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Key Notification and Reporting Requirements

Per the DCMR, nonpublic schools are required to:

Attendance and Truancy

- Report attendance in the special education attendance tracking system (SEATS)
- Notify the local education agency (LEA) of enrollment of unexcused absences at the five and 10-day marks within two
 instructional days
- Seek and obtain authorization from the LEA of enrollment to continue billing in cases where a student has accrued 10 unexcused absences in a school year or seven consecutive unexcused absences in a school year

Related Services

• Provide special education and related services in accordance with the student's individualized education program (IEP)

Progress Reports

 Monitor how each student is making progress toward meeting the annual goals of the IEP and produce written reports for the parent(s) and the sending LEA on at least a quarterly basis

Incident Reports

Report all incidents of a qualifying type (restraint, seclusion, injury, emergency, abuse/neglect) in the incident reporting

Nonpublic Course Collection

Course Data Collection Team, Division of Data, Assessment, and Research

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Nonpublic Course Collection Updates

- **80 percent** of nonpublic schools with Certificate of Approval (COA) from OSSE have successfully uploaded Nonpublic Course Collection template on Integrated Data Submission (IDS) by the Nov. 15, 2023 submission deadline.
- OSSE has received 2,948 courses from 36 nonpublic schools.
- OSSE has mapped nonpublic courses to OSSE State Course Catalog.
- A crosswalk will be shared with LEAs in spring 2024.
- OSSE Course Data Collection Team may reach out to a few nonpublic schools for additional course information to ensure the accuracy of the crosswalk.



Nonpublic Course Data Collection Plan

- In the 2024-25 school year, OSSE plans to continue the annual nonpublic course collection in fall 2024.
- More information on collection timeline and trainings will be shared with nonpublic schools in the upcoming Nonpublic POC webinars.
