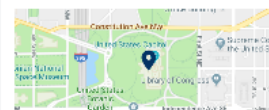

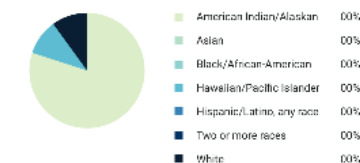
Student population

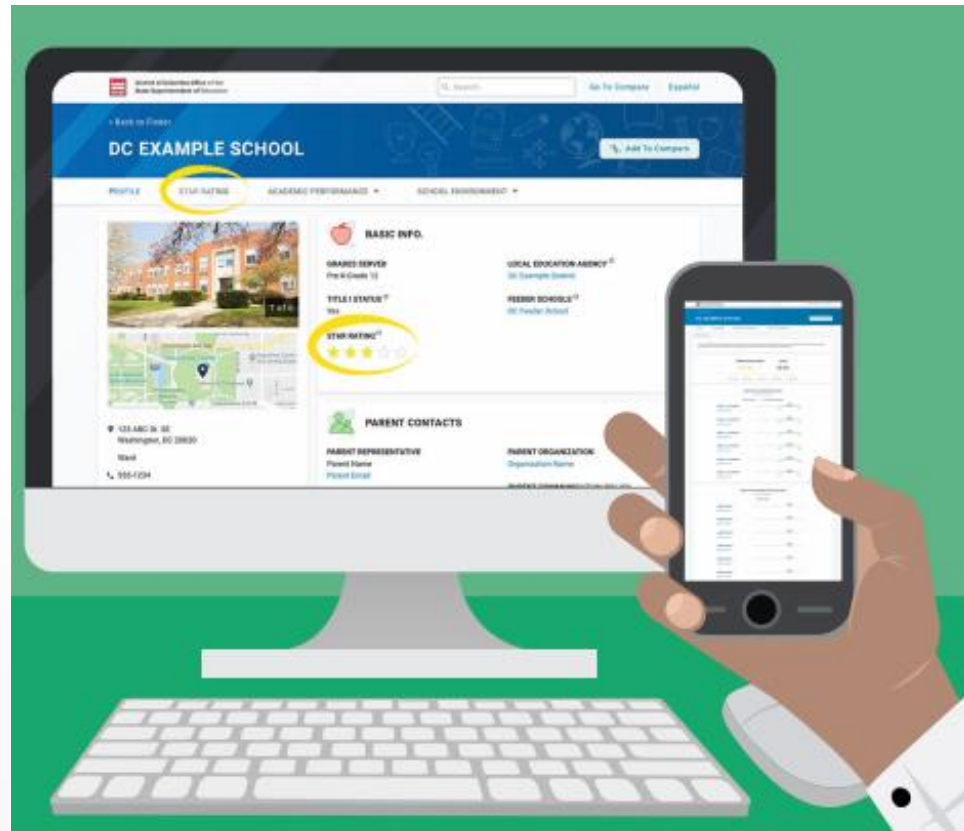

WHAT'S IN THE STAR FRAMEWORK?

The STAR Framework uses multiple types of data to measure a school's performance in the following areas:



Academic Achievement

Measures student performance on PARCC, MSAA and the SAT.



English Language Proficiency

Measures the progress of English learners in speaking, listening, reading and writing in English.



School Environment

Measures chronic absenteeism, daily attendance, and re-enrollment of students from one year to the next. For high schools, it also measures extended graduation rates and student participation and performance on the AP and IB exams. For schools with Pre-K, it includes measures of early childhood learning.



Academic Growth

Measures student progress on PARCC.



Graduation Rate

Measures how many students receive their regular diploma in four years.

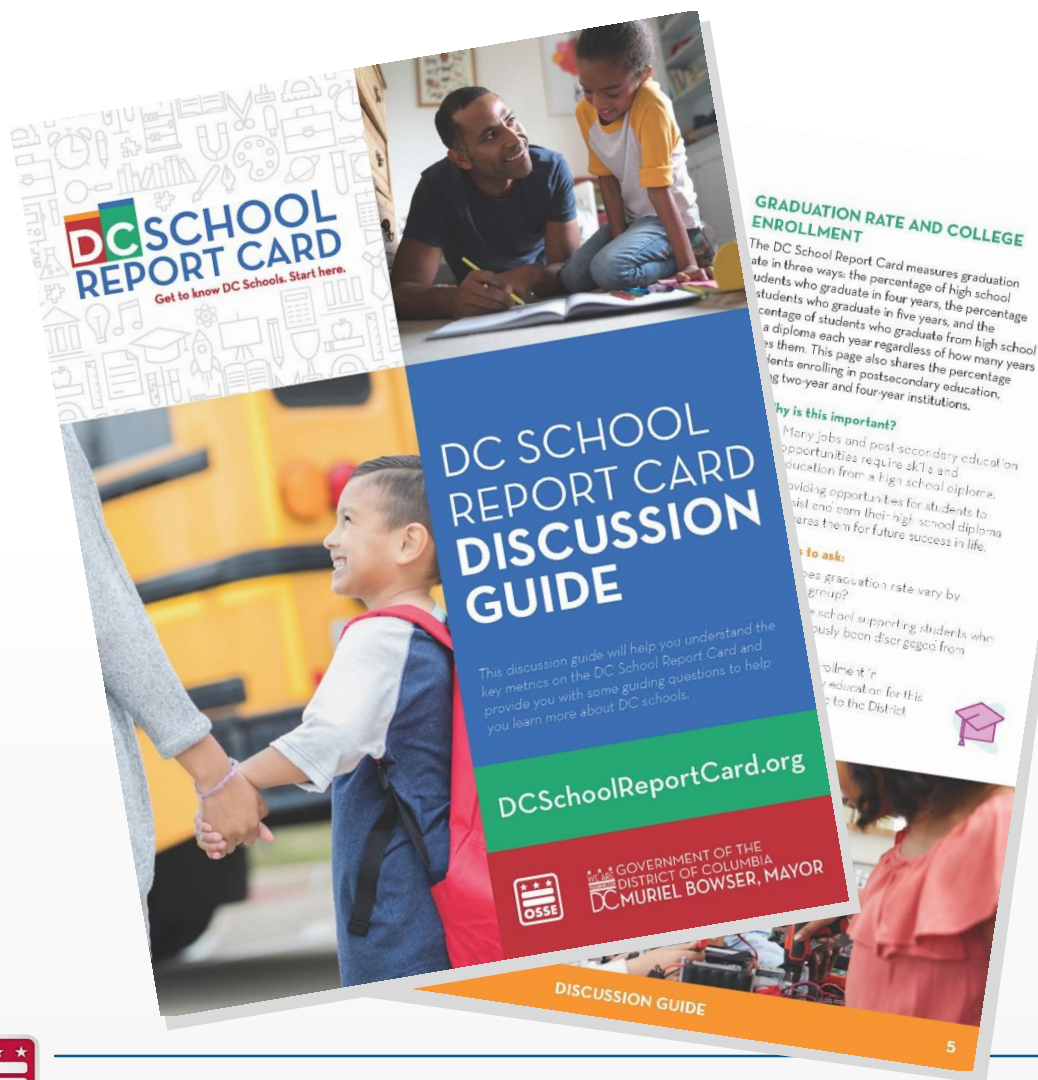

ATTENDANCE

This page provides details on attendance rates. This includes average daily attendance for all students, the percentage of students attending school 90 percent of the time or more and the school's growth in attendance rate.



What is measured?

- The percentage of students who attend school 90 percent of the time or more.
- Improvement in the percentage of students who attend school 90 percent of the time or more.
- The percentage of students who attend school daily, averaged across the entire school year.

Why is this important?

