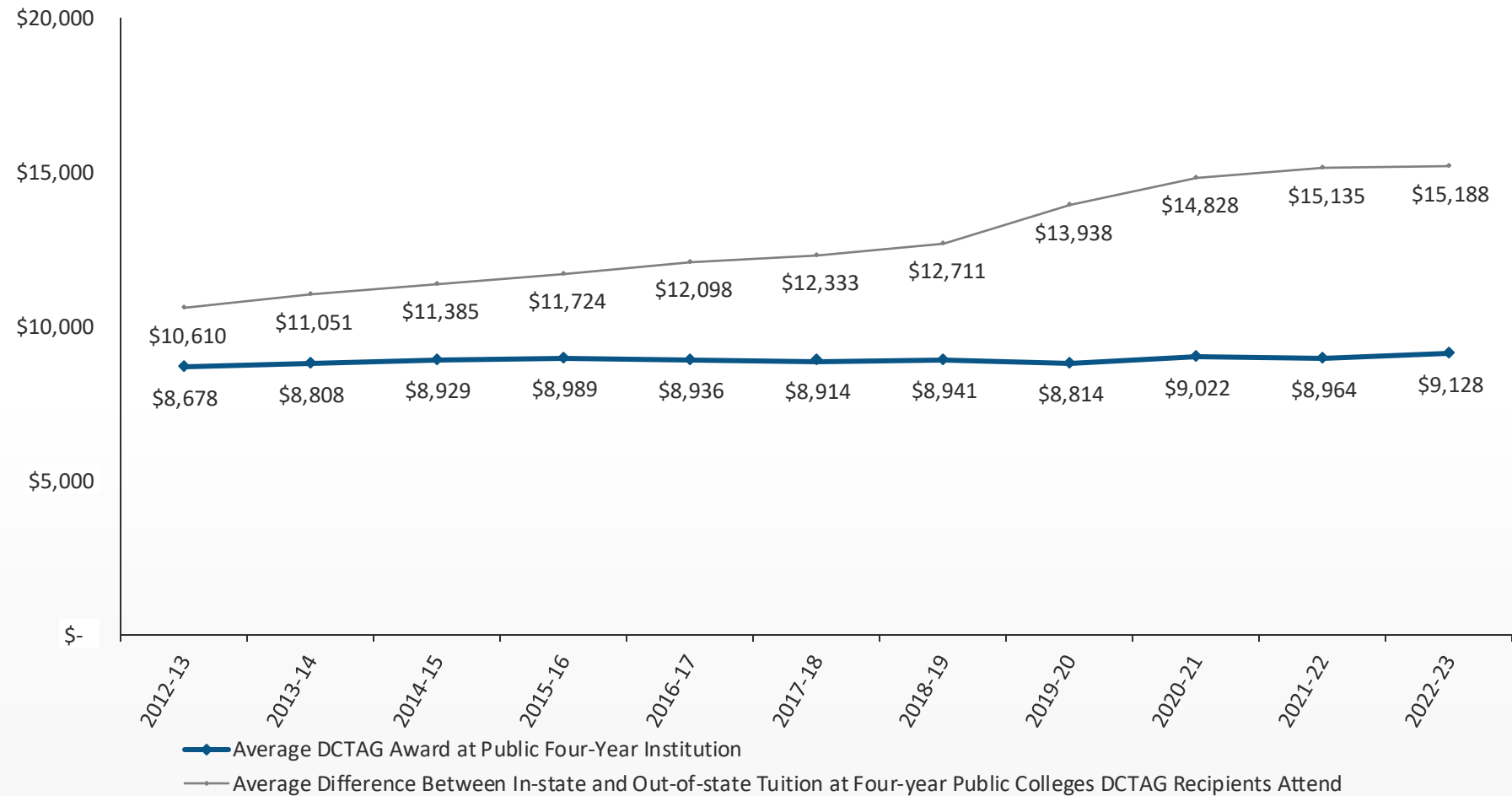

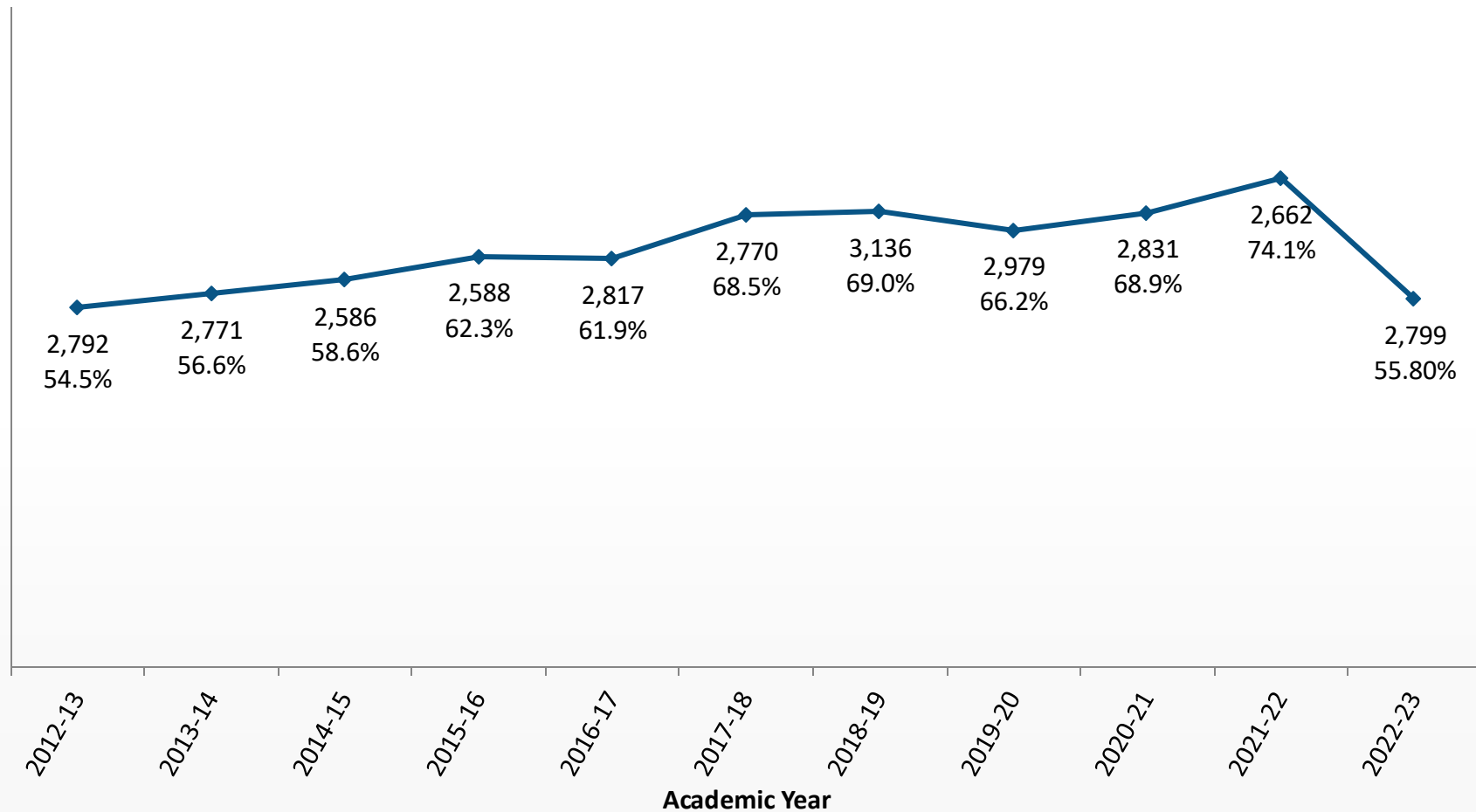




# Average Award at Public Four-Year Institutions

# DCTAG Policy Changes Relevant to Data Presented

- As of AY 2024
  - An age requirement change for DCTAG recipients now allows for a 15-year period since graduation to maintain eligibility to receive the DCTAG Award.
- As of AY 2019-20
  - Income threshold lowered to \$500,000 for students beginning their undergraduate course of study in AY 2019-20 onward.
