INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT

Office of the State Superintendent of Education
Government of the District of Columbia
Washington, DC

We have examined the accompanying Schedule of Student Enrollment for the school year period ended October 5, 2016. The District of Columbia Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) is responsible for the Schedule of Student Enrollment. Our responsibility is to express an opinion based on our examination. OSSE did not provide us a written assertion about their Schedule of Student Enrollment for the school year period ended October 5, 2016.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and, accordingly, included examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the Schedule of Student Enrollment and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

ENROLLMENT AUDIT ANALYSIS

Overview

Our examination included a physical head count of the general education enrollment population of the District of Columbia public and charter schools, Community Based Organizations as well as procedures for District of Columbia students enrolled in non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools. In addition to the physical count, our examination consisted of a review of student records to determine enrollment and residency status as on October 5th of the current school year.

The student enrollment data was provided by OSSE and comprised 92,350 students as detailed below:

- 90,454 general education students;
- 661 Community Based Organizations (CBO) students; and
- 1,235 District of Columbia students enrolled by the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS), District of Columbia Public Charter Schools (DCPCS), OSSE, Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (DYRS), and District of Columbia Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA) in non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools.

The audited enrollment of 91,394 students for the school year period ended October 5th is summarized as follows:

- 90,061 general education students;
- 600 CBO students; and
- 733 District of Columbia students enrolled by DCPS, DCPCS, OSSE, DYRS and CFSA in non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools.

The enrollment discrepancies attributable to the general education and CBO populations were 0.4% and 9%, respectively. However, the enrollment discrepancies for the students placed by DCPS, DCPCS, DYRS and CFSA in non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools was 41%. Overall, the total enrollment discrepancies related to the audited enrollment was 959 students or 1%. Our examination disclosed the following deficiencies in student records that resulted in the enrollment discrepancies. Our auditor's report is not modified with respect to these matters.

General Education Students

Enrollment: OSSE's Statewide Longitudinal Education Database (SLED) reported 90,454 students were enrolled in the general education program. Our examination determined 90,061 students to be enrolled. The primary basis for the net variance of 393 students who were determined to be not enrolled at a school related to:

- **Non-attending and withdrawn students:** There were 264 students classified as non-attending or withdrawn during our examination and excluded from the enrollment. OSSE provided guidance in its Absent Student Documentation and Hierarchy (Policy) for determining enrollment status for students who were absent on count day. If such criteria were not met, the student was classified as non-attending. The OSSE criteria for determining absent student enrollment as of October 5th was as follows:
 - An attendance record for a student had to reflect at least one day of attendance during the period September 21st through October 19th.
 - If attendance records were not available then one of the following acceptable forms of documentation could be provided:
 - A parent or guardian note regarding the absence on count day
 - Two pieces of classwork reflective for the above mentioned period

Students who were reported as withdrawn by schools as of October 5th, yet still reflected in the OSSE database, were considered not enrolled for purposes of our report.

- **Duplicate student enrollment:** Our examination disclosed 373 duplicate enrollments as of October 5th. A duplicate enrollment occurs when a student has been reported as enrolled at

more than one school. Each Local Education Agency (LEA) uses a separate student information system for tracking and reporting enrollment. Because there is no consolidated student information system used to enroll and track all District students, it is possible for a student to be recorded as enrolled in more than one LEA. OSSE issued guidance related to the resolution for duplicate student status in its Absent Student Documentation and Hierarchy (Policy) and this guidance was utilized in our procedures to determine which school would receive credit for a student as part of its enrollment as of October 5th.

- **New enrollments:** The results of our examination identified 244 students who were found to be attending DCPS or DCPCS schools as of October 5th but not included in SLED data provided for testing. We both physically counted these students during our examination and inspected student records to ascertain enrollment and residency status as of October 5th.

Review of the DC Residency Verification Form and Other Appropriate Residency Documentation:

Of the 90,061 students determined to be validly enrolled in DCPS or PCS schools, 90,001 students were categorized as residents of the District of Columbia. Compliance with OSSE guidance requires schools to maintain residency supporting documentation for all enrolled students. For each student, our procedures included a review of the DC Residency Verification Form or other appropriate alternative residency documents, as specified by OSSE guidelines. Additionally, our procedures included an inspection and assessment of residency supporting documentation for a randomly selected sample of the student population, at each school, whose residency had not been “direct-certified” by OSSE.

Based on our examination, there were 16 students attending DCPS or PCS schools for whom (1) a Residency Verification Form or other OSSE approved residency documents were not provided or (2) the supporting residency documentation provided by the schools was not in compliance with OSSE guidelines.

Community Based Organizations

SLED reflected 661 students as enrolled in Community Based Organizations. Of the 661 students identified in SLED, 600 were substantiated as attending programs sponsored by Community Based Organizations. The primary reason for the 61 student variance is attributable to non-attending and withdrawn students. Our examination also disclosed 30 duplicate enrollments as of October 5th. Additionally, there were 31 non attending and withdrawn students.