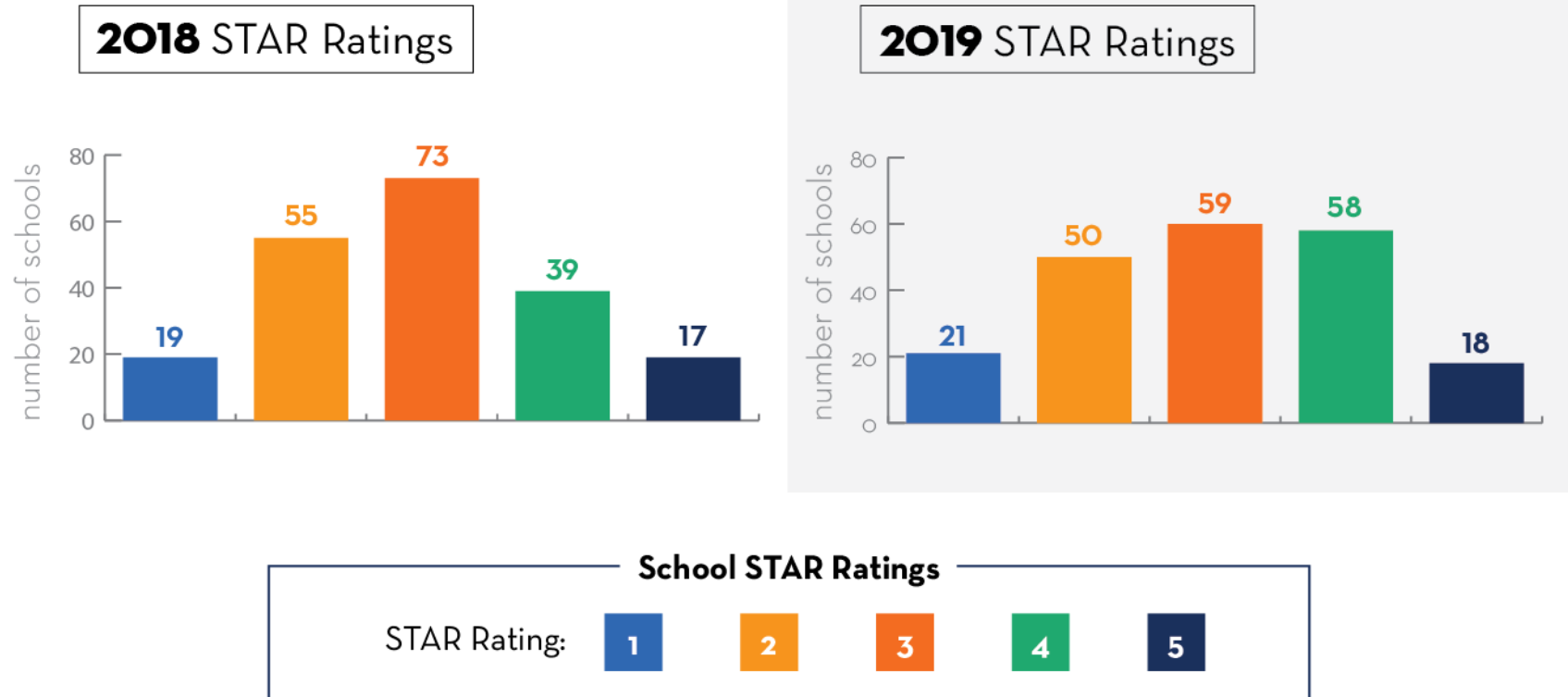
- Students must be in school to learn. Educational research shows that students who miss more than 10 percent of the school year (no matter the reason) are less likely to stay on track for high school graduation and eventual enrollment in postsecondary education. These students are considered "chronically absent." The DC School Report Card shows the inverse of this number - the percentage of students who are not chronically absent at the school as the percentage of students attending school for 90% or more of school days.



Questions to ask:

- Does this school have a high percentage of students who are chronically absent?
- Are attendance rates improving?
- What is being done to improve attendance rates?

