Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate: The four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate is the number of students who graduate in four years with a regular high school diploma divided by the number of students who form the adjusted cohort for the graduating class. For any given cohort, students who are entering grade 9 for the first time form a cohort that is subsequently "adjusted" by adding any students who transfer into the cohort later during the next three years and subtracting any students who transfer out, emigrate to another country, or are deceased during that same period.

<u>Enrolled in DC Schools SY2015-2016:</u> The number of students who re-enrolled in a DC public or public charter school in SY2015-2016, who did not graduate in four years.

Other Credential or Attending College: The number of students in the cohort who received an IDEA Certificate, GED or are currently enrolled in post-secondary education, but who did not graduate.

<u>Educationally Disengaged:</u> The number of students in the cohort who did not graduate, are not currently enrolled and did not receive an IDEA Certificate, GED and are not currently enrolled in post-secondary education.
