

2016-17 Administrative Review Summary

Section 207 of the Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act (HHFKA) amended section 22 of the National School Lunch Act (NSLA), requiring State Agencies to report the final results of the administrative review to the public in an accessible, easily understood manner in accordance with guidelines promulgated by the Secretary. Regulations at 7 CFR 210.18(m) require the State Agency (SA) to post a summary of the most recent final administrative review results for each SFA on the SA's publicly available website no later than 30 days after providing the final results of the administrative review. The SA must also make a copy of the final administrative review report available to the public upon request.