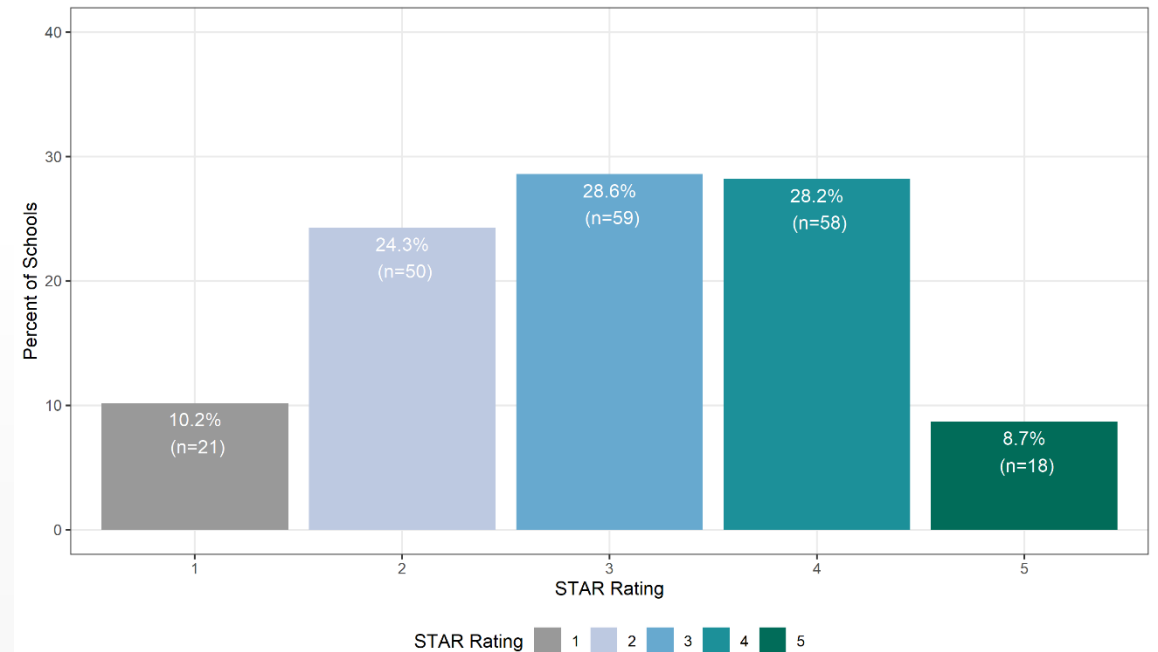

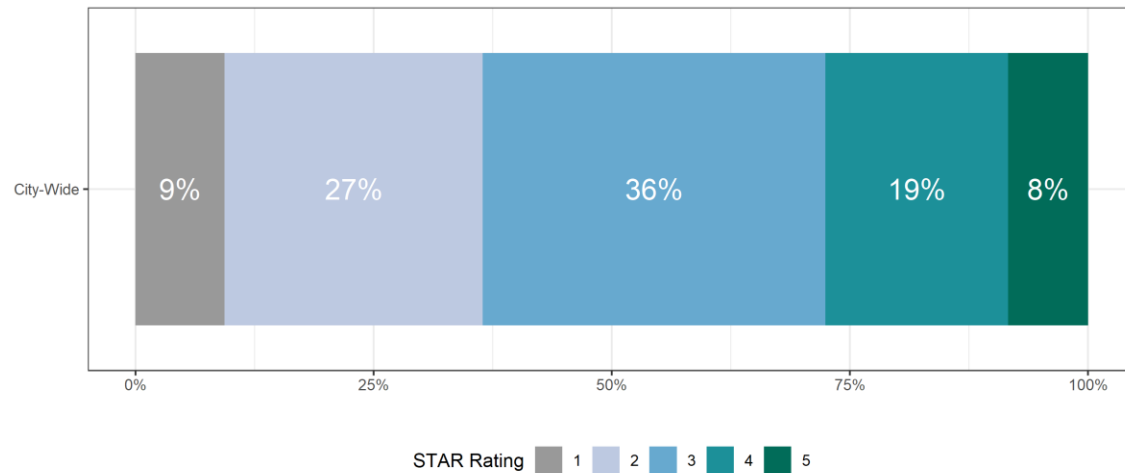

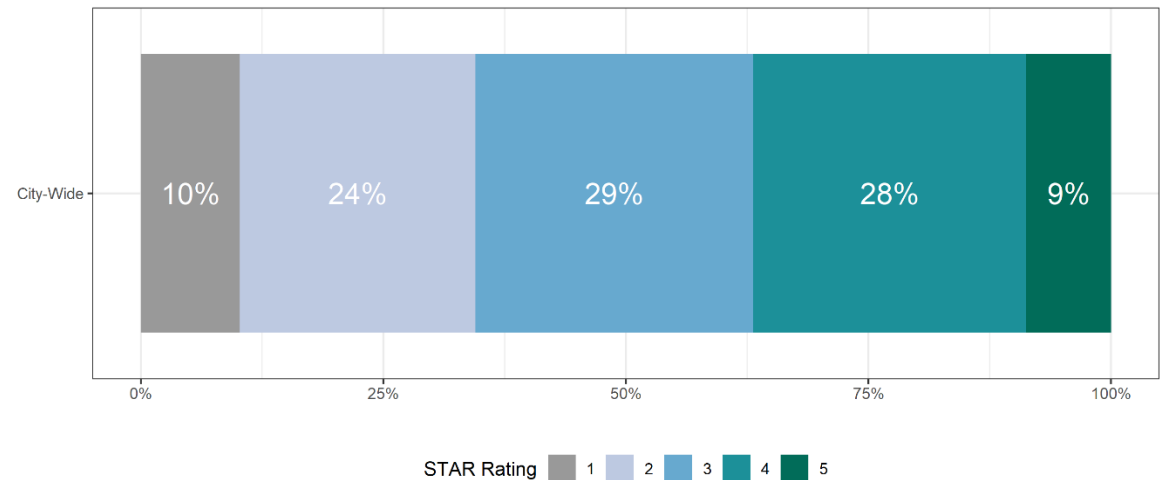


Percent of schools per STAR Rating in 2018 and 2019

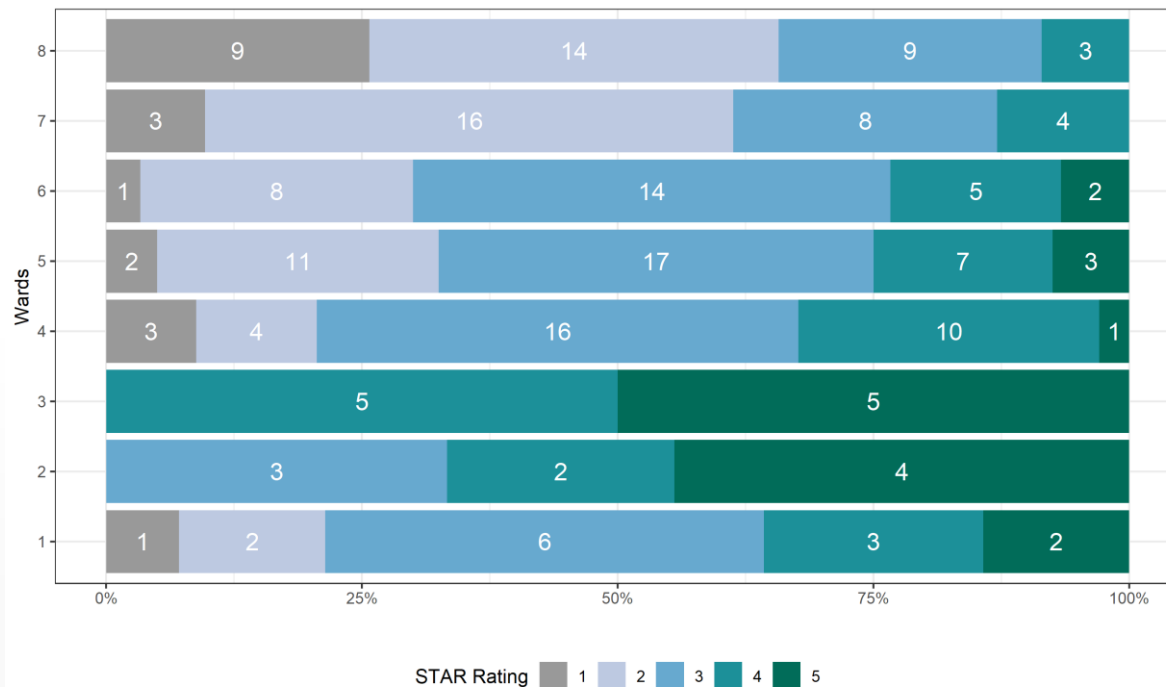

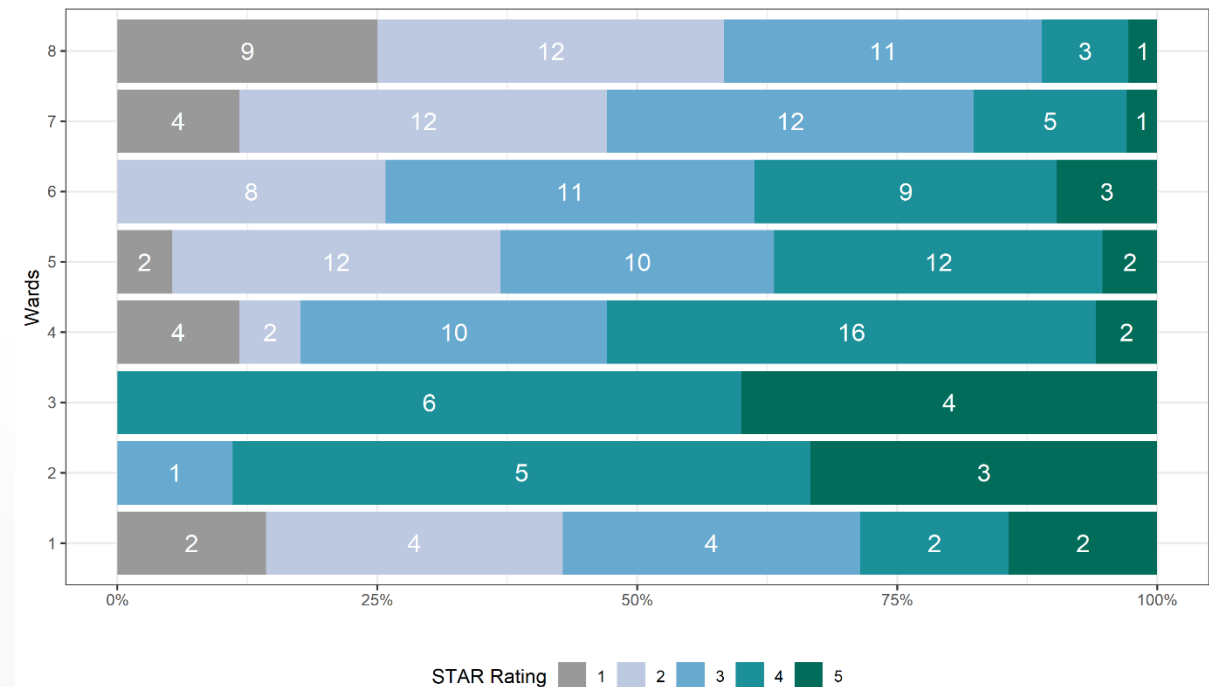


Number of schools rated at each STAR Rating level by ward in 2018 and 2019

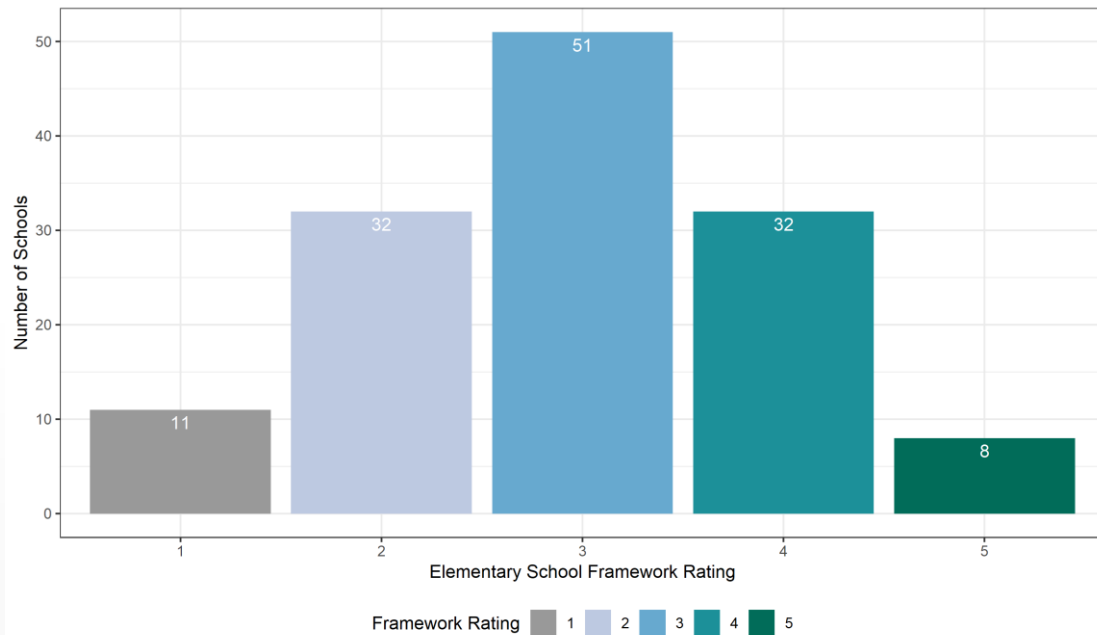

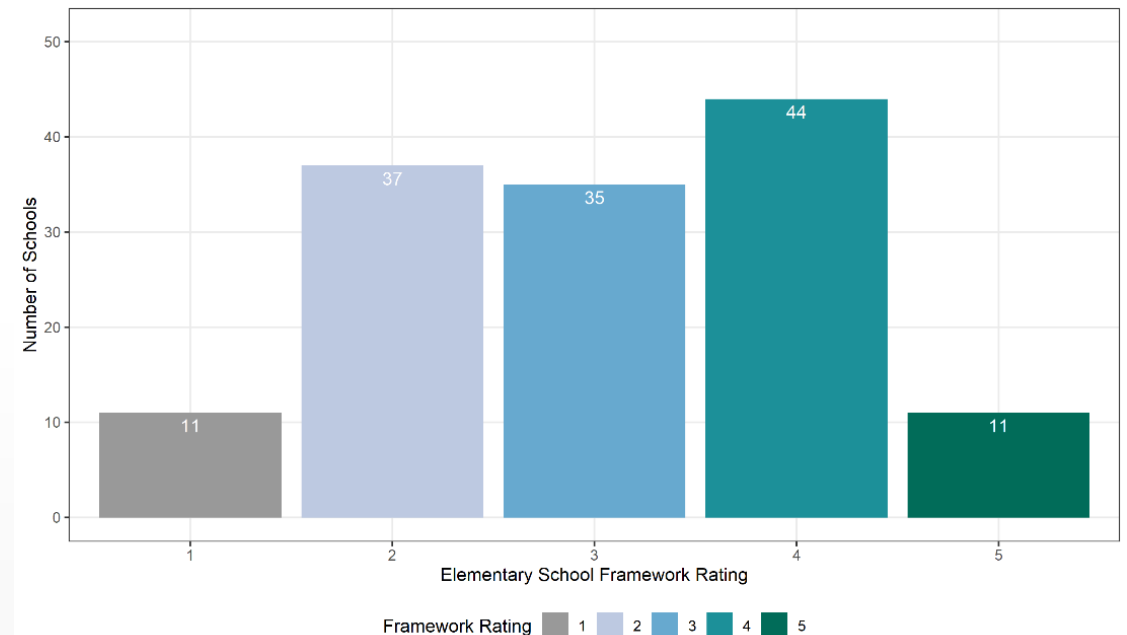


