Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate: The four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate is the number of students who graduate in four years with a regular high school diploma divided by the number of students who form the adjusted cohort for the graduating class. For any given cohort, students who are entering grade 9 for the first time form a cohort that is subsequently “adjusted” by adding any students who transfer into the cohort later during the next three years and subtracting any students who transfer out, emigrate to another country, or are deceased during that same period. The percent of students graduated divided by the total cohort of students is the adjusted cohort graduation rate. In the case of the five year rate, the cohort can be modified only for permanent incapacitation and death and additional graduates are added regardless of what school or sector they graduate from.

Enrolled in DC Schools SY2013-2014: The number of students still enrolled in a DC public or public charter school, who did not graduate in four years.

Other Credential or Attending College: The number of students in the cohort who received an IDEA Certificate, GED or who were enrolled in post-secondary education, but who did not graduate as of October 1, 2013.

Educationally Disengaged: The number of students in the cohort who did not graduate, are not currently enrolled and did not receive an IDEA Certificate, GED and were not enrolled in post-secondary education as of October 1, 2013

Other Credential or Attending College: The number of students in the cohort who received an IDEA Certificate, GED or were enrolled in post-secondary education as of October 1, 2014, but who did not graduate.

Educationally Disengaged: The number of students in the cohort who did not graduate, were not enrolled as of October 1, 2014 and did not receive an IDEA Certificate, GED and were not enrolled in post-secondary education as of October 1, 2014.
