BACKGROUND

A Hearing Officer's Determination/Decision (HOD) was issued in this matter September 2, 2009 wherein the MDT was ordered to convene for certain purposes. The MDT did not convene. On March 4, 2009, Counsel for the Student filed the herein Complaint with the District of Columbia Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE), Student Hearing Office (SHO), complaining the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) denied the student a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE). Specifically, Counsel for the Student complained DCPS violated the HOD issued in the matter September 2, 2009 and, for relief, requested an Order to DCPS to convene the MDT as ordered on September 2, 2009.

A Pre-hearing Conference Order was issued in this matter on December 23, 2008. The Order determined the issue as setout below.

The Student Hearing Office, OSSE, scheduled a hearing in this matter for 11:00 A.M., Thursday, April 9, 2009 at the Student Hearing Office, OSSE, 1150 Fifth Street, SE - First Floor, Hearing Room 6A, Washington, D.C. 20003. The hearing convened as scheduled.

JURISDICTION

The hearing convened under Public Law 108-446, The Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004, Title 34 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 300, and Title V of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

ISSUE: Did DCPS violate the Hearing Officer's Determination/ Decision (HOD) issued in this matter September 2, 2008?

FINDINGS of FACT

By facsimile dated April 1, 2009, the parent disclosed 6 witnesses and 18 documents.

By facsimile dated April 8, 2009, DCPS disclosed 9 witnesses and 4 documents.