Number of Elementary Framework scores at each STAR Rating level in 2018 and 2019

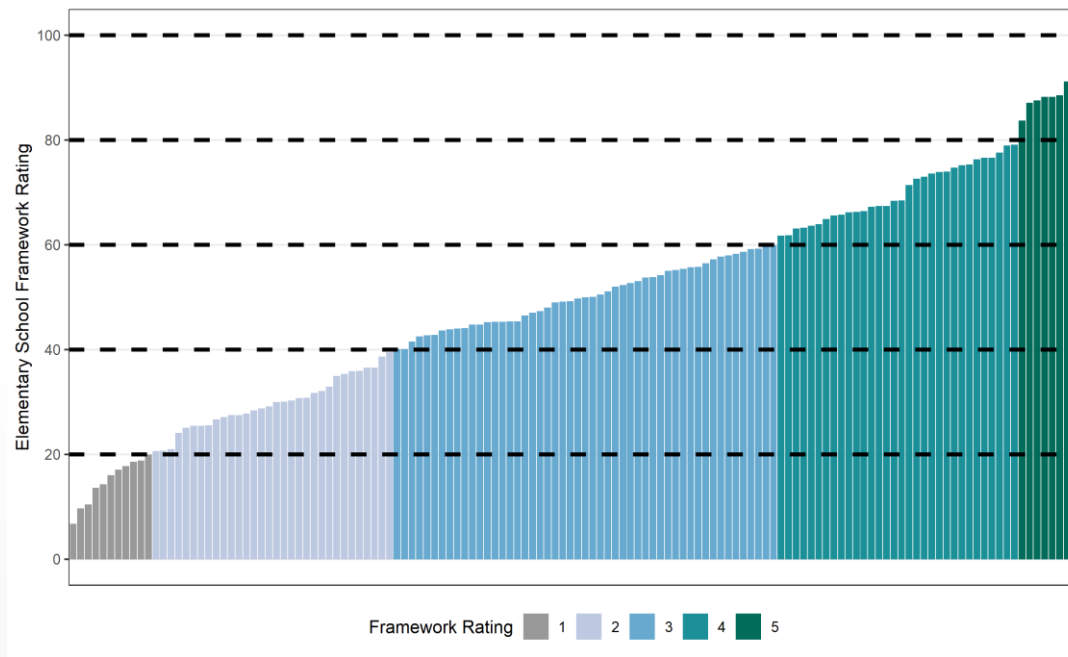

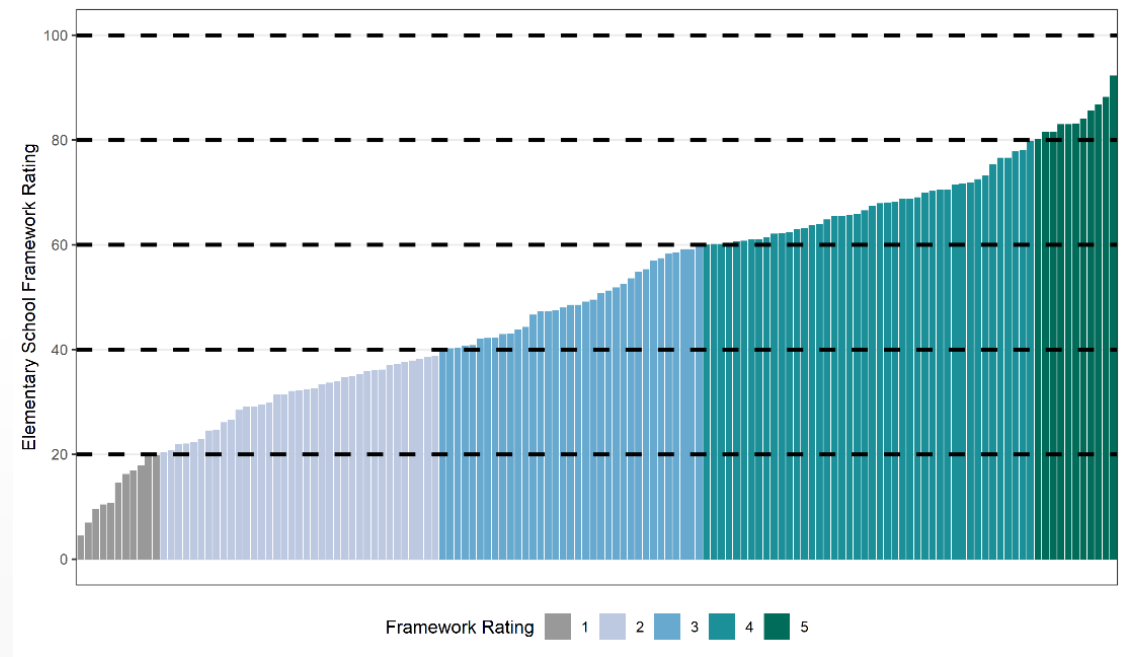


Distribution of Elementary Framework scores in 2018 and 2019

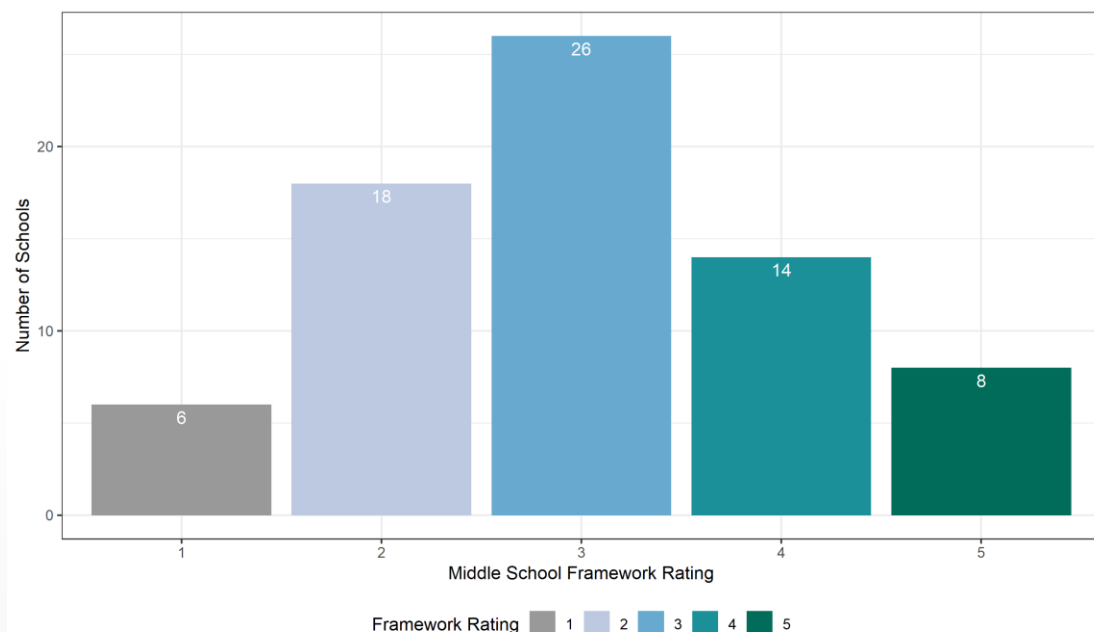

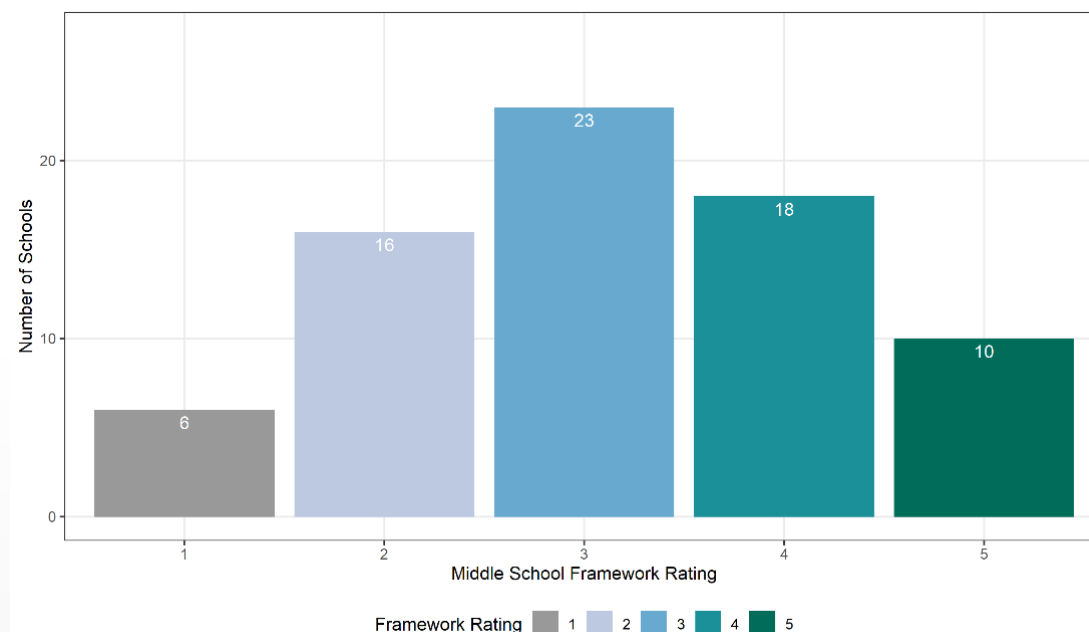


Number of Middle School Framework scores at each STAR Rating level in 2018 and 2019

