CALL TO ORDER

 - Part C State SPP/APR was submitted for FFY 14
 - DC EIP is participating with DC Library Birth to Books reading program
 - Part C is collaborating with DHCF discussing becoming a Medicaid provider
- Chair stated that she has reviewed the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report (SPP/APR) and has signed the statement certifying that the ICC is using the State's Part C SPP/APR for FFY 2014 in lieu of submitting the ICC's own annual report.

DC EIP QUARTERLY UPDATES

- ### SUB-COMMITTEE REPORTS
- Amy Cullen stated from her experience as a provider that there is a discrepancy between the contracted and the actual rate of reimbursement when working with managed care organizations.
 - Raeshawn Settles suggested that OSSF and DHCF discuss an internal process around payment issues for Providers when involving the managed care organizations.

- Chair raised a question about other funding sources for Part C service provision, such as Medicaid.
- Toby and Raeshawn met with Chairman Grosso in January to discuss implementation of the Special Education Services Act of 2014.
- Toby updated the ICC on the sub-committee progress as representatives meet with Senior Advisor, Yair Inspektor and Deputy Mayor Niles to discuss possible challenges with full implementation of the Enhanced Special Education Services Act of 2014.
- The ICC retreat held on Dec. 11, 2015. Chair asked Toby Long (Co-Chair of the Legislative and Social Policy Sub-Committee) to report on progress since the retreat.

ICC MEETING BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

- Chair gave an informal report of membership status.
- There are seven vacant seats that need to be filled to meet regulatory compliance.
- Chair agreed to discuss Mayoral appointment process with the Mayor's Director of Talent and Appointment (MOTA)

OPEN ISSUES

Chair stated the importance of the Council's participation in other District committees to advocate for funding for Part C.

- Elizabeth Groginsky stated that the ICC could give recommendations to the State Early Childhood Development Coordinating Council (SECDCC).
- Colleen Sonosky stated that she is the co-chair of the Health and Well-Being Committee of the SECDCC. She will invite the ICC leadership to the next meeting.
- Jerri Johnston Stewart staffs the Early Intervention and Family Support Committee of the SECDCC and Pam Brown White co-chairs the Committee. The ICC Chair asked to be linked to the SECDCC and all Committees beneficial to ICC's purpose.

- Requested information on new initiatives with Part C.


