Now more than ever, it's important that your child receives their immunizations on time.

All DC students **must** be up to date on their immunizations before next school year!

Starting with the 2020-21 school year, students who have not received their required immunizations may be removed from in-person instruction and activities until they receive the required immunizations and provide documentation to the school.

TAKE THESE THREE STEPS NOW TO GUARANTEE YOUR CHILD IS READY!

SCHEDULE YOUR CHILD'S ANNUAL WELLNESS VISIT

Schedule your child's annual wellness visit today and ask your physician to complete the Universal Health Certificate. If your child receives an immunization during the visit, ask for written proof of the immunization that you can share with your school.

MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD HAS RECEIVED ALL OF THEIR IMMUNIZATIONS

Not sure if your child has received all of their required immunizations? Ask your primary care provider and request a copy of your child's immunization history to share with your school.

SUBMIT IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENTS TO YOUR SCHOOL
