DCTAG FAST FACTS

DCTAG is the District of Columbia Tuition Assistance Grant. The **DCTAG** program is administered by the Office of the State Superintendent of Education.

DCTAG pays the **difference** between in-state and out-of-state tuition, up to \$10,000 annually at public colleges and up to \$2,500 at private colleges in DC and private HBCUs, nationwide.

At public institutions, you have up to 6 years or \$50,000 (whichever comes first) before your **DCTAG** funds expire.

At 4-year private HBCUs and DC private colleges and universities, you have up to 6 years or \$12,500 (whichever comes first) before your **DCTAG** funds expire.

DCTAG eligibility expires after age 26.

DCTAG offers up to \$2,500 for private institutions in the metropolitan DC area: Catholic University, Howard University, George Washington University, Georgetown University, and Trinity Washington University.

DCTAG cannot be used at the University of the District of Columbia (UDC). District students are already paying in-state tuition at UDC.

DCTAG does not offer funding for proprietary institutions, e.g. University of Phoenix, DeVry University, Strayer University etc.

DCTAG funds do not cover room & board, books or other college costs beyond tuition.

Complete the OneApp Early!

Fund your college education in three easy steps:

- 1 Complete the DC OneApp at www.dconeapp.dc.gov
- 2 Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) www.fafsa.gov
- 3 Submit all of the **DCTAG** supporting documents electronically through the DC OneApp website.

DCTAG provides up to \$10,000 per year for college tuition. Funds are limited. Apply early.