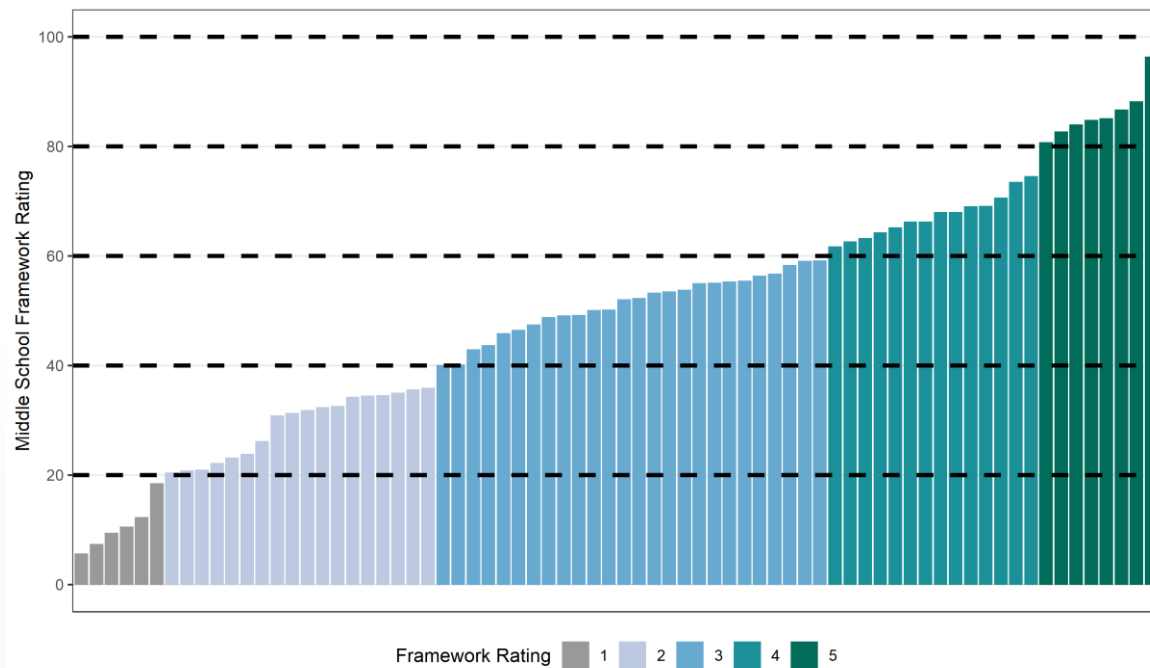

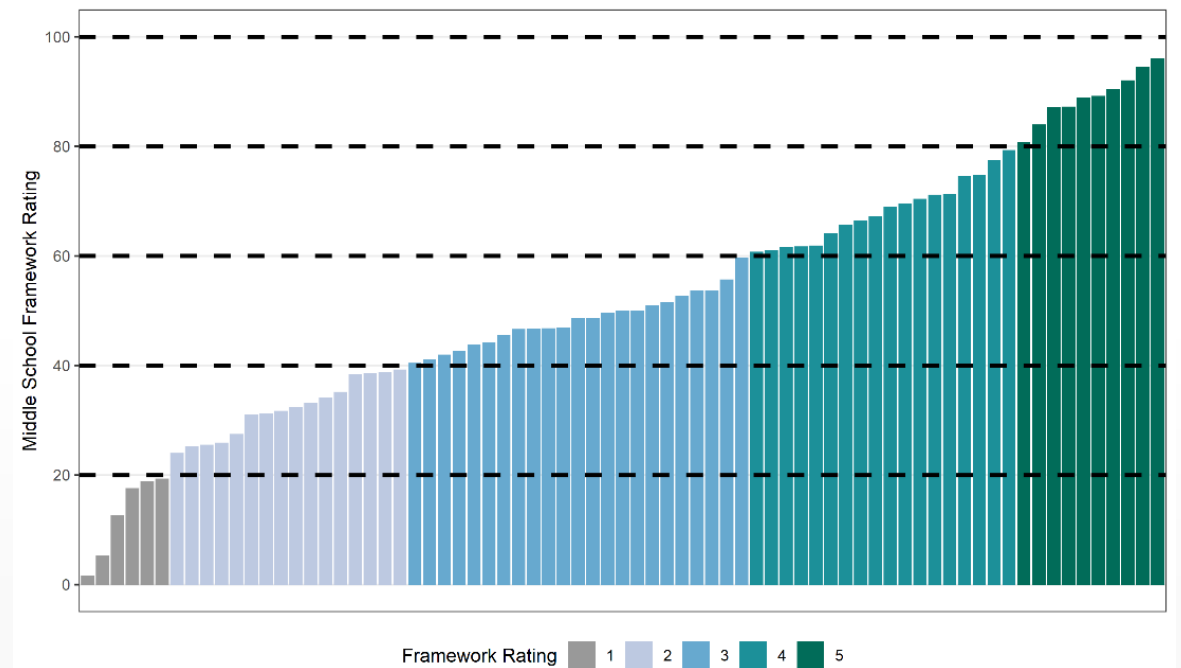


Distribution of Middle School Framework scores in 2018 and 2019

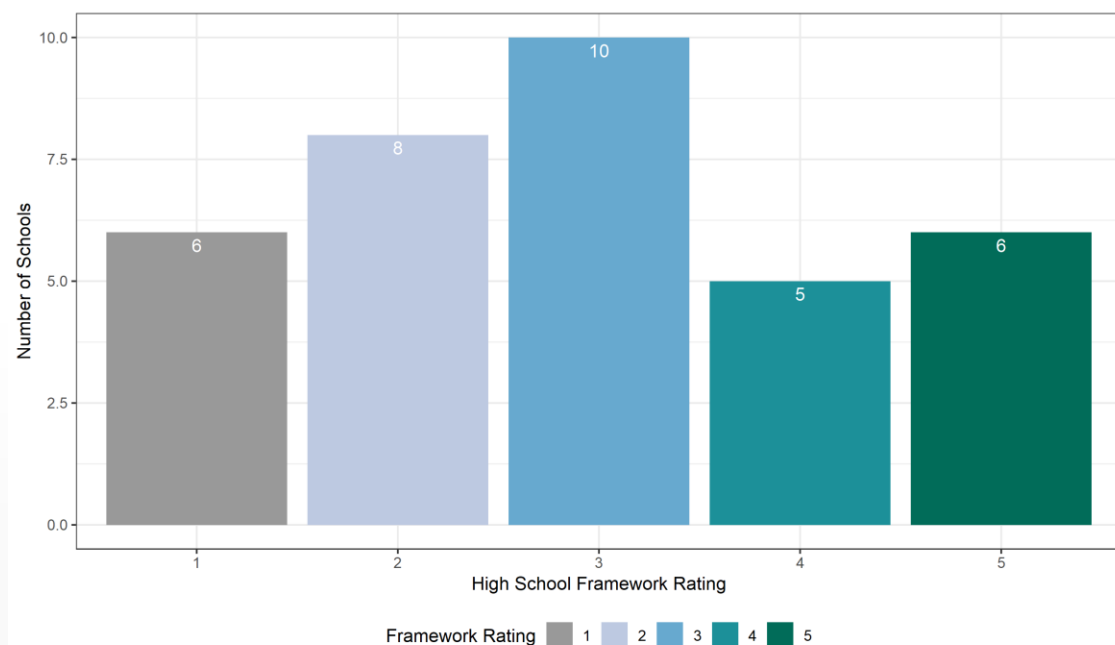

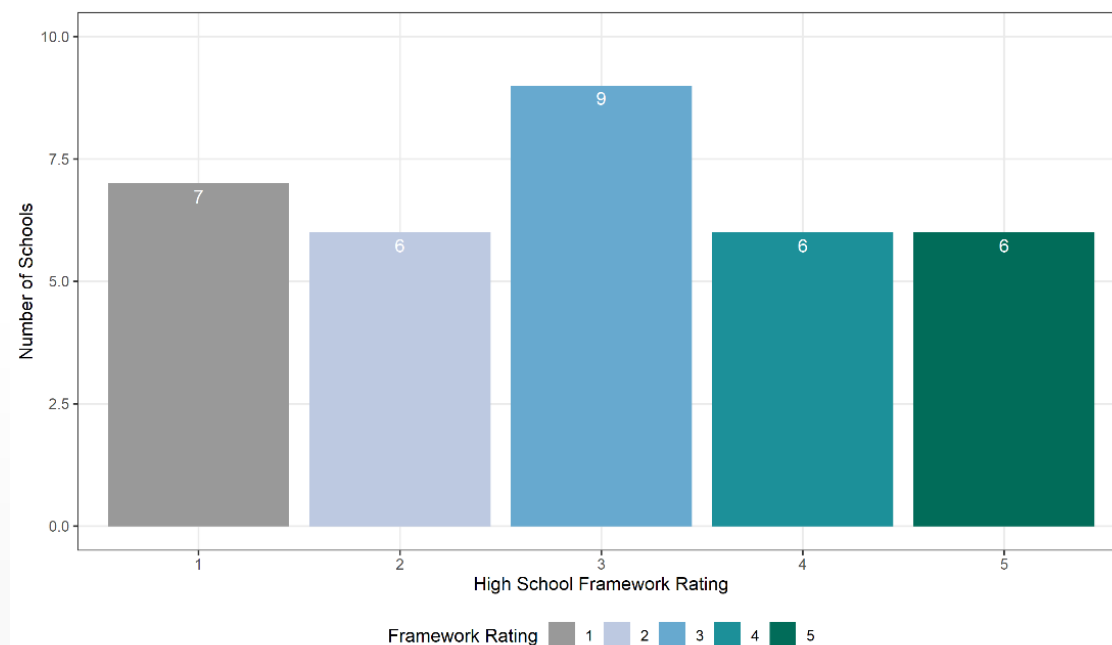


Number of High School Framework scores at each STAR Rating level in 2018 and 2019

