FREE LEGAL SERVICES

Under IDEA and its regulations, specifically 34 CFR 300.507(b), an LEA must inform a parent of any free or low-cost legal or other relevant services available in the area, upon request or upon the parent's filing a due process complaint. The following is a list of organizations, compiled by the Office of Dispute Resolution, which make available free legal services to parents of students with disabilities. Whether legal services will be provided to any particular parent will, of course, be dependent upon each agency's policies and procedures and its review of each individual case.
