# Introduction

- What is the HIT Grant? Over the next three years, the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) will lead a major \$40 million investment in scaling and supporting high-impact tutoring (HIT) across the District, with a particular focus on at-risk students and other students who have experienced disrupted instruction during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.
- As part of this initiative, OSSE is releasing up to \$20 million in funding for a HIT Grant. The presenting organizations are interested in applying for this grant. Please see <u>OSSE's web site</u> for more details.

# **Top Scholar Services Key Details**

- Subject(s): ELA
- Grade Level(s): Pre K 12<sup>th</sup> Grades
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week: Three 1 hour sessions per week
- **Program Length:** 26 weeks to align with school calendar and an optional 6 week summer session
- **Tutor Type:** *Teachers and paraprofessionals*
- **Program Curriculum:** Common core aligned tutoring program which is differentiated to meet each specific student's needs. Staff consists of teachers and paraprofessionals experienced in best practices that result in strong reading outcomes.
- Evidence of Program Effectiveness: 80% of students show year over year improvement as reflected in assessments
- Virtual/In-Person Programming: We have a preference for in person tutoring but are happy to work with schools to identify when virtual tutoring may be employed
- Fee/Cost to the School for Tutoring Partnership: There would be no fee, if the program is funded through the OSSE HIT grant. If not, the cost for tutoring would be negotiable but generally starts at \$20 per session, per tutor with no registration fee

# **BookNook Key Details**

- Subject(s): ELA
- Grade Level(s): K-8
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week: Packages vary from 20 to 60 sessions, delivered 2-4 sessions/week, ~30 min /session
- **Program Length:** Program is available throughout the school year.

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# **CityTutor DC Key Details**

- Subject(s): ELA and Math
- Grade Level(s): K-12
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week: Varies by provider and school wishes
  - Ideally a minimum of 90 minutes per student per week.
- **Program Length:** Varies by provider and school wishes
  - Ideally a minimum of 10 weeks for a tutoring cycle or roughly a schools marking period of quarter
- **Tutor Type:** *Varies:* pre-service teachers, volunteers, paid tutors, part-time teachers
- **Program Curriculum:** Varies by provider and school wishes
  - Ideally based on the curriculum the currently being used by the school to ensure alignment
- Evidence of Program Effectiveness: Tutoring is considered one of the most effective evidence-based interventions for students. A review of nearly 200 studies found that high-impact tutoring can lead to larger learning gains in math and reading than other school-based interventions.
- Virtual/In-Person Programming: 80% of the tutoring we've been involved in is in-person
- Fee/Cost to the School for Tutoring Partnership: Cost estimates based on SY 21-22

# **Club Z! Tutoring Key Details**

- **Subject(s):** Study Skills Development and Writing Improvement Programs
- **Grade Level(s):** 5<sup>th</sup> grade 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week: 2 sessions per week, 60 minutes per session (120 minutes total duration per week)
- **Program Length:** 10 weeks per group
- **Tutor Type:** *Teachers & paid tutors*
- **Program Curriculum:** Study Skills Development includes time-management skills, proper note-taking skills, organizational skills, improving concentration and reducing test anxiety. This course includes a textbook, a workbook, and an academic planner for the student. Writing Improvement Program includes essay-writing techniques, creative writing, and technical writing skills development. This course includes a textbook and a workbook for the student.
- Evidence of Program Effectiveness: Club Z! programs are developed in conjunction with professional educators and aligned to classroom instruction.
- Virtual/In-Person Programming: Tutoring is available in person; however, Club Z! can also offer virtual tutoring if school closures necessitate a move to virtual. Club Z! will consult with each school partner to determine the preferred setting.
- Fee/Cost to the School for Tutoring Partnership: The fee for the Study Skills Development course is \$40 per hour per student. The fee for the Writing Improvement Program is \$40 per hour per student.



Writing: Our Power of Words<sup>™</sup> focused writing program helps students ages 10+ improve writing skills and confidence,



gain better writing mechanics, and learn how to enhance style and flow for writing. Targeted curriculum offers strategies for effectively write narratives, poems, essays and research papers. Students can practice these newly developed writing skills with hands-on writing activities in the student workbook. Complete instructional sets include student textbook and workbook.

Study Skills: Our Learning Built to Last<sup>™</sup> study skills program includes a comprehensive diagnostic test, which identifies



eleven different academic skills necessary for success in school, and a learning style inventory, which explores the student's preferred method of learning. The results from these assessments are used to develop individualized study programs where students develop proper study habits and time-management skills, improve concentration and memory, learn organization skills, address test preparation and test anxiety, and acquire tools for effective writing. Complete instructional sets include a student textbook and corresponding activities workbook, as well as an academic planner. Tutor instructional guides are also available.

# For Love of Children

- **Subjects:** ELA and Math
- **Grade Levels:** 2nd-12th graders
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week: 1 session per subject area weekly
- **Program Length:** 28 weeks during the school year, 6 weeks during the summer
- **Tutor Type:** Trained volunteers (community members)

# **Saga Education**

- **Subject(s):** *Mathematics*
- Grade Level(s): 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week:
  - Block Scheduling every other day for 90 minutes (5 days in a 10 day school cycle)
  - Non-block scheduling every day for 45-60 minutes
- **Program Length:** Entire school year (first day to last day of school)
- **Tutor Type:** Paid AmeriCorps tutors
- **Program Curriculum:** <u>Saga's common core aligned curriculum</u> is used to reinforce the content being taught by the core math teacher. Lessons topics covered by Saga generally trail 1-2 days behind core class instruction.
- Evidence of Program Effectiveness: Saga has been a part of 7 different randomized control trials. Saga's program has reduced math course failures by as much as 63% and reduced non-math course failures by as much as 26%
  - The <u>Hamilton Project</u>: Scaling Up Individualized Tutorials to Improve Academic Outcomes for Disadvantaged Students
  - <u>Mitigate learning loss</u>: Meta-Analysis demonstrates strong effects on early literacy and later mathematics
  - <u>Greater Impact on Student Learning</u> compared to traditional interventions such as reducing class sizes for teachers, increasing per pupil spending, or having more teachers with advanced degrees
- Virtual/In-Person Programming: Our tutors work remotely providing virtual tutoring to students while their school based Saga Site Director reports to the school to supervise the students, troubleshoot technological issues, align and meet with core math teachers, and support the tutors working remotely.
- Fee/Cost to the School for Tutoring Partnership: \$20,000 per school

- Subject(s): English Language Arts (ELA), Math, Science, special education, and English as a Second Language (ESL)
- **Grade Level(s):** Early childhood, elementary, middle, and high schools
- Number of Tutoring Sessions Per Week/Minutes Per Week: Each tutor can provide 25 one-hour tutoring sessions per week.
- Program Length: Full school year
- **Tutor Type:** Full-time virtual teachers (available 8 hours a day; 40 hours a week)
- Program Curriculum:
  - Tutors provide individualized and tailored instruction (personalized learning) to meet both the unique academic and socialemotional needs of each student.

  - 100% of students tutoring plans were based on current academic status and aligned with school curriculum.
  - 99% of sessions were completed without disruption by illness or technology events.
  - 80% of parents reported they were 'highly satisfied' (20% 'satisfied') with tutor instruction.
  - 100% of parents report satisfaction with, and anecdotal evidence of their children's academic gains during the pilot.
  - 100% of parents report high engagement of their children during tutoring.
  - 95% of parents express a desire to continue in the tutoring program.