Students Attending Non-Public Schools, Programs and Surrounding County Schools

SLED reflected 1,235 students as enrolled in non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools. The composition of the 1,235 enrolled students is highlighted below:

- 697 students placed by DCPS, PCS or OSSE;
- 492 students placed by CFSA (wards of the District of Columbia); and
- 46 student placed by DYRS.

This examination verified 733 students attending non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools as follows:


- 692 students placed by DCPS, PCS or OSSE;
- 13 students placed by CFSA (wards of the District of Columbia); and
- 28 students placed by DYRS.

Similar to the general enrollment audit results, the foremost reason for the 502 student variance relates to non-attending and withdrawn students. There are 25 students who were not “direct-certified” by OSSE and for whom residency verification form or other appropriate OSSE-approved residency documents were not provided or the supporting residency documentation provided by the schools was not in compliance with OSSE guidelines.

In our opinion, the schedule referred to above presents, in all material respects, the enrollment count of students for DCPS, DCPCS and CBO in the Pre-Kindergarten Enhancement Grant Program for the school year period ended October 5, 2016, based on criteria set forth in Note A.

Our examination was conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the Schedule of Student Enrollment. The supplementary information on Attachments A through G are presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the Schedule of Student Enrollment. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying records used to prepare the Schedule of Student Enrollment. The information has been subjected to the examination procedures applied in the examination of the Schedule of Student Enrollment and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying records used to prepare the Schedule of Student Enrollment or to the Schedule Student Enrollment itself, and other additional procedures in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the Schedule of Student Enrollment as a whole.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of OSSE, the Council of the District of Columbia, the Office of the Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Office of the Chancellor of DCPS, the District of Columbia Public Charter School Board, and Community Based Organizations in the Pre-Kindergarten Enhancement Grant Program and is not intended to be, and should not be, used by anyone other than these specified parties.

NOTE A—CRITERIA

Enrollment

DC Code 38-1804.02 requires an annual reporting by the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) of student enrollment as of October 5th each year. The Schedule of Student Enrollment presents the enrollment calculations required by DC Code 38-1804.02, which includes students attending District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and DC Public Charter Schools (PCS); students attending Community Based Organizations (CBO); students placed in non-public schools, programs and surrounding county schools for special education services by DCPS, OSSE, or a PCS; and students placed by the District of Columbia Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA) in non-public and surrounding county schools.

Assessment of the accuracy of the enrollment reported by OSSE was based on (1) documents prepared internally by each school which were not subject to audit verification; (2) requirements as stated in OSSE's Enrollment Audit Handbook; and (3) OSSE's *Absent Student Documentation and Hierarchy (Policy)* which is further described in Note 3.

Residency

DC Code Section 38-309 requires that documentation be provided when enrolling a student to verify that the student is a resident of the District of Columbia. Such verification is required no earlier than April 1 each year in order for a student to be considered properly enrolled. OSSE issued instructions to the schools as to the documents necessary to verify residency.

For the purposes of residency verification, the DC Residency Verification Form (or other OSSE designated appropriate alternative document(s) provided by the schools) was inspected for each student. In addition, the supporting residency documentation was examined for a random sample of students who were not indicated as "direct-certified" at each school location for the school's adherence to DC Code Section 38309 and OSSE guidelines.

OSSE identified certain students as "direct-certified" for residency. "Direct certified" students are students identified by OSSE as current residents of the District of Columbia by participation in District of Columbia government programs. The source for the direct certification indicator is the Income Maintenance Administration's Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program file, Child and Family Services (CFSA) and other programs.

The amounts of tuition assessed and collected for nonresident students were provided by individual District of Columbia public and charter schools and OSSE.

Grade Level

Grade levels are reported as provided in the October 5th SLED unless corrected by the schools during the enrollment count process or as appealed by the schools with the following exceptions. Students in special education schools and alternative programs are shown in the reports as "UN" -

Grade Level (Continued)

Ungraded; students with no grade levels or have a grade level of “UN” in schools other than special education and alternative programs were adjusted to a grade level based upon age ranges provided by OSSE, and students in the DCPS STAY programs were all shown as “AO” - Adult.

NOTE B—OSSE APPEALS PROCESS

OSSE established a process whereby schools had the opportunity to appeal the decisions noted during the field examination. This appeals process, after the conclusion of the field examination, allowed LEAs an opportunity to present additional documentation for determination of enrollment and residency status and grade level for students. The outcomes of the appeals process have been included in the audited results.

NOTE C—OSSE CRITERIA FOR DUPLICATE AND ABSENT STUDENTS

For purposes of this examination, the following criteria were used for determination of enrollment.

