Introduction

The District of Columbia Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) grants an educator preparation provider (EPP) state approval after examining the quality of providers and programs preparing teachers, service providers, and administrators for District of Columbia P-12 schools; and determining that the programs meet state standards for preparing candidates to enter the profession. State approval is required for programs in the District of Columbia offering professional preparation programs that lead to state teacher, service provider, and school administrator licensure.

The state EPP and program approval system is designed to ensure a steady flow of high-quality candidates for roles as teachers, administrators, and other school personnel in District of Columbia schools by allowing multiple routes for educator preparation. The District of Columbia's system for state approval of EPPs and programs insists on high standards and selectivity for teacher, administrator, and other school personnel candidates.

The following pages identify the institutions and organizations that have been granted state approval by OSSE. They also identify the specific subject area programs that have been approved to recommend candidates for licensure. Additionally, these pages include information about which of the EPP's programs lead to an undergraduate and/or graduate degree, as well as which programs are non-degree programs that offer coursework that enables candidates to apply for a credential.
