Each year, the Office of the State Superintendent of Education is responsible for producing high school graduation rates for each school and LEA in the District of Columbia.<sup>1</sup> The District of Columbia will release the State graduation rate once all schools and LEAs have verified their data.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The District of Columbia currently uses the NCES methodology for determining graduation rate. The calculation is: (total number of graduates in 2009) / (total number of graduates in 2009 + total number of dropouts in grade 12 in 2008-2009 + total number of dropouts in grade 11 in 2007-2008 + total number of dropouts in grade 10 in 2006-2007 + total number of dropouts in grade 9 in 2005-2006). Starting with the graduating class of 2011, the District of Columbia will shift to a four-year adjusted-cohort graduation rate as required by the U.S. Department of Education.

<sup>2</sup> School or LEA did not verify state data prior to January 7, 2010. This school or LEA's graduation rate will be released at a later point.

<sup>3</sup> School or LEA's graduating class is below reporting requirements of at least 10 students.
