- Current juniors and seniors with a cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA can take all classes on this list without testing except for ENGL 101 and ENGL 102 which require qualifying SAT, ACT or AP scores. Everyone else must provide qualifying SAT/ACT scores or take Montgomery College's remote English placement test to determine the classes they are eligible to take. Minimum qualifying SAT/ACT scores are:
 - 480 or higher on the SAT Evidence Based Reading & Writing & 530 or higher on the SAT math **IF the course requires a math placement**
 - 21 or higher on the ACT Reading section & 21 or higher on the math **IF the course requires a math placement**
