	The LEA will submit a final application in the Enterprise Grants Management System (EGMS) by Sept. 30, 2021 by 3 p.m. ET, that includes uploading these signed assurances and the preliminary grant award notification issued to you by OSSE;
	The LEA will provide additional information on its approach to continuous education, including an indication of whether ESSER II funds will provide support, as part of its final application submission to OSSE;
	The LEA shall to the greatest extent practicable, continue to pay its employees and contractors during the period of any disruptions or closures related to coronavirus (CARES Act Section 18006);
	The program will be administered in accordance with applicable statutes, regulations, program plans, and applications;
	Control of funds and property acquired using program funds will be maintained and administered by the appropriate public agency;
	Fiscal control and fund accounting procedures will be used to ensure proper disbursement of, and accounting for, federal funds;
	The LEA will make reports to the state agency or board and to the secretary as may be needed for the state agency or board and the Secretary to perform their duties under the program, and each LEA will maintain records and provide access to those records as the state board or agency Secretary deems necessary to carry out their responsibilities;

	The LEA will provide opportunities for the participation in, planning for, and operation of each program by teachers, parents, and other interested agencies, organizations, and individuals;
