# Test Security Training Reminders

- **All LEA Test Coordinators** are required to attend OSSE's Test Security Training
  - ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 is a statewide assessment, LEA ACCESS Coordinators are required to attend as well.
- OSSE follows a **“train-the-trainer”** model for Test Security Training
  - LEA Test Coordinators are required to train all authorized personnel, including:
    - School Test Coordinators
    - Special Populations Coordinators
    - Technology Coordinators
    - Test Administrators
    - Proctors

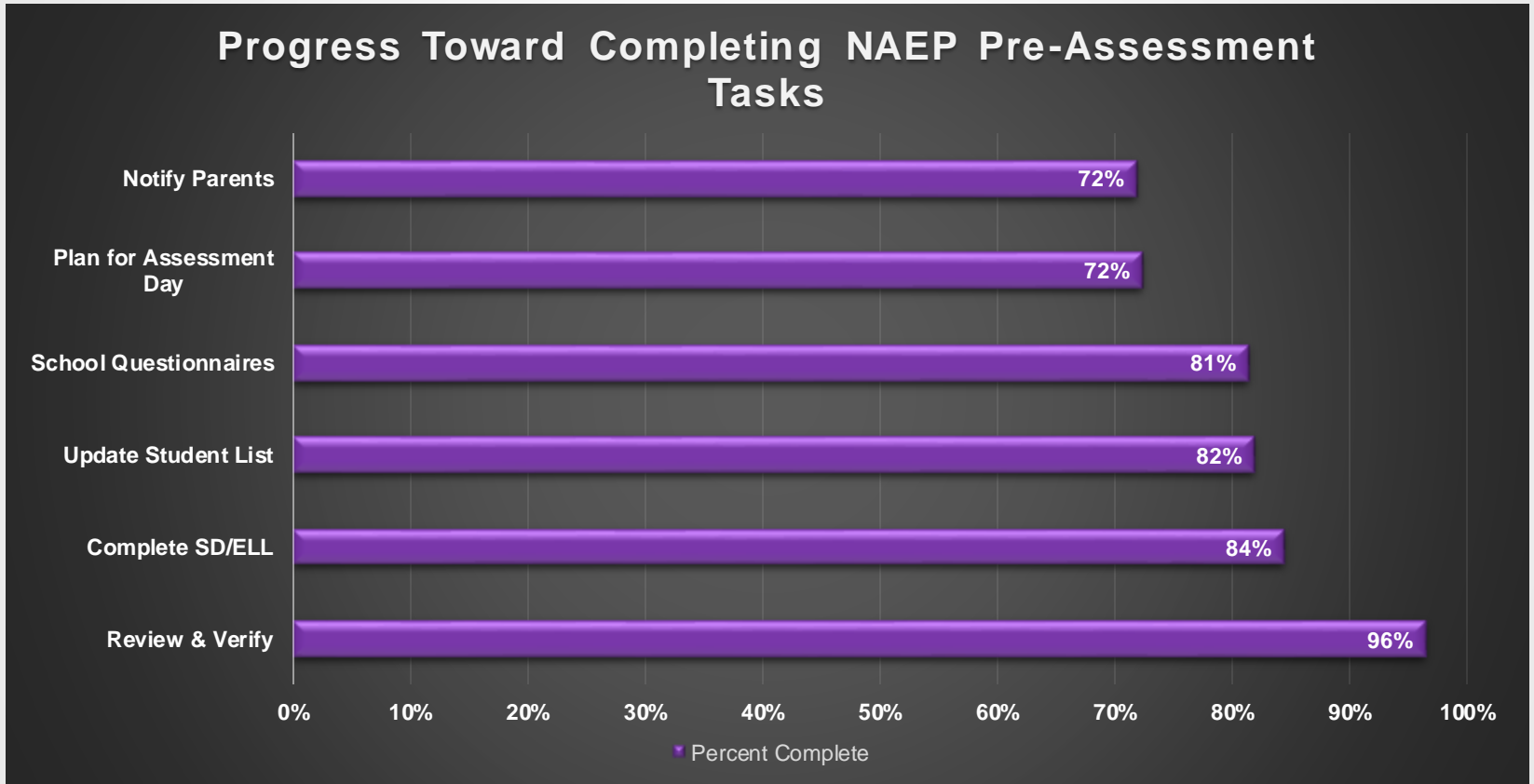

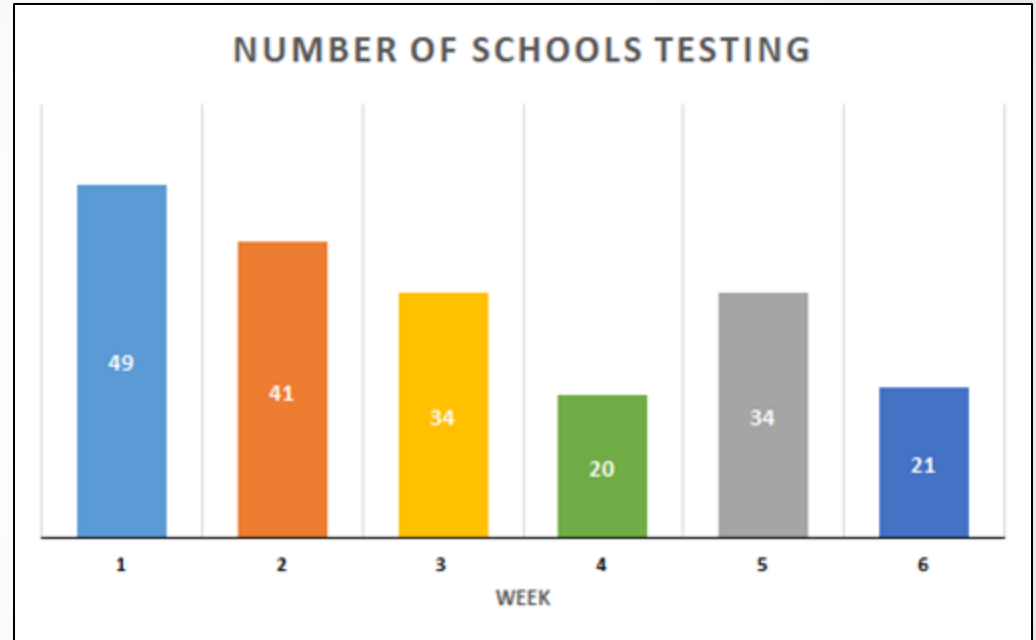

# ACCESS for ELLs and Alternate ACCESS

The WIDA AMS Test Setup window for ACCESS for ELLs and Alternate ACCESS for ELLs will open **Jan. 29** and will close **April 5**. During this timeframe, LEA Test Coordinators will be able to:

- Modify student information
- Add new students
- Set up test sessions
- Print test ticket
- Mark accommodations and Do Not Score Codes
- Monitor test progress

# Alternate Eligibility Determinations

All Alternate Assessment eligibility determinations are now reflected in QuickBase and SEDS!

If an IEP team determines, upon review, that a student deemed ineligible by OSSE should take the alternate assessment, the student may be registered for the MSAA but will be counted as a non-participant in the calculation of the school's participation rate in the state assessment. Under federal law and regulations, schools are required to have a 95 percent participation rate on the state assessments.

