



Carnegie Unit Requirement Waiver: School Year 2024-25 Implementation Update

Background

In 2015, pursuant to State Board of Education Resolution SR16-3, the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) updated the District of Columbia's graduation rules to include a process for waiving the Carnegie Unit requirement for a school seeking to award competency-based unit(s) (see 5-A DCMR § 2203).¹ OSSE established the information required to be included in the waiver application and the format, as well as the standards and requirements for reviewing the application.² The District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) or the DC Public Charter School Board (PCSB) may waive the Carnegie Unit requirement for DCPS and public charter schools, respectively. DCPS and PCSB annually submit evidence of the progress and quality of competency-based education implementation for each approved waiver to OSSE.

This report, which meets the reporting requirements of 5-A DCMR § 2203.7(c), identifies each school that received a waiver to award competency-based unit(s) as well as each competency-based learning course.

Schools with Competency-Based Education Waivers

In the 2024-25 school year, **ten** waivers were implemented within DC Public and Public Charter Schools.
