### **Downloadable Print Materials**


Click the links below to download the bookmark, coloring pages and signs.

### Sing, Talk and Read (STAR)




### Sign Up for a Library Card


Anyone who resides, works, pays property taxes or attends school in the District of Columbia can get a card. Library cards expire after three years. Residents of Montgomery, Prince George's, Fairfax, Frederick County, Loudoun, Arlington, Prince William, Falls Church and Alexandria may also get a library card for free. There are 26 public libraries throughout the District. Visit <u>dclibrary.org/hours-locations</u> to find a DCPL location near you.





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
