

## District of Columbia Combined Middle School Survey Sample Description

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### Sample Description

**School Level** – All schools of the following type(s) containing grades 6, 7, or 8 were included in the sampling frame:

Charter	Included
Private	Excluded
Alternative	Excluded
Vocational	Excluded
Special education	Excluded

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Note: Your 2015 YRBS sampling frame had the same types of schools included and excluded.

All 72 schools in the sampling frame were selected. 5 schools were ineligible.

**Class Level** - All students were included in the sample.

### Response Rates

**Schools** - 85% 57 of the 67 sampled eligible schools participated.

**Students** - 81% 9,172 of the 10,857 sampled students submitted questionnaires. 8,799 questionnaires were usable after data editing.

**Overall response rate** - 85% \* 81% = 69%<sup>1</sup>

### Weighting

A weight has been associated with each questionnaire to reflect the likelihood of sampling each student and to reduce bias by compensating for differing patterns of nonresponse. The weight used for estimation is given by:

$$W = f1 * f2 * f3$$

f1 = a school-level nonresponse adjustment factor calculated by school type (regular public, charter) and school size category (small, medium, large). The factor was calculated in terms of school enrollment instead of number of schools;

f2 = a student-level nonresponse adjustment factor calculated by school;

f3 = a poststratification adjustment factor calculated by gender within grade and by race/ethnicity.

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<sup>1</sup> Overall response rate is computed as (number of participating schools/number of eligible sampled schools) \* (number of usable questionnaires/number of eligible students sampled in participating schools), rounded to the nearest integer.

**Use of the Weighted Results**

The weighted results can be used to make important inferences concerning the priority health-risk behaviors of all regular public and charter school students in grades 6 through 8.
