## District of Columbia Students Experiencing Homelessness – Enrollment School Year 2022-23

The Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) is federally required to annually post the number of enrolled children and youth identified as experiencing homelessness in public schools in the District of Columbia.

The data below reflect the number of students who experienced homelessness during a specified school year. Students are included in these reports if, at any point during those school years, they were determined to be experiencing homelessness and enrolled in school. Children and youth who were not enrolled in school are not included in this report.

### Definition

A person experiencing homelessness, as defined by the US Department of Education, is an individual who “lacks fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.” Unlike the Department of Housing and Urban Development, this definition includes individuals who are “doubled-up,” meaning that they are staying with friends and family out of economic necessity. Please note that the homeless designation is cumulative for the school year, meaning that if the student was homeless for even one night of the school year, they are considered homeless for the entire school year.

### Statewide Count for District of Columbia– All Students

A unique count of students who experienced homelessness during the 2022-23 school year.

### Statewide Count for District of Columbia–Compulsory-Aged Students

A unique count of compulsory-aged students (age 5-17 on Sept. 30, 2022) who experienced homelessness during the 2022-23 school year.

### Count by Local Education Agency (LEA)

A count of students who experienced homelessness during the 2022-23 school year, regardless of age. These counts include students at each LEA they attended, so students who experienced homelessness who attended multiple LEAs will be counted multiple times. LEAs not listed did not serve any students identified as experiencing homelessness during the 2022-23 school year.
