FY2020 Cafeteria Staff Training Grant Competitive Preference

Background

The Cafeteria Staff Training Grant provides schools foodservice/nutrition employees with knowledge, training, and tools they need to plan, prepare, and purchase healthy products to create nutritious, safe, and enjoyable school meals.

The Cafeteria Staff Training Grant has a one year project period and the one-time awards can range from \$2,500 to \$100,000. Eligible applicants include District of Columbia (DC) public schools, DC public charter schools, non-profit private/non-public schools who participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), other organizations that support the NSLP, and certified training organizations.

OSSE's competitive preference is intended to increase the reach of the grant by prioritizing applicants that provide training to cafeteria staff at more schools. It is also intended to narrow the achievement and opportunity gap by prioritizing schools that have a STAR 1 or 2 rating on DC Report Card.

Competitive Preference

Based on the rationale above, OSSE will utilize a competitive preference in reviewing FY2020 Cafeteria Staff Training Grant applications. After application review based on the responses on EGMS, applicants will be awarded additional points based on the following factors:

- 1 point for each school served through the grant; and
- 1 additional point for each 1 or 2 STAR school served through the grant.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Should a school with a STAR rating of 3, 4, or 5 apply?

A. Yes. Applicants will primarily be scored on their narrative section responses on EGMS. Additional points will be given to schools that have a STAR 1 or 2 rating or would train staff at schools with a STAR 1 or 2 rating.

Q. Will applications that receive the competitive preference be held to the same standards as those that do not receive the competitive preference?

A. Yes. Awards will be made in consideration of an applicant's score on the evaluation criteria described in the Request for Applications. OSSE shall make all final funding determinations.
