Funding for Public Schools & Public Charter schools Amendment Act of 2011

- The District of Columbia recently made changes to the way LEAs track and spend UPSFF payment(s)under the *Funding for Public Schools & Public Charter Schools Amendment Act of 2011.* The Act requires:
 - Compliance with the federal MOE requirement for LEAs (see 34 C.F.R. §§300.203 through §§300.205)
 - LEAs to report on local (UPSFF) expenditures **annually**
 - Compliance with allowable uses of special education payments (outlined in pages 8-9 of the Funding for Public Schools & Public Charter Schools Amendment Act of 2011 – Guidance)



Funding for Public Schools & Public Charter schools Amendment Act of 2011

- The Act also added *new* funds to the special education UPSFF payment:
 - Special Education Capacity Fund designated to increase the capacity of public schools to serve students with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs), including students returning from nonpublic placements
 - **Special Education Compliance Fund** designated to support activities required to address identified noncompliance with federal and local regulations regarding the provision of special education services to students with IEPs
- LEAs must report on expenditures from both of these funds in MOE Expenditure Tool