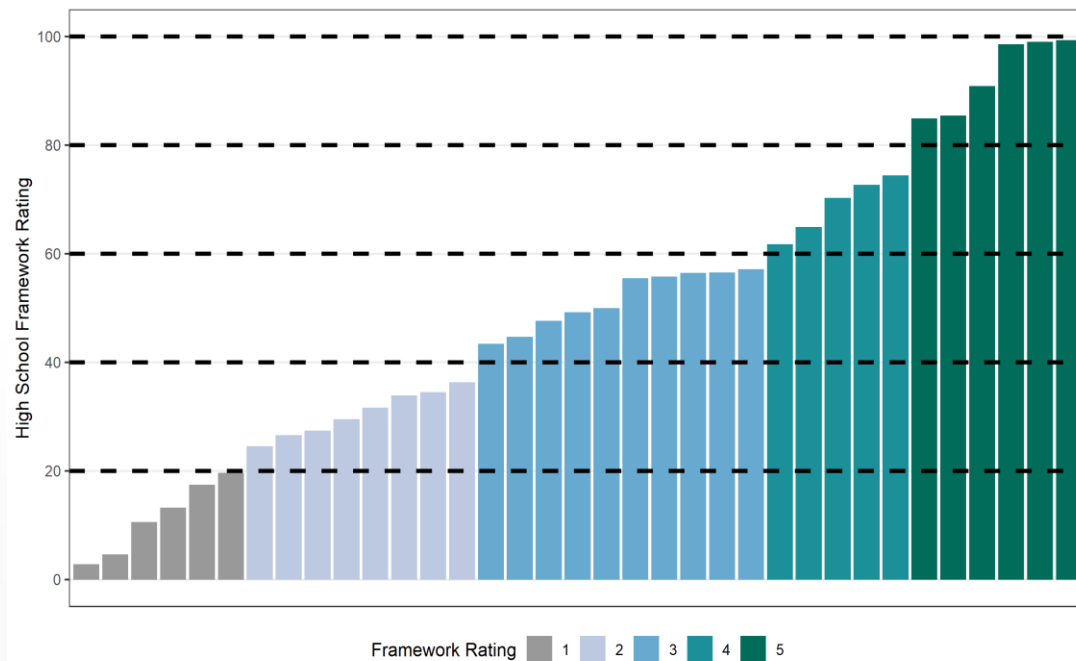

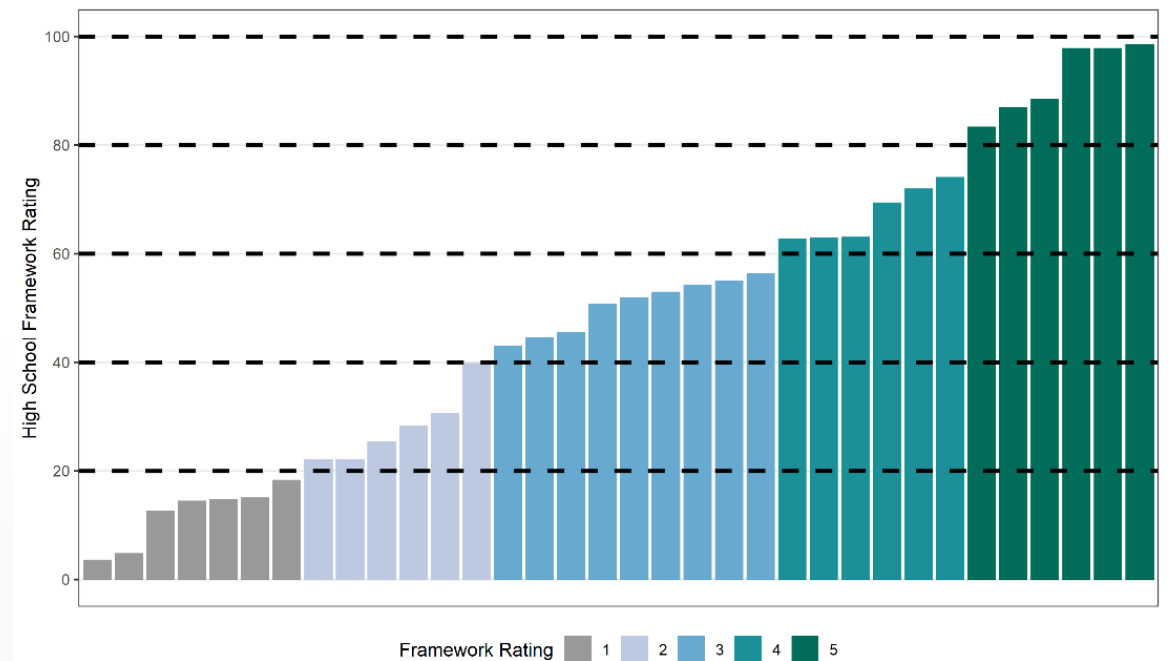


Distribution of High School Framework scores in 2018 and 2019

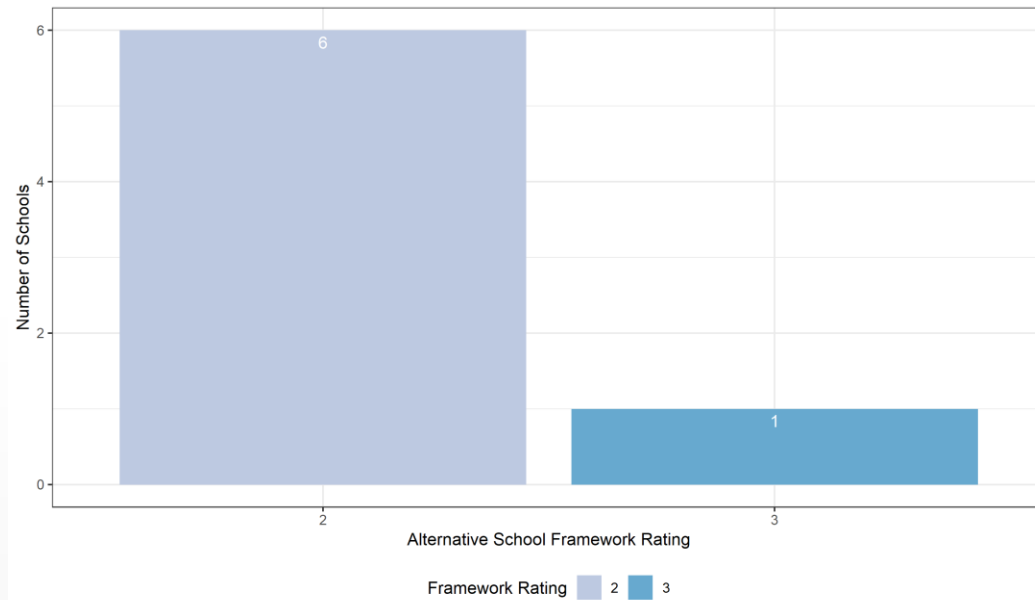

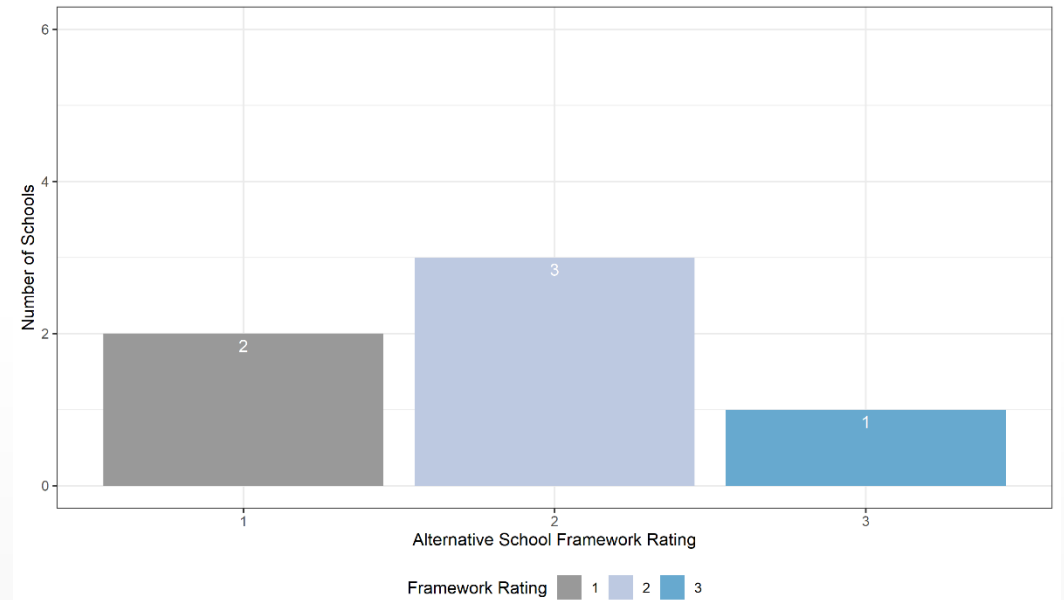


Number of Alternative School Framework scores at each STAR Rating level in 2018 and 2019

