

DAILY COVID-19 SCREENING QUESTIONS FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN ATTENDING CHILD CARE

Answer each question below (1-4) to determine whether your child is able to attend child care today.

If any of your responses to 1-4 led to “They must not attend child care today” or “They should not attend child care today,” talk to your child care provider to learn when your child should return to care.

If no responses led to that outcome, your child is able to attend child care today.

1. Is your child experiencing symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19)?

↳ Has your child tested negative for COVID-19 since the symptoms began?

Has a healthcare provider provided written or verbal documentation that those specific symptoms are not due to COVID-19?

YES NO → They must not attend child care today.

2. Is your child awaiting a COVID-19 test result after experiencing symptoms of COVID-19?

NO YES → They must not attend child care today.

3. Has your child tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 10 days?

↳ Is your child younger than age 2?

NO YES → They must not attend child care today.



Has it been at least five days since your child tested positive?

YES NO → They must not attend child care today.



Have your child’s symptoms improved?

YES NO → They must not attend child care today.



Is your child able to wear a well-fitting mask?

YES NO → They must not attend child care today.

4. Within the past 10 days, has your child had close contact with someone who is confirmed to have COVID-19?

↳ Has your child had COVID-19 and recovered in the last 90 days?

Is your child up to date on COVID-19 vaccination?¹

Is your child younger than age 2?

NO YES → They should not attend child care today.



Has it been at least five days since your child’s last exposure to the COVID-19 positive individual?

YES NO → They should not attend child care today.



Is your child able to wear a well-fitting mask?

YES NO → They should not attend child care today.



Did your child have symptoms throughout the five-day quarantine period?

NO YES → Your child must not attend child care today.

¹ The following are considered up to date on their COVID-19 vaccine:

- People 5 and older who have received all recommended vaccine doses, including booster doses as applicable.
- Children age 6 months- 4 years who have completed their primary vaccine series at least two weeks ago.