- A student present on the day of the count was an enrolled student for the school if (1) the student was reported on the school’s roster in the October 5th SLED and (2) there was only one school claiming the student (not a duplicate student enrollment).
- A student who was present on the day of the enrollment count yet not reported on the school’s roster in SLED as of October 5th was an enrolled student for that school if (1) acceptable documentation for enrollment at October 5th was provided during the examination and (2) no other school reported the student as enrolled (not a duplicate student enrollment).
- For a student being claimed by multiple schools as an enrolled student (duplicate student enrollment), OSSE’s criteria as outlined in the *Absent Student Documentation and Hierarchy* stated that the school receiving credit for the student would be the school which the student attended on October 5th. In cases in which both schools had documented attendance for October 5th, the school which had the most days of attendance for the period September 28st through October 26th received credit for enrollment.
- For a student who was absent on the day of the count, the OSSE criteria as outlined in the *Absent Student Documentation and Hierarchy*, stated that the school could provide:
-Attendance records for a student to reflect attendance during the period September 21st through October 19th. If attendance records were not available, then acceptable documentation could be -A note from parent/legal/doctor if absence on count day was because of an illness, court-ordered appearance, out-of-school suspension, etc.; or -Twost pieces of the student’s school work/exam documentation during the period September 21st through October 19th.

NOTE D—GENERAL EDUCATION NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

General education students who are not residents of the District aggregated 60. This comprised of 44 tuition-paying and 16 non-tuition paying students.

INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT

We have examined the accompanying Schedule of English Language Learner (ELL) Student Enrollment for the school year period ended October 5, 2016 based on the criteria set forth in Note A. The District of Columbia Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) is responsible for the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment. Our responsibility is to express an opinion based on our examination. OSSE did not provide us a written assertion about their Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment for the school year period ended October 5, 2016.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and, accordingly, included examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

The October 5th SLED reflected 8,789 students identified by OSSE as English Language Learner (ELL) students. The composition of the 8,789 ELL students is highlighted below:

- 5,660 students identified by DCPS
- 3,129 students identified by DCPCS

The examination results indicate that there are 8,434 ELL students as follows:

- 5,870 students identified by DCPS
- 2,564 students identified by DCPCS


Our procedures included an inspection and evaluation of ELL supporting documentation for a sample of students in the ELL population which had not been automatically certified by OSSE. The sample and audit process were determined by OSSE and noted in OSSE's Student Enrollment Audit Handbook. There were 3,207 students who were not automatically certified and, as a result, were subject to audit. Of those students, there

were 31 discrepancies noted, which represents 1% of the audit sample population. These discrepancies were mostly attributable to incomplete ELL documentation to support ELL status and non-qualifying assessment scores.

In our opinion, the schedule referred to above presents, in all material respects, the enrollment count of English Language Learner students for the school year period ended October 5, 2016, based on criteria set forth in Note A.

Our examination was conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment. The supplementary information on Attachment H is presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying records used to prepare the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment. The information has been subjected to the examination procedures applied in the examination of the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment or to the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment itself, and other additional procedures in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrollment as a whole.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of OSSE, the Council of the District of Columbia, the Office of the Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Office of the Chancellor of DCPS, the District of Columbia Public Charter School Board, and Community Based Organizations in the Pre-Kindergarten Enhancement Grant Program and is not intended to be, and should not be, used by anyone other than these specified parties.

**Notes to Schedule of English Language Learner Student Enrolment

NOTE A—CRITERIA

In order to qualify for supplemental funding through the DC Uniform Per Student Funding Formula, all English Language Learner (ELL) students attending District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and DC Public Charter Schools (PCS) must meet the District of Columbia definition of ELL. In accordance with the Public Law 107-110, qualifying ELL students must meet all of the following criteria:

- Student is age 3 through 21;
- Student is enrolled in or preparing to enroll in an elementary school or secondary school;
- Student is:
 - not born in the United States or whose native language is a language other than English;
 - a Native American or Alaska Native, or a native resident of outlying areas; and comes from an environment where a language other than English has had a significant impact on the students' level of English language proficiency; or
 - migratory, his/her language is a language other than English and comes from an environment where a language other than English is dominant; and
- Student who has difficulties speaking, reading, writing, or understanding the English language may be sufficient to deny the student
 - ability to meet the state's proficient level of achievement on state assessments described in section 1111(b)(3);
 - ability to successfully achieve in classrooms where the language of instruction is English;
 - opportunity to participate fully in society.

The Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) provided guidance to the schools as to the documentation necessary to support ELL determinations. ELL assessments were to be current and administered in accordance with mandated timeframes. Additionally, all assessments were to include data elements as noted below:

- Unique Student Identifier (USI)
- Student's first and last name
- Date of birth
- Grade level when assessment was administered
- Date assessment was administered
- Official scoring sheet, inclusive of the overall or composite score

NOTE B—ASSESSMENT

For purposes of this report, final evaluation of ELL status was based on the examination of both complete and current ELL documentation and qualifying assessment scores for a sample of ELL students. The requirements for the ELL audit process and the sample selection process are identified in OSSE's Student Enrollment Audit Handbook.

NOTE C—OSSE APPEALS PROCESS

OSSE established a process whereby schools had the opportunity to appeal the decisions noted during the field examination. This appeals process, after the conclusion of the field examination, allowed LEAs to present additional documentation for determination of ELL status for students. The outcome of the appeals process has been included in the audited results.
