

UJAMAA SCHOOL HEALTH AND SAFETY PLAN

EDUCATION ACTIVITIES

Due to the recent reports on the Covid-19 Virus the opening of **School for 2021/2022** will remain the same. The students will have the option of virtual learning only or a combination of both. In-school activities will be 2 or 3 days each week. The needs of the parents for their children will be accommodated.

All students will be required to have access to internet with a laptop computer or tablet that would allow for virtual education. Laptops will be made available for the students who need them. Instructions for virtual learning will be provided for all students enrolled for the 2021/2022 school year.

School will start at 9AM and close at 3PM on those days when classes are scheduled. Creative recreation will take place such as films, storytelling, drumming and dancing, martial arts, exercise, etc.

UJAMAA SCHOOL SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR IN CLASS ACTIVITIES

Parents will receive written notification outlining school education requirements and Health and Safety precautions.

Parents will not be allowed to enter the school. They must drop their student at the door.

Everyone will be required to wear a face mask.

Temperatures will be taken from each student prior to entering the building and once when leaving the school.

Hand Sanitizer will be issued at the door as they enter the school.

Mask will only be removed when students are eating their lunch and when the Kamau class take their nap. Social distant will take place with the carts.

Social distances will be implemented, 6 feet apart, and marks on the floor will identify where each student will set and where they will stand to address the teacher.

Male and Female restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized 3 times daily.

Washing the hands will be required when entering the school and several times during the day such as before and after lunch. Soap and hand sanitizers will be available.

Students will be required to bring their own lunch and water/drink. Lunch will take place in the individual class rooms.
