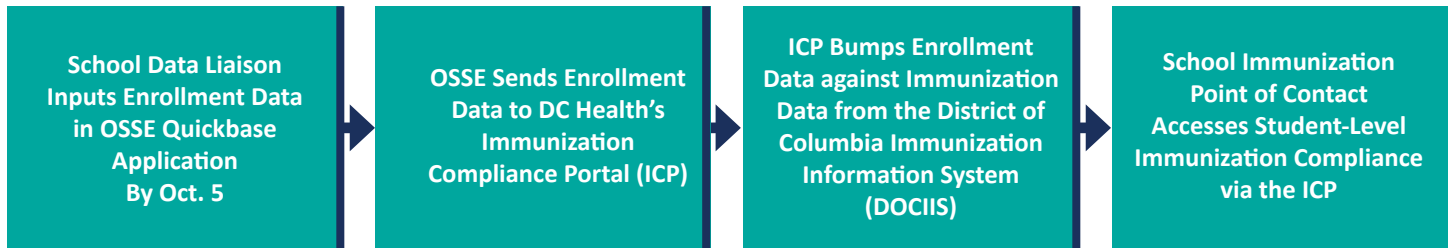




# DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION POLICY

## ENROLLMENT AND IMMUNIZATION DATA FLOW BETWEEN Private, Parochial and Independent Schools, OSSE and DC Health

This resource outlines the process whereby private, parochial and independent schools submit enrollment data to the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE). The enrollment data are then sent by OSSE to DC Health in order to create each school's roster of students in the Immunization Compliance Portal (ICP).



After private, parochial and independent schools submit their enrollment to OSSE via the Quickbase application, OSSE reviews the submission to ensure it is complete and there are no errors. If OSSE identifies errors, your school's data liaison will be contacted to review and correct the submission. When OSSE has determined the submission is correct and complete, the enrollment data will be fed from OSSE to DC Health's ICP and DOCIIS to identify student-level immunization compliance.

Note: If your school's enrollment data is not reflected correctly in DOCIIS or ICP, first connect with your school's data liaison to ensure your school has sent the enrollment data to OSSE via the Quickbase application and that your school does not have any outstanding corrections to make in its enrollment submission. If an individual student is added or removed from your school's enrollment, ensure your school's data liaison captures it in the enrollment data sent via OSSE's Quickbase application.
