Funding Breakdown

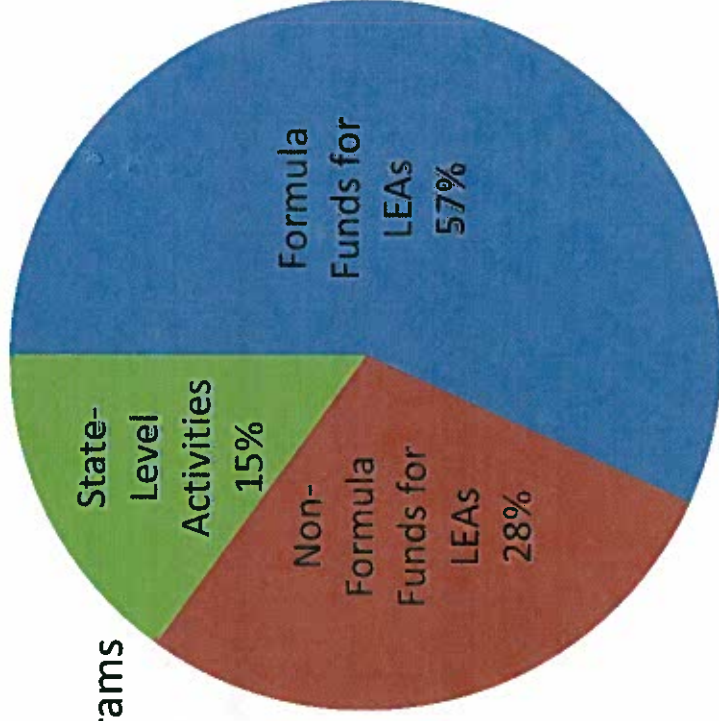
➤ \$75 million from September 24, 2010 – September 23, 2014
