Science Assessment Update

- Administration Window: May 18 June 19
- Administration:
 - Computer Based: Pearson Access and TestNav 8.2
 - Testing time ~1 hour per student, not timed
- Test Design/Field Test Status:
 - Each student takes 1 session, 26 items
 - 16 items brand new, associated with two NGSS-aligned scenario events that simulate a situation requiring scientific reasoning, 10 NGSS-aligned carryover items
 - Census field test, will not be public this year, but schools will get data

Science Formative

- Available in the fall
- Optional for all schools
- Secure, functioning as both a secondary field test and a science diagnostic
