### District of Columbia School Immunization Policy Key Dates for the 2023-24 School Year

Schools should use this list of key dates to support their efforts to implement the District of Columbia School Immunization Policy for the 2023-24 school year. Activities that apply to all students are highlighted in blue, and activities that apply only to non-compliant students in grades pre-K 3, kindergarten, 7 and 11 are highlighted in green. In all instances, schools should use the Immunization Compliance Portal (Salesforce) to identify non-compliant students.

<b>April:</b>	Include information on immunization requirements in enrollment packets.
<b>May through Summer:</b>	Conduct a variety of outreach to families of non-compliant students to encourage them to get their student immunized before the start of the 2023-24 school year.
<b>Beginning on Sept. 6 and continuing periodically throughout the school year:</b>	Conduct outreach to families of non-compliant students indicating that their student must meet immunization requirements.

#### Oct. 5: ENROLLMENT COUNT DAY

<b>Oct. 13 through 25:</b>	Develop warning notifications of temporary exclusion to send on <b>Oct. 26</b> to all families of non-compliant students in grades pre-K 3, kindergarten, 7 and 11.
<b>Oct. 26:</b>	Send warning notifications of temporary exclusion to all families of non-compliant students in grades pre-K 3, kindergarten, 7 and 11.
<b>Throughout November:</b>	Send reminders to families of non-compliant students in grades pre-K 3, kindergarten, 7 and 11.
<b>Dec. 1:</b>	Send final notifications of temporary exclusion to all families of remaining non-compliant students in grades pre-K 3, kindergarten, 7 and 11.
<b>Dec. 4:</b>	Temporarily exclude non-compliant students in grades pre-K 3, kindergarten, 7 and 11 and continue outreach to families of temporarily excluded students until the students become compliant.
