

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR LICENSURE EXAM

To obtain a full, renewable Administrative Services Credential in the District of Columbia, individuals must present evidence of successful completion of the School Leaders Licensure Assessment (SLLA) administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). Individuals with valid principal-level licenses from other states may qualify for a testing waiver with the submission of a passing score report documenting the successful completion of a school leader/principal licensure exam. NOTICE: The SLLA is solely offered in the computer-delivered format. Testing accommodations are available for test takers who meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) disability requirements.
