Mayor's Order 2012-136 August 24, 2012

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority pursuant to D.C. Law 19-142, the Raising the Expectations for Education Outcomes Omnibus Act of 2012

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia pursuant to section 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6) and (11) (2012 Supp.), and pursuant to the Raising the Expectations for Education Outcomes Omnibus Act of 2012 ("Act"), effective June 19, 2012 (D.C. Law 19-142, 59 DCR 3642), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

- 1. The State Superintendent of Education is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor to implement the following provisions of the Act:
 - a. Section 103 to establish a pilot early warning and support system as provided in the Act;
 - b. Section 104 to survey a sample of schools to identify existing initiatives used to support high school and college readiness and increase graduation rates;
 - c. Section 105 to create a report on school-level data, recommendations, and a plan to expand the early warning and support system to all schools as provided in the Act;
 - d. Section 203 to ensure that each public high school student before graduation applies to at least one post-secondary institution, takes the SAT or ACT, and participates in a program on applying to post-secondary institutions; and to issue a report on students that attend post-secondary institutions as provided in the Act;
 - e. Section 303 to establish a pilot incentive program to encourage highly effective teachers to teach in high-need schools as provided in the Act;
 - f. Section 304 to provide an annual report on August 30th of each year of the pilot program as provided in the Act;

- g. Sections 403(a) (b) (c) (e) and (f) to establish a process for awarding Incentive Initiative grants, to conduct periodic evaluations, to refine and improve grant activities, and to identify best practices;
- h. Section 404 to administer the Community School Fund; and
- i. Section 601 to issue rules to implement Titles I, II, III, and IV of this Act.

2. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.
