



## DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION POLICY

## What is the school nurse and health suite personnel's role in supporting immunization compliance?

- Serve as primary point of contact for students, parents, guardians, school leaders, local education agency (LEA) central office (if applicable) and DC Health on immunizations.
- Coordinate with the DC Health Immunization Program.
- Access the District of Columbia Immunization Information System (DOCIIS) and paper records to review immunization certification compliance at school.
- Identify non-compliant students and bring them to the attention of School Health Team.
- Coordinate resources, access to immunization health services and communications with students and families.
- Coordinate with registrar's office to record all immunization communications to families.