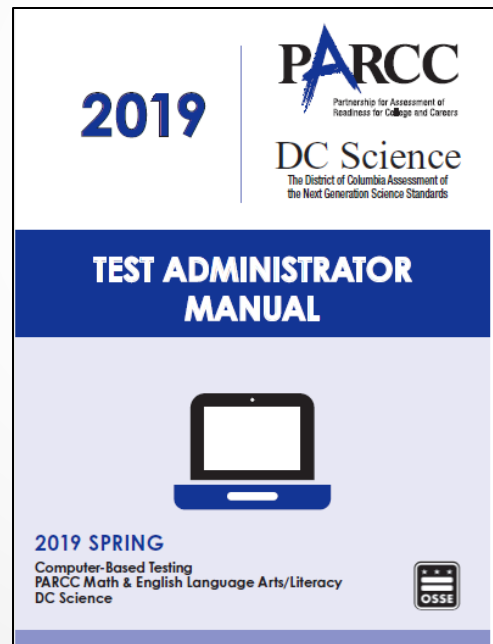
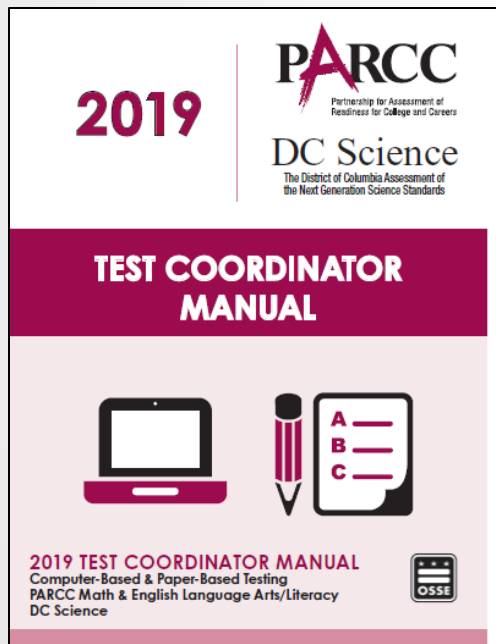

**PARCC Assessment**

The Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers, or PARCC, is the District of Columbia's annual assessment of mathematics and English language arts (ELA), based on the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). The PARCC assessments measure the knowledge and skills that matter most for students — understanding complex texts, evidence-based writing, mathematical problem-solving — all skills that lead to confidence and success in key academic areas.

Students in grades 3 through 8 and high school take PARCC assessments in ELA and mathematics online each spring.

**DC Science Assessment**

DC Science is the District of Columbia's statewide assessment of the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). It is an online assessment that focuses on sense-making and problem solving in science. The DC Science assessment presents students with tasks that are built around scientific phenomena as well as engineering design challenges.

The DC Science assessment is administered to students in grades 5 and 8 and to students enrolled in high school biology.
