The new DC PDIS is an online system that allows early childhood staff to access training and professional development offered by the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) and its partners. Professionals can register for training online, save training certificates, build a resume and access valuable resources.

The new PDIS was designed to replace the current Professional Development Registry (PDR). The PDIS is user friendly, easy to navigate, and built for all of your professional development needs. The new PDIS is beneficial for educators, center directors and home caregivers in licensed child development facilities.

- Receive and store all of your training certificates in your individualized PDIS account
- Securely save and store all copies of your important educational documents (e.g., high school transcript)
- Build a printable, ready-to-use resume
- Access resources such as Child Development Associate (CDA) credential supports, associate degree and bachelor's degree programs, current research and additional training opportunities