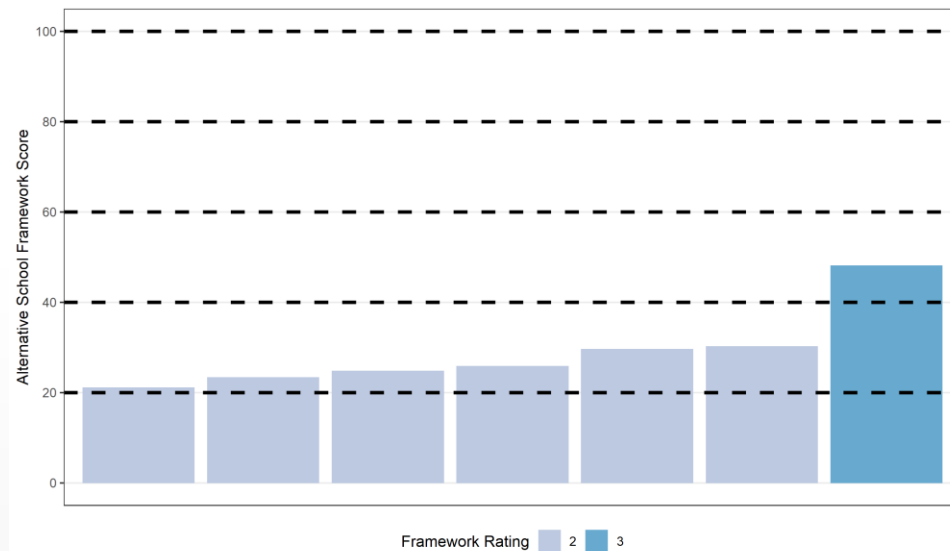

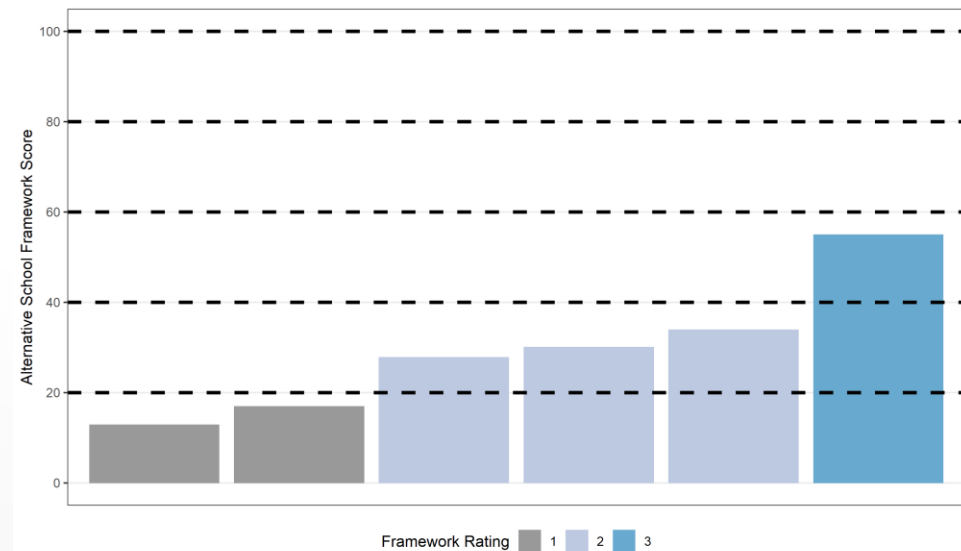


Distribution of Alternative School Framework scores in 2018 and 2019

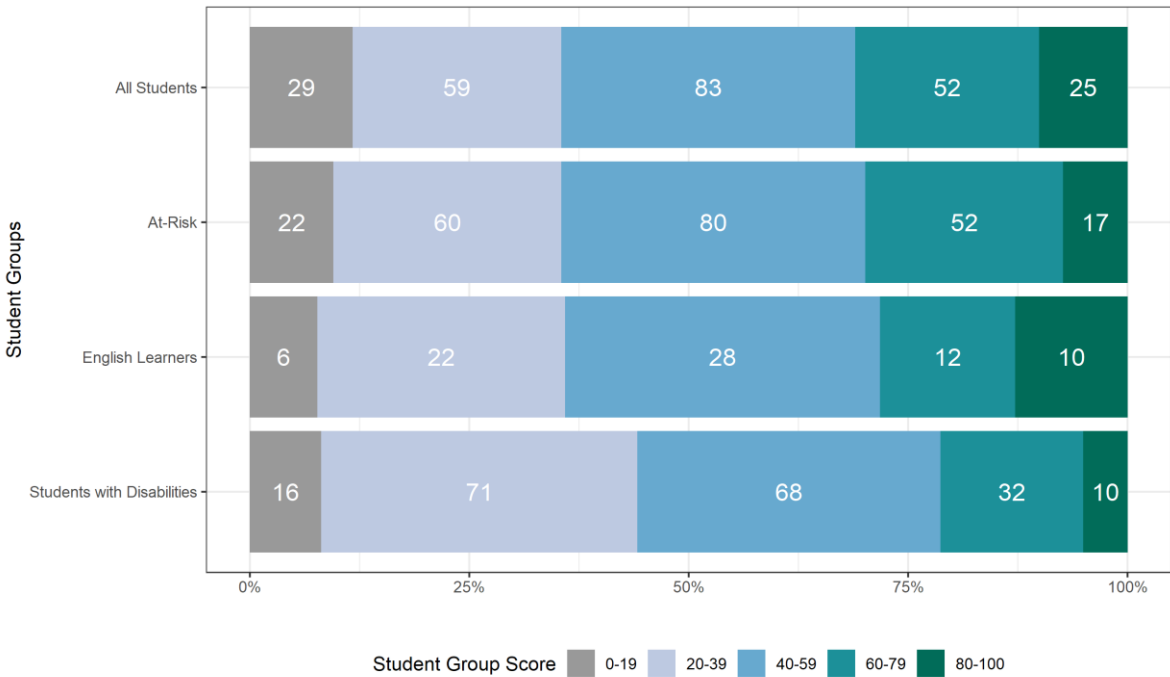

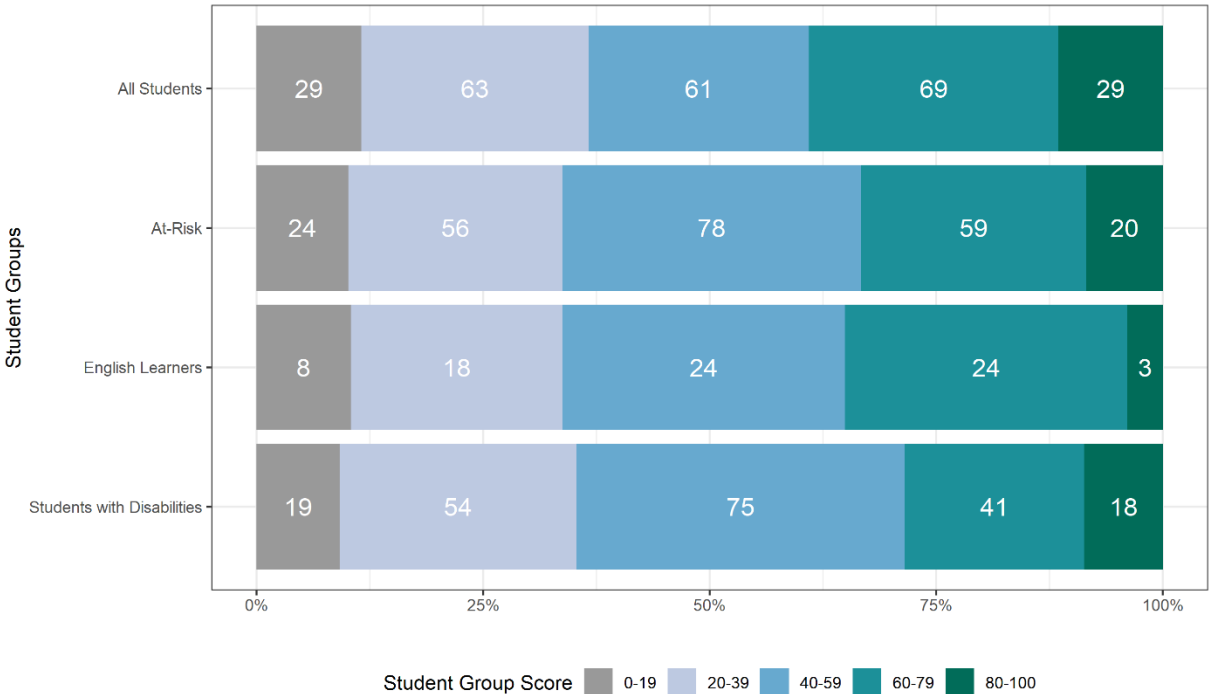


Number of Frameworks with Student Group scores per scoring level in 2018 and 2019

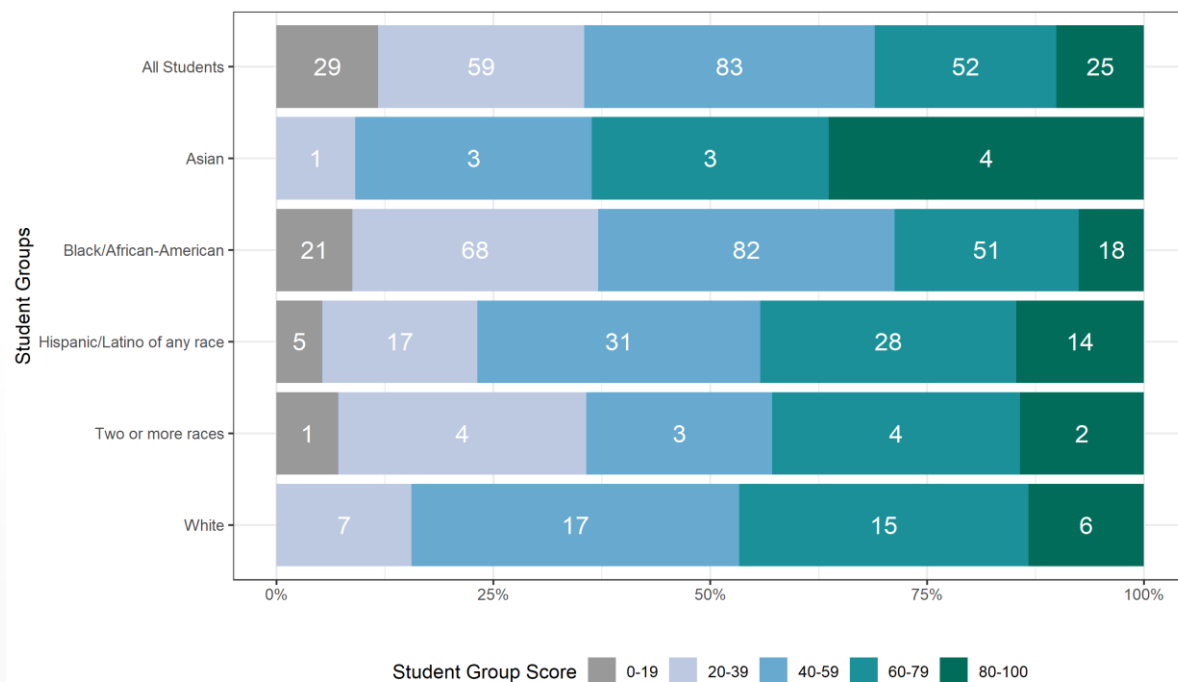

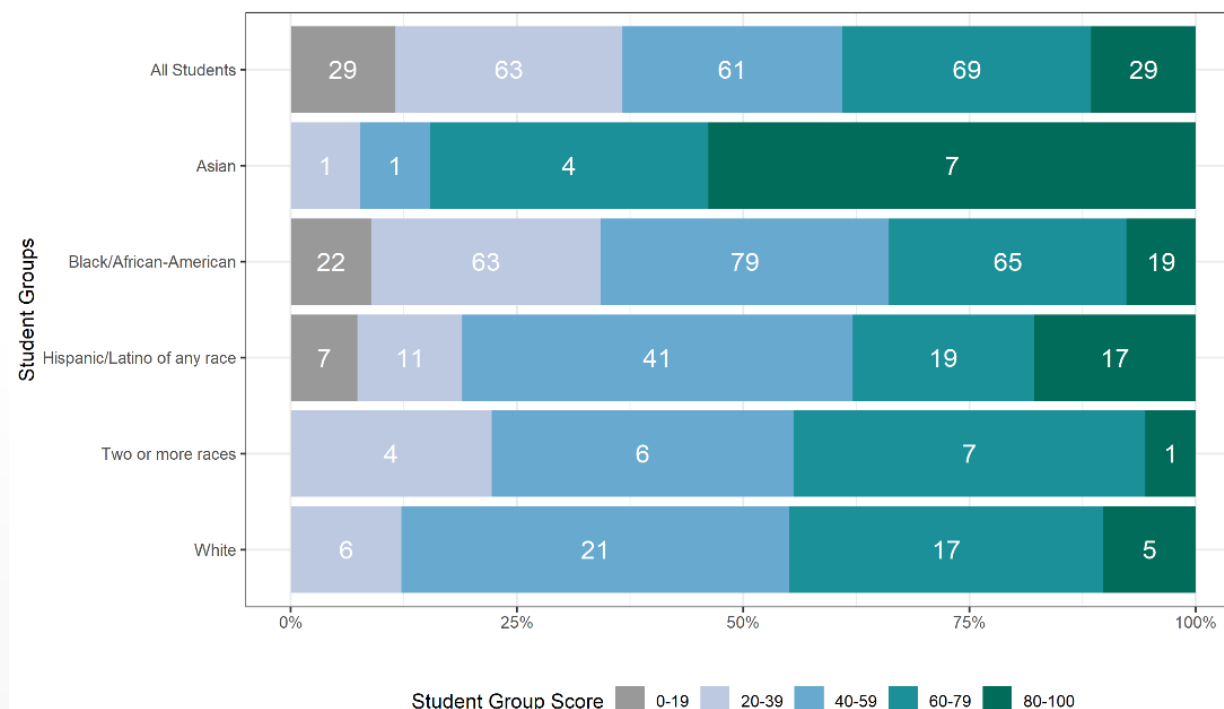


Number of Frameworks with Race/Ethnicity Student Group scores per scoring level in 2018 and 2019

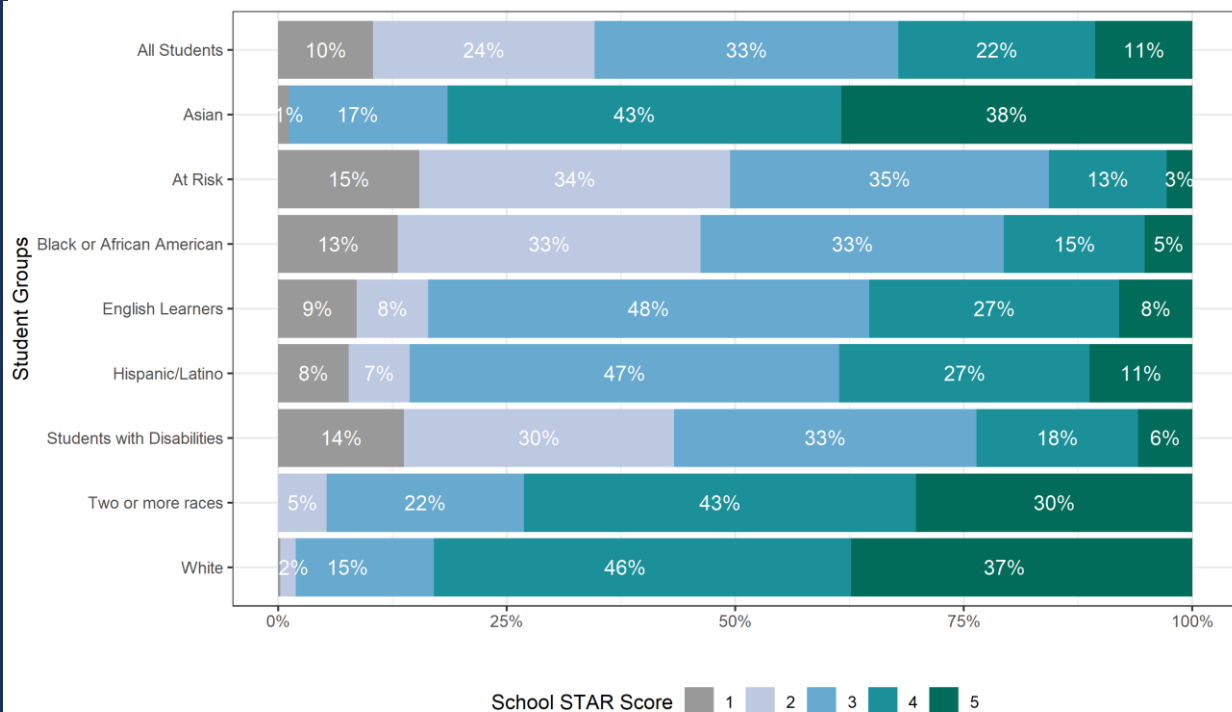
